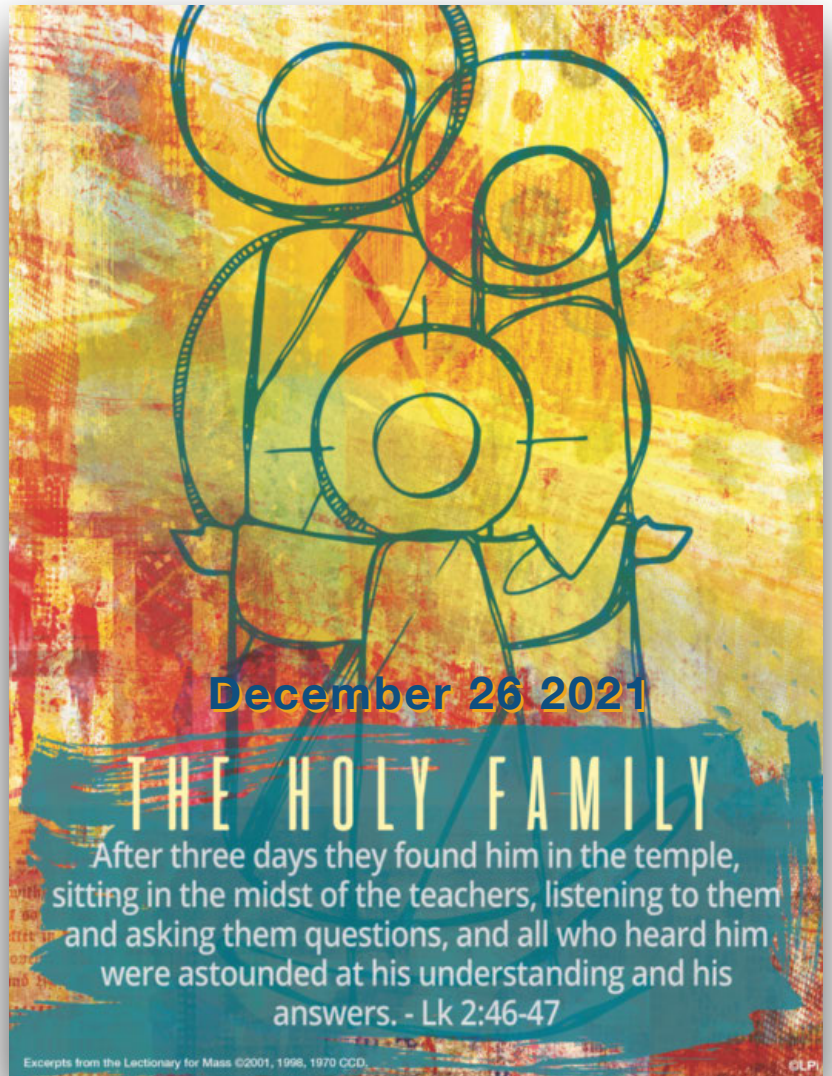

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

Families can be very difficult things to negotiate. This is true not only of our families of origin, the current family of which we are a part, the family of our Church, our society, and our global family as well. Everything human can be found in family stories. Those stories speak of wonderful life-giving successes as well as painful spirit-robbing abuses. Our greatest joys and our greatest wounds are usually connected with the experience of family. Our needs, experiences, and unresolved baggage often color what we bring to our familiar relationships. They contribute to our level of defensiveness, how guarded and protected we become, and what prejudices we believe.

In order to break the cycle of dysfunction we have to remember that it is not only by human effort that we negotiate the difficult and challenging events of our lives. There is a Divine Effort at work as well. For sure, the human effort can create quite a mess and easily destroy lives. This is true of any family with which we are associated. Today's Feast of the Holy Family serves to help us understand that there is a Divine Story being told as well. It is a story of perseverance in the face of hardship, determination in the face of despair, healing when we see nothing but wounds, and light where there is darkness.

Do we believe that God is always working, guiding, restoring, and leading? Unless we do, we will never be free from the imperfections and wounds that bind us and never be able to understand what it really means to forgive. Pope Francis tells us that the "light which comes from the Holy Family encourages us to offer human warmth to other families." While this is most certainly true, we can only really begin to do this when we realize that we are still works in progress, not anchored to the wounds and sins of our past, and still a leading star in God's continually unfolding story of love. The Holy Family persevered and radiated warmth because they knew they were not alone. We can too.

