## CLERGY CORNER Deacon Mike Daniels

### A CALL TO RADICAL TRUST

Jesus gave instructions to His disciples to "take nothing for the journey but a walking stick—no food, no sack, no money in their belts." Do you think He would include our smartphones on the list if He were sending us out today? How many of us could imagine setting out for even one day taking nothing with us: No food, no purse or wallet, no change of clothes, no phone, no money, no checkbook or credit cards. Can you imagine it? Can you imagine the trust those disciples had that God would provide? It was incredible. His disciples left Jesus that day, taking nothing with them. Could we set out for just one day taking nothing with us? Not me!

What do you think the point was? You have to believe He was telling them—and He is telling us—don't let possessions so clutter your life that they get in the way of doing what is important to God—sharing your faith with others!

Years ago, some young Christians were attending an international summer camp. They came from many nations around the world. One project assigned them was to come up with practical ways to preach the Gospel in our modern world. After the young people talked about using television, radio, the Internet, and rock concerts, an African girl said something that touched the heart of everyone. She said, "When Christians in my country think a pagan village is ready for Christianity, they don't send books or missionaries. They send a good Christian family. And the example of the family converts the village."

I think that's what the Gospel is saying today. Our call is to have such radical trust in God that it changes the people with whom we come in contact. Like this young African woman's example, God wants us in our homes, workplaces, and communities to preach the Gospel by living a life that trusts God will provide what we need. We can be missionaries to our world by our presence and by our example more than by our words. The poet Edgar Guest had it right when he said years ago:

It is all in vain to preach the truth,  
To the eager ears of trusting youth.  
Fine words may grace the advice you give,  
But youth will learn from the way you live.



- Kids—3 kids, 10 grandkids, lots of great grandkids, and 1 great great grandchild
- Currently lives at Fredericka Manor in Chula Vista



### What brought you here?

I was born on July 2, 1921 in Buffalo, New York to parents William and Ethel Milton. We moved to Pacific Beach (1428 Law Street) when I was 13 because my father got a job at General Dynamics. At the time, the closest Catholic Church was Mary, Star of the Sea in La Jolla. At that time the Bishop ordered a census of Pacific Beach to find out how many Catholics were living here. So two other girls and I (we were in our late teens at the time) went door-to-door doing the census. This census eventually resulted in Saint Brigid Parish being formed in 1940 and the first Church and rectory being built. My daughter Patricia was the second child ever to be baptized here—and missed being the first by only two weeks! Years later, my family donated a stain glass window, in the current Church, which can be seen above the altar on the south side.

### What is your favorite type of prayer?

My favorite prayer is the Prayer of St. Francis (Lord, make me an instrument of your peace...). Also, novenas to Our Lady have always held me up during times of health problems.

### Who influenced your faith?

Sister Justine was a great friend and teacher at the school—yes, St. B's used to have a school. We

would go on bike rides as far as Torrey Pines. One time I was privileged to go on a camping retreat with Sr. Justine and her other religious sisters and I was the only one who wasn't a nun! Years later, Sr. Justine invited me to spend time with her but I was busy. But at that moment I saw big "headlines" in front of my eyes that said, "take time". So I did and we spent the day together—she died suddenly the next day.

### What spiritual experiences have influenced your faith?

Prayer retreats with Sister Justine and other friends at the Prince of Peace Abbey and Mission San Luis Rey—good memories of smuggling in wine.



The italicized sections explain posture, plain text is the priest's or leader's part, and bold text denotes our response as the gathered Body of Christ.

## THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

During this part of the Mass, we hear God's Word proclaimed. We listen to preaching, which makes Scripture come alive again today, and we express our Catholic faith.

### INTRODUCTORY RITE

*Please stand for the entrance and opening hymn.*

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The grace of our Lord...be with you all.

And with your spirit.

### PENITENTIAL RITE

Brothers and sisters...celebrate the sacred mysteries I confess to almighty God, and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask the blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

*Repeat after the priest:*

Lord Have Mercy. Christ have mercy. Lord Have Mercy.

OR Kyrie, eleison. Christe, eleison. Kyrie, eleison.

### GLORIA

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise You, we bless You, we adore You, we glorify You, we give You thanks for Your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, You take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; You take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; You are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For You alone are the Holy One, You alone are the Lord, You alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

*Please sit to receive the Word of God.*

*Please sit as we listen to a reflection from the clergy.*

### PROFESSION OF FAITH

*Please stand as we proclaim the creed together.*

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through Him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation He came down from heaven, \*and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. \*(*please bow during this profession*) For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, He suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and His kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

### UNIVERSAL PRAYER

*Please stand as we pray for our community, united with the entire Body of Christ.*

After each intention, repeat the response said by the reader.

## THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

In this part of the Mass, we re-experience Jesus' sacrifice. We acknowledge that He is present in the consecrated Bread and Wine—Communion. We pray together and take what we have received in Mass home and into the world.

### THE OFFERTORY

*As we bring up the bread and wine, we also offer our prayers, gifts, and even ourselves to be placed before God and be transformed.*

### PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS

Blessed are You, Lord... the bread of life.

Blessed be God forever.

Blessed are You, Lord... become our spiritual drink.

Blessed be God forever.

Pray...to God, the almighty Father.

*Please stand and reply:*

May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of His name, for our good and the good of all His holy Church.

### EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

The Lord be with you. **And with your spirit.**

Lift up your hearts. We lift them up to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right and just.

### HOLY, HOLY, HOLY

Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord, God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of Your glory. Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.

Hosanna in the highest.

*Please kneel in reverence for Christ coming in His Eucharist.*

...The mystery of faith.

We proclaim Your Death, O Lord, and profess Your Resurrection until You come again.

OR When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim Your Death, O Lord, until You come again.

OR Save us, Savior of the world, for by Your Cross and Resurrection, You have set us free.

*Please stand as we pray together.*

### THE LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Deliver us, Lord ... Jesus Christ.

For the kingdom, the power and the glory are Yours now and forever.

### THE SIGN OF PEACE

The peace of the Lord be with you always.

**And with your spirit.**

Let us offer each other the sign of peace.

*At this time we usually exchange a sign of sharing God's peace by offering a handshake, hug, or similar gesture with those around us. However during these days of COVID protocols, please offer a wave or a nod of the head or other socially-distant expression of peace.*

### LAMB OF GOD

Lamb of God, You take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. 2x

*Please kneel as we prepare to receive the Body of Christ.*

Non-Catholics or those choosing to abstain from Communion are welcome to come forward for a blessing (please indicate this by crossing your arms over your chest) or may remain in the pews to pray.*
