



# STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

## When Our Own Hour Comes

We parents know that it's tricky, tackling the topic of fear with our kids. We want them to know that it's okay to be scared, that it's something we all feel from time to time. We want them to understand that bravery isn't the absence of fear, but the choices we make in persevering despite that feeling.

Most of all, we want to model the right kind of behavior for our kids. Whatever our scary situation is — illness, a job loss, life changes — we want them to see us make a choice to face that fear head-on.

Jesus seems to be the parent who is gently broaching the topic of fear with his children. A great sense of foreboding hangs over these readings. Jesus knew what was coming. He knew it was going to be hard, both for him and for his followers, who did not have his courage. Even he admits to being “troubled” and he speaks of “the time of judgment.” There is the dramatic raising of Lazarus, the talk of how a grain of wheat must die in order to bear fruit, the depiction of Christ as an obedient student of his own suffering.

“Yet what should I say?” he asks them. “Father, save me from this hour?’ But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour.”

This week, Christ gives us a very parental gift: He shows us his fear, and he shows us how to conquer it. He challenges us to embrace the purpose for which we came to this hour — whatever that hour may hold.

## Jesus Died That We Might Find Life

*“Truly, truly I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit”* (John 12:24). As we come closer to the celebration of the Passion of the Lord, Sunday’s liturgy invites us to be active pilgrims of faith in the celebrations to come - not just passive spectators. The quote from the Gospel of St. John draws us into the mystery of the passion, death, and Resurrection of Christ. For many eyewitnesses, the bloody death of Christ on the cross on Good Friday was just like the death of any other lawbreaker in the land. But in obedience to the perfect will of God the Father, and out of love for us, Jesus laid down his life. Through His singular death, Jesus will draw millions into a new and eternal covenant. He is the perfect offering for our sins.

Therefore, as we move into the high point of the Lenten Season, let us recall the ultimate sacrifice of Christ for us. We are also invited to return love for love by offering ourselves totally to the Lord. We are challenged to die to our negative ambitions, our pride, and our tendency to sometimes dominate others. Self-discovery is the first step towards self-transcendence. Though spiritual growth is a challenging task, the result is union with God. We bow down to God’s transforming power as we ask Him for the grace to die to self, that His grace may increase in us.

This year has been a very challenging year for everyone. Many families continue to mourn the passing of their loved ones. May the Lord Jesus, who laid down his life for us, grant them the courage and strength they so desire at this time. May all those who sleep in Christ find in God’s presence the light, happiness, and joy of eternal life.

## Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

### The Good News

In today's Gospel, Jesus announces, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified." But this glorification will take place only after his suffering and Death on the Cross. Jesus uses the example of a grain of wheat that only produces fruit when it falls to the ground and dies. He promises that those who die to themselves by serving him will know the reward of eternal life.

### Reflect

Draw a timeline of your life in five- or ten-year increments (from birth to age ten, from ten to twenty, from twenty to thirty, and so forth). Leave room on the timeline to note any experiences of suffering, pain, and sorrow that you recall. Perhaps one of your parents died at a young age, a favorite pet died, your childhood friend moved away, or you lost your job.

After you complete your timeline, review it again and note the good that came after the times of suffering. Consider that two of the most important and most valuable lessons you can teach your children are to let go and to trust that good will come after or as a result of what may seem too difficult to bear.

### Share

Talk about recent or well-known news stories highlighting those who gave their lives so that others might live. Older family members will recall 9/11, and younger children may remember special collections they took part in for victims of hurricanes, fires, floods, and other natural disasters.

Pray for all who have given their lives so that others might live.

We are open in a **limited capacity**. Currently, we are able to take **264 people per Mass**. Our Mass Schedule is Monday-Friday (8:00 AM), Tuesday evening (6:00 PM), Saturday (8:00 AM, 4:30 PM), and Sunday (8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, 12:00 Noon, 2:00 PM).

We are also able to offer Confession by appointment. **Reservations are required for all Masses. To make a reservation for Mass, you can sign-up online using the links on our homepage ([www.stjosephhom.org](http://www.stjosephhom.org)) or call the parish office during business hours.** Per Diocesan policy, we are required to lock the doors once Mass begins. We ask that those with reservations arrive 25-30 minutes early so that everyone can be well-checked and seated on time. Thank you for your help.

This week the parish office is open Monday - Friday from 8:30 AM - 4:00 PM, and Sundays from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM. During this time the church is not open for prayer outside of the Mass. Masks must be worn at all times while on our property. Everyone is required to pass a temperature check. We look forward to welcoming you!




## Watch Sunday Mass Online

### Stewardship Saint for March: Lucy Filippini

Lucy Filippini was born on January 13, 1672, in Corneto-Tarquinoa, Italy, to a wealthy, aristocratic family. Both her parents died when she was still young and she was cared for by an aunt and uncle. Growing up, she cultivated a habit of daily prayer, practiced religious devotions and dedicated herself to the Blessed Mother.

Located in Lucy's neighborhood was a women's Benedictine community, and Lucy spent much of her time there. The community had a school where the daughters of the wealthy were educated. She was an excellent student, took advantage of the many religious education opportunities, and found the serenity of the community a place that fostered her spiritual growth. Her teachers and companions alike were moved by her humility, kindness and compassionate nature.

Into Lucy's life stepped Cardinal Mark Anthony Barbarigo, one of seventeenth century Italy's great religious figures. He has been favorably compared to Saints Frances de Sales and Charles Borromeo. Upon making his first pastoral visit to Corneto, he made a lasting impression on Lucy. She gave up her life in Corneto in order to help him realize his vision

for establishing centers to educate and evangelize young girls, especially those from impoverished families. He believed young women were the future of the Church.

At the age of 20, Lucy plunged headlong into the plans to establish schools that not only would educate young women, but would show them how to influence a healthy and faith-filled family life. In 1692, teachers were trained to staff what soon became a proliferation of women's Catholic learning centers. Fifty-two schools were established during Lucy's lifetime. As the community grew, it attracted the attention of Pope Clement XI who, in 1707, called Lucy to Rome to establish schools there as well.

Lucy passed away on the Feast of the Annunciation, March 25, 1732, at the age of 60. In 1930, she was canonized and given the last available niche in Saint Peter's Basilica. Hailed as the foundress of the Pontifical Institute of Religious Teachers, her legacy goes far beyond Italy. The Institute's mission has spread into other parts of Europe, the United States, Brazil, Ethiopia, and India.

Her feast day is March 25.
