

The Pope's Prayer Intention for June

Families : We pray for Christian families around the world; may they embody and experience unconditional love and advance in holiness in their daily lives.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today's Gospel reading begins a long section unique to Luke's Gospel. Immediately Jesus is met with rejection, as a Samaritan village will not receive him because he is going to Jerusalem. There was animosity between Samaritans who worshiped on Mount Gerazim and Jews who worshiped in Jerusalem. James and John want to call down fire from heaven to destroy the people in the village, but Jesus rebukes them and moves on. There is often the temptation to use violence to achieve right. Jesus has come to break this temptation. He is aware that he must undergo violence himself before he can enter his glory.

The rest of today's reading is about the radical demands of discipleship. The three people who volunteer to become disciples on this journey show that they do not understand the demands Jesus will make of them. Neither care of self, care for the dead, nor care of one's family (as required by the Fourth Commandment) can come before the demands of discipleship. Jesus reminds the first volunteer, who would go wherever Jesus goes, that animals in the wild have more security than do Jesus and his followers. The second, who wants to bury a parent, is reminded that the demands of proclaiming the Kingdom of God take precedence. And the third, who wants to say farewell to his family, is reminded that once you put your hand to the plow you cannot look back or the furrow will be crooked. Such a person is not ready for the Kingdom of God.

Jesus seems harsh here, but he is only asking of his disciples what he asks of himself. Jesus' unconditional commitment to God's saving work will demand of him his life. He knows this, but the disciples do not understand. Jesus does not want anyone to rush into discipleship, because the demands of discipleship require everyone considering it to be aware of the cost, make Jesus and his mission central to his life, and then go forward without looking back.



VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS FOR PANTRY OPERATIONS VOLUNTEERS:

- Under 18 years old Can volunteer at the pantry if accompanied by a parent/guardian. The parent/guardian is required to stay with the child. The parent/guardian is also required to be Safe Environment trained.
- **18 and older** You will need to be Safe Environment trained. This is an online class and is required to participate in any of the ministries at St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church. The class takes no more than 90 minutes to complete. Visit CMGConnect to register and complete the training.
- Closed-toe shoes (no sandals) are required.
- Physical requirements depending on task: Standing for a long period of time (2-3 hours), lifting up to 20-30 pounds, bending over often to reach for food items, standing outside in the heat/cold, loading/unloading supplies, moving continuously.

Frederic and his Catholic friends were challenged with the question: "What is your church doing today to meet the needs of society and the poor?". Society of St Vincent De Paul was organized in 1833 in Paris, and quickly spread in Europe (Italy, England, etc), before coming to the United States in 1845 in St Louis.

SVDP AT ST. ANTHONY'S

- Approximately 50 members
- Meet twice a month on the 1st and 3rd Sundays.
- We are active for 3 out of 4 weeks in a month
- We provide funds for rent, utilities, car payments, furniture, medicine & more.
- We often work with the St. Anthony's Bread food pantry to provide food.

• Our individual responsibilities include answering phones, scheduling and conducting home visits, pledging funds

- and paying client bills.We conduct roughly 8 to 12 home visits per week
- We distribute \$8,000 to \$10,000 per week, based on the donations received from the parish to the SVDP ministry
