

Community Connections Mentoring is a communitybased program for youth ages kindergarten through 7th grade. Mentoring pairs have the flexibility of meeting at any of your favorite public locations around town or during school lunch and time together can include our monthly group activities and community service projects.

Research confirms that quality mentoring relationships have powerful positive effects on young people in a variety of personal, academic, and professional situations. Unfortunately, one in three young people will grow up without any type of mentor. And with each additional risk factor a young person experiences, the less likely he or she will connect with a mentor. To close this gap, it will take everyone from parents, students and teachers to counselors, coaches and family friends – anyone who has a touch point in a young person's life.

#### What does it take to be a mentor?

- · Have the willingness to listen and offer encouragement
- Ability to share what you've learned about life
- Be 18 or older and reside in Lincoln County
- Complete the application and matching process
- Spend 4 to 8 hours a monthly interacting with your mentee learn a new skill together, walk the dog, run errands, have ice cream, get to know each other and have some fun!
- Be consistent and reliable, expect some ups and downs, and be willing to learn as you go



When youth in our program were asked "What is the best thing about having a mentor?" they responded:



"Being nicer, being happier, being more responsible."

"That adults don't have to be just family. They can be friends and help you out."

"I'm more confident. I used to think I didn't deserve a spot in the world, but now I do."

"I've learned how to golf, kinds of trees, different restaurant. I've learned to compare books I've read to movies that I see with my mentor."

Mentoring, at its core, guarantees young people that there is someone who cares about them, assures them they are not alone in dealing with day-to-day challenges, and makes them feel like they matter.





#### RECIPE

#### **Oma's Rhubarb Cake**

**Ingredients** 

#### Cake:

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 ¼ cups white sugar

1 teaspoon baking soda

½ teaspoon salt

2 eggs, beaten

1 cup sour cream

3 cups diced rhubarb

#### Streusel:

1 cup white sugar

¼ cup butter, softened

¼ cup all-purpose flour

¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon, or to taste



#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease and flour a 9x13-inch baking dish.
- 2. Make cake: Stir together flour, sugar, baking soda, and salt in a large bowl. Stir in eggs and sour cream until smooth, then fold in rhubarb. Pour into the prepared dish and spread evenly.
- 3. Make streusel: Stir together sugar and butter in a medium bowl until smooth. Stir in flour until mixture is crumbly. Sprinkle mixture on top of cake, then dust lightly with cinnamon.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, about 45 minutes.





## 1. August was once the 6th month of the year and named "Sextilis", meaning the 6th month in Latin. 2. August once had only 29 days until Julius Caesar introduced the Julian calendar and changed it to 31. 3. In 8 B.C. the month was named Augustus in honor of the Roman Emperor. In a standard year there is no other month that begins on the same day of the week as August. In Leap Year, August begins on the same day as February. 5. In the Southern hemisphere it is considered the last month of Winter. 7. In the days of the Anglo-Saxons, the month was called Weod Monath. Meaning "Weed Month", weeds and other plants grow the fastest in the Northern hemisphere. 8. On August 1st, Lammas Day is celebrated as the first day of harvest in the U.K. 9. On August 6, 1762, the first ever sandwich was created. It was named after the Earl of Sandwich. 10. August has 2 star signs. If you were born before August 22nd, you are a Leo. 
