## Walk Every Step with Christ

Holy Week is a week for being mindful. We must set loose the baggage of Lent, and not be deterred by the dazzling sunrise of Easter morning beckoning in the distance.

It's okay for us to be excited for Easter. We've waited so long. In my opinion it's one of the best feelings there is: the yearning we have in our hearts for the Resurrection as we embark on Palm Sunday. And in a purely logical sense, many of us have Easter celebrations for which we are preparing, and practical considerations to contend with. It's going to be a busy week, one likely full of happy distractions.

But my friends, we simply must keep our feet on the ground. Let's not "skip" Holy Week. Resist the urge to flip to the last page of the book, to fast-forward to the final scene of the movie. Don't rob yourself of the journey. This week is a blessed opportunity. It is this week that teaches us who we are. In the span of the Triduum, we have the birthday of the priesthood, the institution of the Eucharist, the sacrifice on Calvary and so many other vivid and meaningful scenes.

It may sound strange, to advise someone to savor the moments of Holy Week. There are so many violent and heartrending moments, after all. But this is the valley of tears, remember — we are not in Heaven yet. And here, in our fallen, sin-filled world, it is the heartrending moments that seem to matter the most.

These are the moments that define us as Catholics. Live them. Cherish them. Be present for each one.

## Jesus Brings Us Life Through Death

Palms had a symbolic meaning to the ancient Israelites. They were used in the celebration of the Feast of Tabernacles, the Jewish thanksgiving celebration held at the end of the agricultural season at the period of harvesting the grapes and olives. Palms were also used by the Maccabees to celebrate their victory over the ancient Greeks.

The palms we use in the celebration of Palm Sunday are a symbol of peace and eternal life. They are also a symbol of the victorious and triumphant death of Christ for us. They remind us that the death of Christ brings us peace and shall lead us to Eternal Life. ***"Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest!"*** (Matthew 21:9)

Palm Sunday invites us to reflect on the events leading to the end of the earthly life of our Lord Jesus Christ. The story of the sorrowful Passion and death of Christ is the greatest love story ever told. It shows us the perfect love of God the Father, who did not spare His Son but gave Him up for our salvation. Love so pure and wonderful, grace so great and beautiful!

The three-part reading from the Gospel of Mark 14:1-15:47 tells the whole story. Beginning with the Last Supper, we read about the betrayal of our Lord by Judas Iscariot, the arrest and agony of Jesus, and his most bloody crucifixion. But the death of Jesus was not the end of the story. For death could not stop Him, nor the grave hold Him down. He conquered the grave, rose again on the third day, and revealed the glory of Easter. As we reflect over the Passion this Sunday, let us journey with Christ in faith. Do we want to walk with the crowd that shouted, ***"Crucify Him!"***, or do we want to turn our hearts to the Lord and say, ***"Oh God, be merciful to me, a sinner?"***

## Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

### The Good News

Mark's account of the Passion is the shortest of the Gospel accounts and is known for its swift impact and drama. It begins with an unnamed woman pouring costly perfumed oil on Jesus' head and includes accounts of the Last Supper, Jesus and his disciples praying in Gethsemane, Jesus' arrest, his trial, Crucifixion, Death, and burial.

### Reflect

The Gospel story told today further unfolds in the liturgies of Holy Thursday evening and Good Friday. The Triduum is the Church's annual retreat time. It is a time to tell the story of the Paschal Mystery—the suffering, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. The story is told through lavish use of song, Scripture, symbol, Sacrament, and procession. This is the holiest time of the entire Church year. How will your family spend these holiest of days? As Holy Week begins, make room on the family calendar to attend the liturgies of the Triduum.

### Share

If you are unable to attend your parish's celebration of the Triduum, gather your family and read aloud the appropriate portions of today's Gospel on Holy Thursday evening and on Good Friday. Sing a simple refrain or hymn such as "Jesus, Remember Me" and spend a few moments together in silent prayer.

### Talk

1. **On Holy Thursday:** On this night, Jesus gathered his closest friends—his disciples—to share a special meal. If you were holding a special meal tonight, what friends would you invite? What foods would you serve? What would you talk about?
2. **On Good Friday:** On this day, Jesus suffered and died on the Cross out of love for us. What does it mean to you that he did this? Who are those suffering in the world, today? How can you ease their suffering?
3. **On Holy Saturday:** Jesus is in the tomb. His friends are trying to make sense of what has happened. They cannot see the coming of the Resurrection. Today is a day for waiting and for praying. For what are you waiting? For what do you wish to pray?

## Updated Mass Information



We are open in a **limited capacity**. Currently, we are able to take **264 people per Mass**. Our Mass Schedule is Monday-Friday (8:00 AM), Tuesday evening (6:00 PM), Saturday (8:00 AM, 4:30 PM), and Sunday (8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, 12:00 Noon, 2:00 PM). See page 7 for Holy Week Schedule.

We are also able to offer Confession by appointment. **Reservations are required for all Masses. To make a reservation for Mass, you can sign-up online using the links on our homepage ([www.stjosephhom.org](http://www.stjosephhom.org)) or call the parish office during business hours.** Per Diocesan policy, we are required to lock the doors once Mass begins. We ask that those with reservations arrive 25-30 minutes early so that everyone can be well-checked and seated on time. Thank you for your help.

This week the parish office is open Monday - Thursday from 8:30 AM - 4:00 PM, and Easter Sunday from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM. **We will be closed on Good Friday.** During this time the church is not open outside of the Mass. Masks must be worn at all times while on our property. Everyone is required to pass a temperature check. We look forward to welcoming you!

The traditional blessing of special Easter food takes place on Holy Saturday in Polish, Slovak, and Italian cultures. The food is taken to the church where a member of the clergy blesses it. This food is then taken home and used on Easter Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday. Foods typically included in the baskets, which are traditionally lined with white linen, include: butter, cakes, lamb, sausage, dried meats, bread, cheese, eggs, salt, horseradish, and wine. We are happy to continue this parish tradition. Please join us on **Holy Saturday, April 3, at 10:00 AM** in the courtyard!

## FROM BISHOP THOMAS

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On Good Friday, April 2, 2021, our Diocese will take up the national collection for the Holy Land.

The Collection for the Holy Land, in the words of Paul VI, is “not only for the Holy Places but above all for those pastoral, charitable, educational, and social works which the Church supports in the Holy Land for the welfare of their Christian brethren and of the local communities.”

This Collection brings an indispensable support to the Christian minority of the Holy Land. The State of Israel and Palestine have a population of some 10 million people. The 180,000 Christian inhabitants represent less than 2% of this population. To check the exodus from the Holy Land of Christians whose lives are rendered difficult, the Franciscan Custody implements numerous initiatives. In addition to ensuring the guard of the shrines, the Good Friday Annual Collection allows these living stones to inhabit the Holy Places and in so doing bear witness to the Resurrection of Christ.

Shrines in Bethlehem, Nazareth, Jerusalem and many other locations welcome Christian pilgrims regularly throughout the year with Christian generosity and hospitality. Likewise, the Church in the Holy Land provides housing and food for the poor.

Please be generous, and prayerfully consider how you can support this collection. Holy Land Christians, along with all the clergy and religious working there greatly appreciate your generosity.


### Consecration to St. Joseph: Book Now Available
