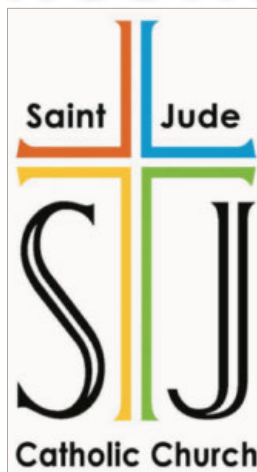

THE ST. JUDE GIVING TREE - AN ANNUAL TRADITION

For over 30 years, the St. Jude Giving Tree Program has been bringing Christmas joy to those in need in Allen and the surrounding area.

In the months leading up to November, the names and needs of children and the elderly are gathered by St. Jude Staff through community sources (local school counselors, the Allen Food Pantry, People Helping People, Collin County Juvenile Detention Center, the St. Jude Home Bound Ministry, the Bonham Veteran's Home and Victoria Gardens) and made into tags by our American Heritage Girls. The tags are placed on the Giving Tree, and once the Tree is Blessed, parishioners may take the tags from the tree, shop for the items on the tag and return the gifts to the Giving Tree by the posted due date. The gifts are then sorted and picked up or delivered to the recipients. Through the love and generosity of our parish community, the true spirit of Christmas Shines!

***The Gift Deadline of DEC 6 by 5PM is CRITICAL:** When a gift is turned in **after the 12/6 deadline**, it is automatically considered missing. Our team begins working (goes shopping!) to find a replacement gift to fulfill that person's wish. Therefore, while late gifts are still accepted, they make the process more difficult on the Giving Tree Team.

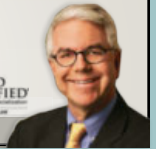
