**THE TWELFTH DAY OF CHRISTMAS** is the solemn feast of the Epiphany, January 6. In the United States, the celebration of the Epiphany is transferred to a Sunday so that all may celebrate. The word *epiphany* comes from the Greek and means "revelation," and so we celebrate the revelation of Christ to the magi, who were gentiles and did not belong to the people of Israel.

Learn this Appalachian folk song in honor of the star that guided the magi to the Christ child. Find out if anyone you know is familiar with it and could teach it to you. (Take the time!) Or check a local record store's folk section. (If that fails, try shopping around on the Internet.) The words are:

Bright mornin' star's arisin'  
Bright mornin' star's arisin'  
Bright mornin' star's arisin'  
Day is breakin' in my soul.

The daily prayer of the Orthodox churches gives us these lovely verses for the solemn feast of the Epiphany:

The magi who had been led on their way by a divine star  
stood before you in wonder at your marvelous birth;  
and bearing gifts they see the sun  
who rose from the virgin cloud.  
Let the people who sat in darkness  
see shining forth the light that knows no evening,  
him whom the stars once manifested  
to the fire-worshiping Persian kings.

Glory in heaven and peace on earth, now and forever!

### LOS REYES MAGOS

Es una tradición muy arraigada en los países latinoamericanos, celebrar el 6 de enero a los "Reyes Magos", recordando aquel episodio del Evangelio en el que unos Magos de Oriente llegaron a adorar y dar regalos a Jesús "Rey de los Judíos", según la manifestación de una gran estrella. (Cf. Mt 2, 1-12) Esta fiesta es una tradición cargada de significado. En realidad celebramos la Manifestación del Señor a todo el mundo, es decir la Epifanía. Dios se les revela, no sólo a los pastores, no sólo a los judíos, también a aquellos hombres de ciencia, ricos y poderosos que se ponen en camino desde tierras lejanas, en busca de la estrella que interpretan como una manifestación de la presencia de Dios; significa que el Hijo de Dios debe ser reconocido por todos los hombres, de todos los lugares, de todos los tiempos. Los Magos de Oriente se posan ante Jesús Niño y lo adoran, con sus regalos hablan de lo que ellos encuentran en Él: El oro se le ofrece sólo a los reyes, por lo que reconocen en Jesús al Rey; el incienso se le ofrece sólo a Dios, por lo que revelan que Jesús es Dios; y la mirra es un perfume que reconoce en Jesús Rey, Hijo de Dios, también a un Hombre. Es una bella historia que merece nuestra reflexión. Además de que es una oportunidad para continuar meditando en el gran Misterio de la Encarnación, y para compartir en familia las bendiciones y gracias que este milagro nos trajo.

### Tradición.

La tradición mexicana nos invita a compartir la "Rosca de Reyes", costumbre también llena de significados importantes: el pan en forma de rosca evoca a Dios Eterno, que no tiene principio ni fin; las frutas dulces con que se decora nos recuerdan la gracia que Jesús nos trae; el muñequito escondido entre la masa representa al Niño Jesús que todos debemos buscar, quien lo encuentra se llena de tanto gozo que desea compartirlo con todos, por lo que promete una fiesta el próximo día dos de febrero, día de la "Candelaria" (luz) o Presentación del Señor. Jesús es la "Luz para iluminar a todos los pueblos" (Lc 2, 32). Y los bautizados hemos sido iluminados con esa Luz de Cristo.

Los cristianos siempre tenemos el compromiso de buscar, encontrar y compartir a Jesús con los demás.

## POPE'S LETTER TO MARRIED COUPLES: THE MAGISTERIUM OF A LOVING FATHER

On the feast day of the Holy Family of Nazareth, Pope Francis presented his Letter to Married Couples. This text comes exactly one year after announcing the "Amoris Laetitia Family Year." It is a path rich in fruits and marked by the tenderness of a father, a tenderness that is renewed in a "magisterium text."

In the letter that he sent to married couples as a gift, Pope Francis goes through aspects and stages of family life, without forgetting young couples preparing for marriage, with the tone of a father. It is evident the tenderness of the tone, the affection he expresses for families in such a difficult time, the pandemic still dominates that. Today there are so many families experiencing crises and difficulties of all kinds, to whom the Pope turns his fatherly gaze. But I am particularly struck by his attention to the Sacrament of Marriage. The beauty of this gift, so difficult for young people to understand today, lies in the presence of Christ, who dwells in families amid our daily lives. And with extraordinary delicacy, the Pope enters into our daily lives, into family dynamics, almost taking us by the hand to encourage us and make us not feel alone in this journey. And he invites young people to marry, to trust in the grace that invests spouses, a grace that sustains them throughout their lives in the adventure of marriage, even during storms. After all, the Pope reminds us that "*in no way must the Church desist from proposing the full ideal of marriage, God's plan in all its grandeur. Not to do so would be a lack of love on the part of the Church for young people. Understanding exceptional situations must never imply hiding the light of the fullest ideal, nor proposing less than what Jesus offers to human beings.*" The Holy Father reminds us of this in Amoris Laetitia." (AL 307).

En el día de la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret, el Papa Francisco presentó su Carta a los Matrimonios. Este texto llega exactamente un año después de anunciar el "Año de la Familia Amoris Laetitia". Es un camino rico en frutos y marcado por la ternura de un padre, una ternura que se renueva en un "texto de magisterio".

En la carta que envió a los matrimonios como regalo, el Papa Francisco recorre aspectos y etapas de la vida familiar, sin olvidar a las parejas jóvenes que se preparan para el matrimonio, con tono de padre.

Es evidente la ternura del tono, el cariño que expresa a las familias en un momento tan difícil, la pandemia aún domina eso. Son tantas las familias que atraviesan hoy crisis y dificultades de todo tipo, hacia las que el Papa dirige su mirada paternal. Pero me llama particularmente la atención su atención al sacramento del matrimonio. La belleza de este don, tan difícil de comprender para los jóvenes de hoy, reside en la presencia de Cristo, que habita en familias en medio de nuestra vida cotidiana. Y con extraordinaria delicadeza, el Papa entra en nuestra vida cotidiana, en la dinámica familiar, casi llevándonos de la mano para animarnos y hacer que no nos sintamos solos en este camino. E invita a los jóvenes a casarse, a confiar en la gracia que reviste a los cónyuges, gracia que los sostiene a lo largo de la vida en la aventura del matrimonio, incluso durante las tormentas. Al fin y al cabo, el Papa nos recuerda que "*la Iglesia no debe desistir en modo alguno de proponer el ideal pleno del matrimonio, el plan de Dios en toda su grandeza. No hacerlo sería una falta de amor de la Iglesia hacia los jóvenes. Comprender situaciones excepcionales no debe implicar jamás ocultar la luz del ideal más pleno, ni proponer menos de lo que Jesús ofrece a los seres humanos*". El Santo Padre nos lo recuerda en Amoris Laetitia "(AL 307).