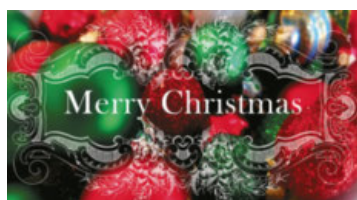

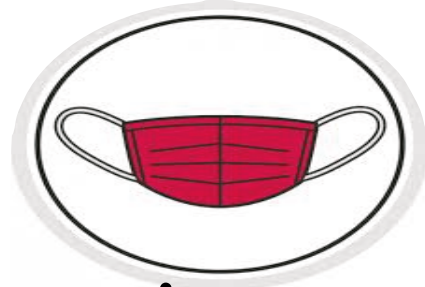

St. Stephen | Feast Day December 26

The Acts of the Apostles tells the story of St. Stephen, the first Christian martyr. A man filled with grace and power, he worked great wonders among the people. Some Jews debated with St. Stephen but could not match his wisdom and spirit. Eventually, a charge of blasphemy was brought up against him, and the local population demanded that he be tried and sentenced. He was seized and carried before the Sanhedrin.

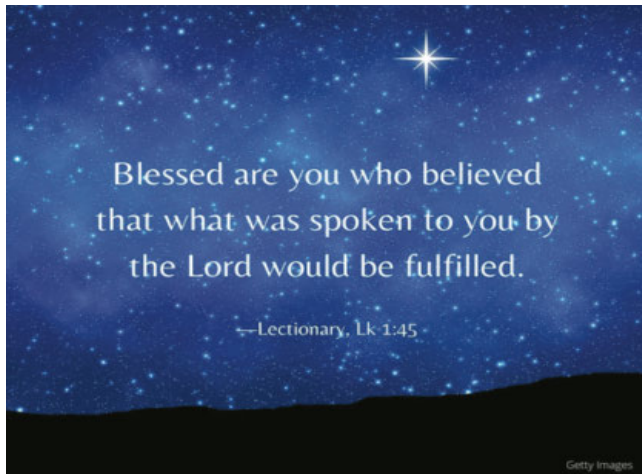
Despite the danger he faced, in front of the Sanhedrin and his accusers, St. Stephen gave a long speech about the history of Israel and the blessings that God had given upon His chosen people. He talked about how Israel had become disobedient despite God's abundant mercy. This enraged his accusers, and eventually the crowd dragged him out of the city and stoned him to death.

Even in his final moments, St. Stephen displayed great forgiveness and even asked God not to hold the sins of his attackers against them. Hundreds of years after his death, he is still a role model for us to follow. ©LPi

Todo lo humano se puede encontrar en las historias familiares. Esas historias hablan de éxitos maravillosos que dan vida, así como de abusos dolorosos que roban el espíritu. Nuestras mayores alegrías y nuestras mayores heridas suelen estar conectadas con la experiencia de la familia. Nuestras necesidades, experiencias y bagajes no resueltos a menudo dan color a lo que aportamos a nuestras relaciones familiares. Contribuyen a nuestro nivel de actitud defensiva, cuán cautelosos y protegidos nos volvemos, y qué prejuicios creemos.

Para romper el ciclo de disfunción, debemos recordar que no es solo mediante el esfuerzo humano que negociamos los eventos difíciles y desafiantes de nuestras vidas. También hay un Esfuerzo Divino en acción. Sin duda, el esfuerzo humano puede crear un gran lío y destruir vidas fácilmente. Esto es cierto para cualquier familia con la que estemos asociados. La Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia de hoy sirve para ayudarnos a comprender que también se está contando una Historia Divina. Es una historia de perseverancia frente a las dificultades, determinación frente a la desesperación, curación cuando no vemos nada más que heridas y luz donde hay tinieblas.

¿Creemos que Dios siempre está trabajando, guiando, restaurando y dirigiendo? A menos que lo hagamos, nunca seremos libres de las imperfecciones y heridas que nos atan y nunca seremos capaces de comprender lo que realmente significa perdonar. El Papa Francisco nos dice que “la luz que viene de la Sagrada Familia nos anima a ofrecer calidez humana a otras familias”. Si bien esto es ciertamente cierto, solo podemos realmente comenzar a hacer esto cuando nos damos cuenta de que todavía estamos en obras en progreso, no anclados en las heridas y pecados de nuestro pasado, y aún somos una estrella principal en la historia de amor de Dios que se desarrolla continuamente. La Sagrada Familia perseveró e irradió calidez porque sabían que no estaban solos. Nosotros también podemos.



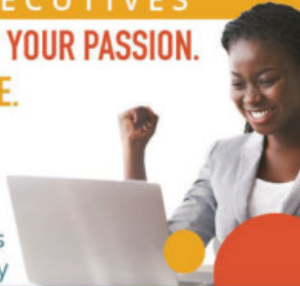

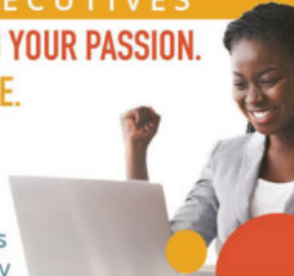
