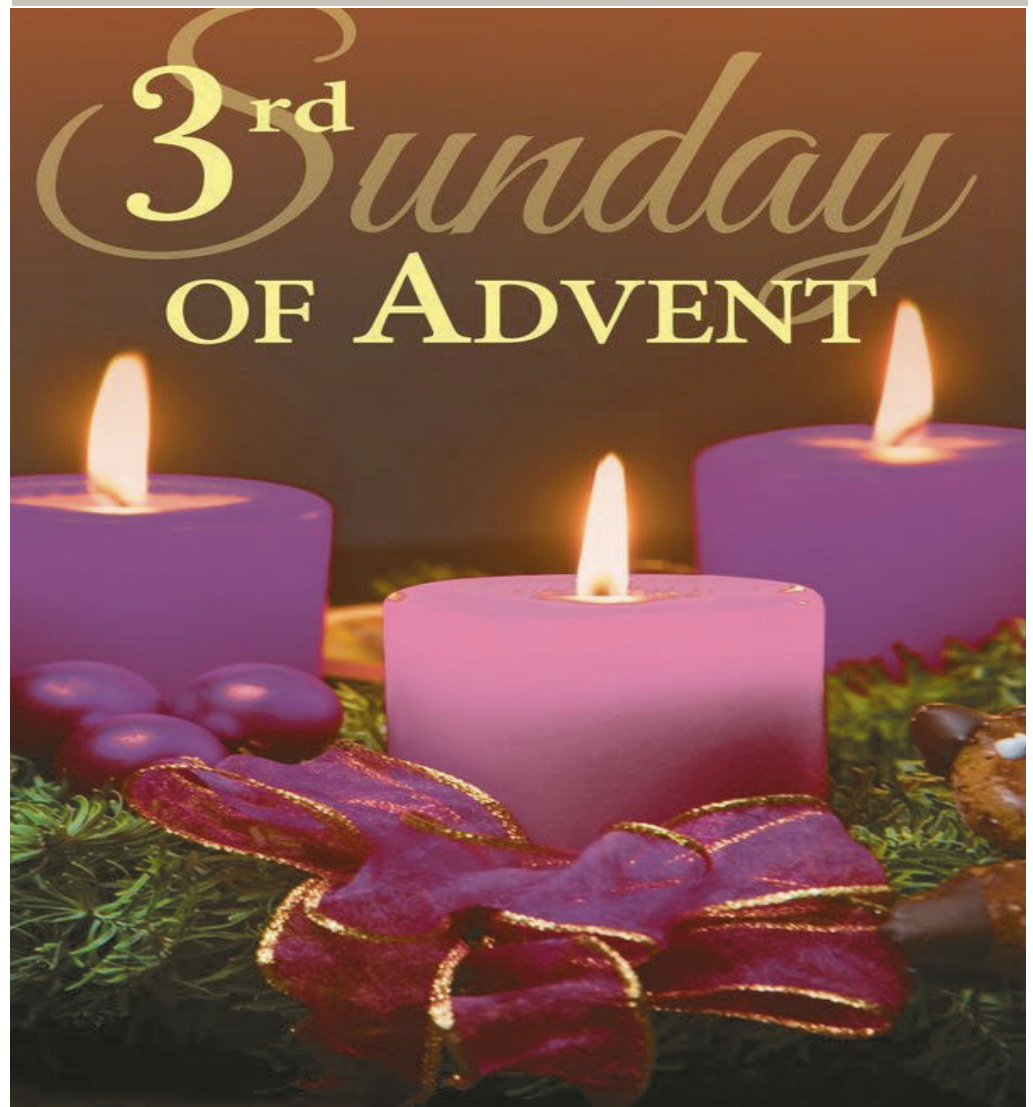

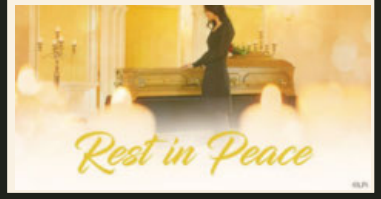

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Third Week of Advent

Sunday of the Third Week of Advent begins with the **Prophet Zephaniah's** announcement of liberation and God's presence among the people after decades of their own infidelity. In **Luke's Gospel** John the Baptist is the focus of the expectation in the people who come to him asking what to do. He exhorts them to integrity and charity and announces the one who is to come: "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

Monday is the **Memorial of Saint Lucy, Martyr**. Tuesday is the **Memorial of Saint John of the Cross, Priest and Doctor of the Church**.

