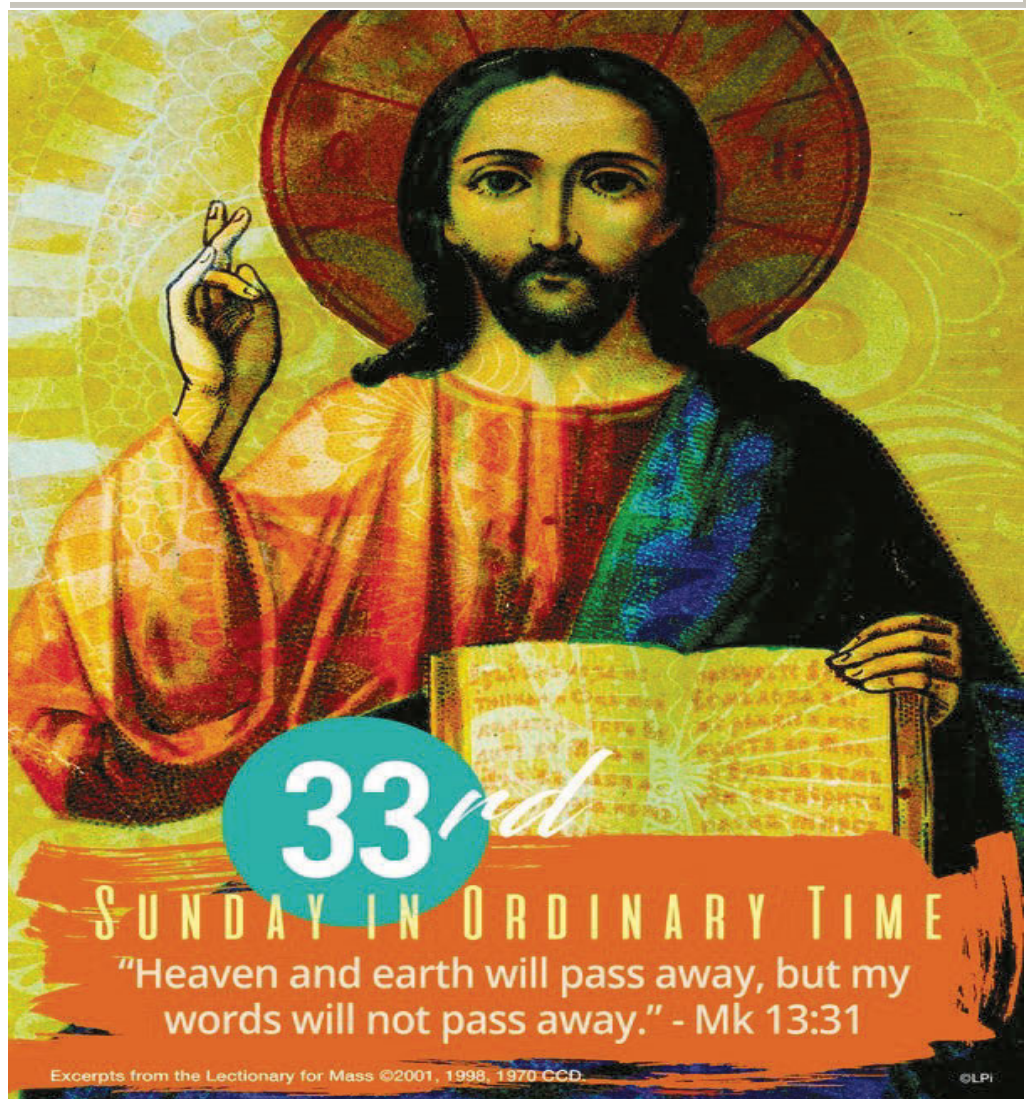

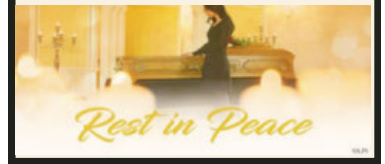

Thirty-Third Week in Ordinary Time

The **Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time** brings us the familiar and powerful parable from **Matthew's Gospel** about the servants who are each given sums of money to invest. We are all called upon to use the gifts we have received as gifts, and to return them, fully developed and utilized.

Wednesday is the **Memorial of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary, religious.**

During these last two weeks of Ordinary Time, the first reading is from the Book of **Revelation**, with its mystic imagery. Written for readers who were familiar with apocalyptic writings, the writings sends a hidden message of salvation to the earliest communities of Christians, and to us.

Luke's Gospel offers the story of the blind man who hails him, "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me!" An unpopular tax collector, Zacchaeus, climbs a tree to get a glimpse of Jesus and is given personal recognition as Jesus says, "Zacchaeus, today I must stay at your house." Luke's version of the parable of the talents offers praise for the servant who has invested the ten coins and earned another ten. "Well done, good servant! You have been faithful in this very small matter; take charge of ten cities." He weeps over Jerusalem: "If this day you only knew what makes for peace – but now it is hidden from your eyes." Jesus drives out the sellers from the temple while the chief priests plot against him. Religious leaders try to trap him with a trick question about a woman who marries seven brothers but Jesus refutes them.

