

## MESSAGE FROM FR. DAVID

Hola, my dear parish family! I am just over halfway through my Spanish Immersion Program. I want to give you a progress report. Upon arrival, a language skills evaluation was done. Sadly, after about week, I was having difficulties with my conversational and listening skills. For this reason, they reassigned me to a lower level so that I could concentrate and improve those skills. To help, I have been assigned a tutor in addition to the classroom learning.

My schedule: I wake up at 6 a.m. every day. I have my morning Holy Hour and then I get ready for the day. Classes begin at 8 a.m. and last until 1 p.m. After lunch and a short siesta, I study independently and have time for a tutoring session. I take a break to say my rosary and then I get back to work. At 5 p.m., I begin preparing for Holy Mass, which I celebrate in Spanish every day. I pray for you, my parish family, and your intentions. After Holy Mass, I walk back to the school, praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and then go eat dinner with the other students. (At meals we all try to speak and use our vocabulary.) At 8:30 p.m. is an activity, usually a movie so we can work on our listening skills. After that, I do a bit more homework, then I say my evening prayers and go to bed.

I very much look forward to returning home, to the parish. I miss you all! Thank you for your prayers for me. Again, know of my prayers for you.

¡Hola, mi querida familia parroquial! Estoy a poco más de la mitad de mi programa de inmersión en español. Quiero darles un informe de miprogreso. A mi llegada, realizé una evaluación de habilidades lingüísticas. Lamentablemente, después de aproximadamente una semana, estaba teniendo dificultades con mis habilidades para conversar y escuchar. Por esta razón, me reasignaron a un nivel inferior para que pudiera concentrarme y mejorar esas habilidades. Para ayudar, me han asignado un tutor además del aprendizaje en el aula.

Mi horario: me despierto a las 6 a.m. todos los días. Tengo mi Hora Santa matutina y luego me

preparo para el día. Las clases comienzan a las 8 a.m. y duran hasta la 1p.m. Después del almuerzo y una breve siesta, estudio de forma independiente y tengo tiempo para una sesión de tutoría. Me tomo un descanso para rezar el Santo Rosario y luego vuelvo al trabajo. A las 5:00 p.m., empiezo a practicar las oraciones y a prepararme para la Santa Misa, que celebro en español todos los días. Rezo por ustedes, mi familia parroquial, y sus intenciones. Después de la Santa Misa, camino de regreso a la escuela, rezo la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia y luego voy a cenar con los otros estudiantes. (En las comidas todos tratamos de hablar y usar nuestro vocabulario). A las 8:30 p. m. hay una actividad, generalmente una película, para que podamos trabajar en nuestras habilidades auditivas. Después de eso, hago un poco más de tarea, luego rezo mis oraciones vespertinas y me acuesto.

Tengo muchas ganas de volver a casa, a la parroquia. ¡Los extraño a todos! Gracias por sus oraciones por mí. Una vez más, cuenta con mis oraciones por ustedes. ¡Que Dios los bendiga abundantemente a todos!

#### VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS FOR PANTRY OPERATIONS VOLUNTEERS:

- Under 18 years old Can volunteer at the pantry if accompanied by a parent/guardian. The parent/guardian is required to stay with the child. The parent/guardian is also required to be Safe Environment trained.
- **18 and older** You will need to be Safe Environment trained. This is an online class and is required to participate in any of the ministries at St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church. The class takes no more than 90 minutes to complete. Visit CMGConnect to register and complete the training.
- Closed-toe shoes (no sandals) are required.
- Physical requirements depending on task: Standing for a long period of time (2-3 hours), lifting up to 20-30 pounds, bending over often to reach for food items, standing outside in the heat/cold, loading/unloading supplies, moving continuously.

The Society of SVDP is a Catholic lay organization, which leads women/men to join together to **grow spiritually** by offering **person to person service** to the needy and suffering in the traditions of founder, Frederic Ozanam and patron St. Vincent De Paul.

#### THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

The Founder of the Society of SVDP was Frederic Ozanam. Frederic and his Catholic friends were challenged with the question: "What is your church doing today to meet the needs of society and the poor?". Society of St Vincent De Paul was organized in 1833 in Paris, and quickly spread in Europe (Italy, England, etc), before coming to the United States in 1845 in St Louis.

#### SVDP AT ST. ANTHONY'S

- Approximately 50 members
- Meet twice a month on the 1st and 3rd Sundays.
- We are active for 3 out of 4 weeks in a month
- We provide funds for rent, utilities, car payments, furniture, medicine & more.
- We often work with the St. Anthony's Bread food pantry to provide food.

• Our individual responsibilities include answering phones, scheduling and conducting home visits, pledging funds

- and paying client bills.We conduct roughly 8 to 12 home visits per week
- We distribute \$8,000 to \$10,000 per week, based on the donations received from the parish to the SVDP ministry