We continue to focus on the first readings in this first part of Advent. From the Book of Numbers, we have the proclamation that "a star shall advance from Jacob..." Zephaniah is the prophet of impending doom, if the people don't abandon their idolatry. But this week we read about consoling healing, "on that day," when the Lord comes. Isaiah's message is full of promise: "Turn to me and be safe ... for I am God; there is no other!"

On Thursday, we reach the December 17th and in these last eight days of Advent the focus returns to the gospels with stories from Jesus' family in the time before he was born. Matthew's gospel offers the genealogy of Jesus' family. On the 18th we read Matthew's account of the nativity: Joseph decides to divorce the pregnant Mary until an angel appears to him in a dream, saying, "It is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her." On the 19th, in the first chapter of Luke's gospel, Elizabeth and Zechariah struggle with their inability to have a child. They are told they will have a child named John who will be filled with the Holy Spirit. When Zechariah doubts, he is struck speechless.

The **Fourth Sunday of Advent** begins the last week of Advent, which takes us to Christmas on Saturday. The reading from Micah reminds us that of the seemingly unimportant town of Bethlehem, "from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel." Luke's gospel offers again the story of Mary's going to visit her cousin. Elizabeth understands immediately Mary's situation and praises God saying, "How does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy."



Tercera semana de Adviento

El domingo de la Tercera Semana de Adviento comienza con el anuncio del **profeta Sofonías** de la liberación y la presencia de Dios entre el pueblo después de décadas de su propia infidelidad. En el **Evangelio de Lucas**, Juan el Bautista es el centro de la expectativa de las personas que se acercan a él para preguntarle qué hacer. Los exhorta a la integridad y la caridad y anuncia al que ha de venir: "Él os bautizará en Espíritu Santo y fuego".

El lunes es el **Memorial de Santa Lucía Mártir**. El martes es la **Memoria de San Juan de la Cruz**, Sacerdote y Doctor de la Iglesia.

Seguimos centrándonos en las primeras lecturas de esta primera parte de Adviento. Del Libro de Números, tenemos la proclamación de que "una estrella avanzará desde Jacob ..." Sofonías es el profeta de la perdición inminente, si la gente no abandona su idolatría. Pero esta semana leemos acerca de la curación consoladora, "en ese día", cuando el Señor venga. El mensaje de Isaías está lleno de promesas: "Vuélvete a mí y mantente seguro ... porque yo soy Dios; ¡no hay otro!"

El jueves llegamos al 17 de diciembre y en estos últimos ocho días de Adviento el enfoque vuelve a los evangelios con historias de la familia de Jesús antes de su nacimiento. El evangelio de Mateo ofrece la genealogía de la familia de Jesús. El día 18 leemos el relato de Mateo sobre la natividad: José decide divorciarse de la María embarazada hasta que un ángel se le aparece en un sueño y le dice: "Es por el Espíritu Santo que este niño ha sido concebido en ella". El 19, en el primer capítulo del evangelio de Lucas, Isabel y Zacarías luchan con su incapacidad para tener un hijo. Se les dice que tendrán un hijo llamado Juan que será lleno del Espíritu Santo. Cuando Zacarías duda, se queda sin habla.

El cuarto domingo de Adviento comienza la última semana de Adviento, que nos lleva a la Navidad el sábado. La lectura de Miqueas nos recuerda que de la aparentemente insignificante ciudad de Belén, "de ti me saldrá uno que será el gobernante de Israel". El evangelio de Lucas ofrece nuevamente la historia de que María va a visitar a su prima. Isabel comprende inmediatamente la situación de María y alaba a Dios diciendo: "¿Cómo me pasa esto, que la madre de mi Señor venga a mí? Porque en el momento en que el sonido de tu saludo llegó a mis oídos, el niño en mi vientre saltó de alegría. . "

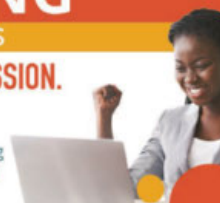