Next Sunday is the **Thirty-Fourth or Last Sunday in Ordinary Time** and **The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King**. Jesus tells the marvelous parable about how we will all be judged - as a shepherd separates sheep from goats, based upon our care for the poor: "Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me."

Trigésima-tercera semana del tiempo ordinario

El **trigésimo tercer domingo del tiempo ordinario** nos trae la familiar y poderosa parábola del **Evangelio de Mateo** acerca de los siervos, a los que se le da a cada uno sumas de dinero para invertir. Todos estamos llamados a utilizar los dones que hemos recibido como obsequios y a devolverlos, plenamente desarrollados y utilizados.

El miércoles es el **Memorial de Santa Isabel de Hungría, religiosa.**

Durante estas dos últimas semanas del Tiempo Ordinario, la primera lectura es del **Libro del Apocalipsis**, con su imaginaria mística. Escrito para lectores que estaban familiarizados con los escritos apocalípticos, los escritos envían un mensaje oculto de salvación a las primeras comunidades de cristianos y a nosotros.

El **Evangelio de Lucas** ofrece la historia del ciego que lo saluda: "¡Jesús, Hijo de David, ten compasión de mí!" Un recaudador de impuestos impopular, Zaqueo, trepa a un árbol para ver a Jesús y recibe un reconocimiento personal cuando Jesús dice: "Zaqueo, hoy debo quedarme en tu casa". La versión de Lucas de la parábola de los talentos alaba al siervo que invirtió las diez monedas y ganó otras diez. "¡Bien hecho, buen siervo! Has sido fiel en este asunto muy pequeño; toma el control de diez ciudades". Él llora sobre Jerusalén: "Si este día supieras lo que hace la paz, pero ahora está oculto a tus ojos". Jesús expulsa a los vendedores del templo mientras los principales sacerdotes conspiran contra él. Los líderes religiosos intentan atrapararlo con una pregunta capciosa sobre una mujer que se casa con siete hermanos, pero Jesús los refuta.

El próximo domingo es el **trigésimo-cuarto o último domingo del tiempo ordinario** y la **solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo el Rey**. Jesús cuenta la maravillosa parábola de cómo todos seremos juzgados, como un pastor separa ovejas de cabras, basándose en nuestro cuidado por los pobres: "En verdad, te digo que todo lo que hiciste por uno de mis hermanos más pequeños, tú hizo por mí".

RCIA’s Rite of Acceptance

On November 21, 2021, at the 9am Mass, St. Joseph RCIA will celebrate The Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens which is the first of the “threshold rites” of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), and the first public ritual. In the Rite of Acceptance, a change of identity takes place: those previously known as inquirers become catechumens. They are officially welcomed by the Church as disciples, members (albeit not yet full members) of the household of faith. The RCIA Manual calls this rite “the first consecration by the Church” of those seeking Christian initiation. They are literally marked with the cross of Christ as God’s own. Consequently, the gathered community and its welcome, as well as the inquirers and their promise of discipleship, are essential to this rite. This Rite is normally celebrated at a Sunday Mass so that “the entire Christian community...take an active part in the celebration.”

Also at this Mass, we will celebrate the Rite of Welcoming to those candidates who’ve already been baptized in another Christian tradition as well as those who’ve been baptized Catholic and are completing their Sacraments of Initiation by receiving First Communion and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation.

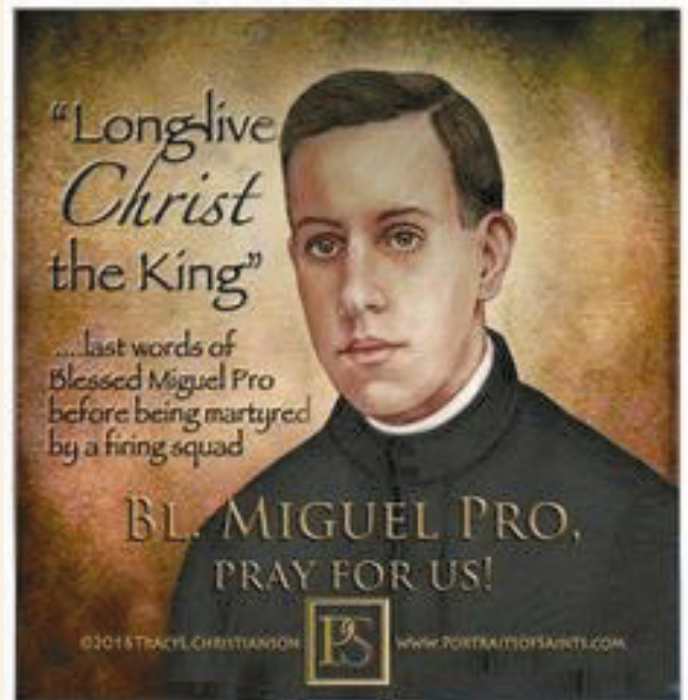

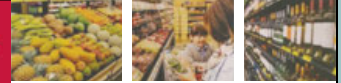

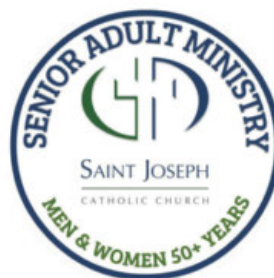
