Trinity Sunday

This weekend the church celebrates a fundamental aspect of our faith: the mystery of the Holy Trinity. This great Feast of the church highlights the inner life of the Godhead. This mystery is beyond our human understanding. If we cannot understand the mystery of God or the divinity of Christ, how can we even try to understand the mystery of the Trinity?

The three most popular monotheist religions, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam, believe in the existence of one God. The Christian religion goes further to express her faith in God as three distinct divine persons in one - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Today's Gospel contains the **Trinitarian Formula** used in the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism by early Christians. This shows that the belief in the mystery of the Trinity pre-dates the foundation of the Church.

The celebration of the Pascal Mystery at Easter highlighted the events that led to our salvation. The Lord Jesus was sent by God to save us by laying down His life for us. In fulfillment of His promise to the disciples, the Lord Jesus sent them the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday. Today's Feast celebrates the eternal union between God the Father, the Son, and the Most Holy Spirit. This belief is echoed in the Nicene Creed:

“We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father; God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God; begotten not made, one in being with the Father. Through Him all things were made... We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the Giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son, He is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets...”

In our celebration of the mysterious nature of God, we are invited to reflect on our own human relationships. What better place to begin than from the smallest unit of life - the family? We are called to imitate the perfect unity of the Trinity. May every member of our families follow the humble example of Christ, who though was in the form of God, humbled himself and took our nature (Philippians 2:5-8). Today's celebration also calls us to a life of obedience and self-giving. As the Holy Spirit was sent to the Apostles, we too are sent to become instruments of unity and healing in a hurting world. Let us think about this the next time we reverently make the Sign of the Cross to begin and end our prayers.

May all glory be to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit for ages unending.

An acquaintance who works in church ministry once told me a story about one of the students she had in Faith Formation. This student informed my friend that his family doesn't come to Mass in summer. "God takes a break in summer, and so do we," he said.

We've still got a few weeks left before it's official, but the school year should be winding up for most kids, the birds should be chirping a little louder, and hopefully your lawn is starting to green up nicely. You're probably daydreaming about the annual cabin getaway weekend or waterskiing on the Fourth of July.

All in all, summer is going to be a nice break, even if — like typical Americans — our break is full of productive work.

Thank God — literally — that He doesn't take a break, even if we do. Can we try to remember that, even in the midst of our many wonderful distractions? Let's enjoy this summer. Let's live it to the full. But let's see it for the gift that it is — and remember the thanks we owe the Giver.

Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

The Good News

Today's Gospel passage is the conclusion of Matthew's Gospel. In the Bible, this event is titled The Commissioning of the Disciples. They are indeed commissioned to make disciples of all nations, to baptize, and to teach to others what Christ has taught them. Jesus promised that he would always be with them as they carried out the mission of the Church.

Reflect


As parents, we are commissioned by the Church to be the first and most significant teachers of the faith for our children. We present our children to the Church for Baptism, we teach them the Commandments, and we share with them the Good News of Jesus Christ. We show them how to live as Christ's disciples in the world today. In this way the Church on Earth grows and is strengthened. Take time this week to think about how you are fulfilling your commission to be the first and foremost teacher of the faith for your child. What more can you do to fulfill your role?

Share

This solemnity celebrates the Holy Trinity—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Work together to create a Holy Trinity mobile. Invite family members to use small squares or circles of construction paper to draw symbols for the Persons of the Holy Trinity. For example, you might draw favorite parts of creation to symbolize God the Father, a cross to represent God the Son, and a dove or a flame to symbolize God the Holy Spirit. Write the title "The Holy Trinity" in one square or circle. Use yarn and dowels or coat hangers to create your mobile. Hang the mobile in a place where all family members will see it and will be reminded to celebrate the work of the Holy Trinity.


Updated Mass Information
