**JESUS IS OUR RESTORATION WITH THE FATHER**

God is the master craftsman of creation. In His great love, He made us in His own image and likeness. His original plan was that we may live forever with Him in perfect union. Out of man's free will, he chose to disobey God, and severed this relationship. After the Fall, the life of man was never the same. Even though it was man who wandered away from God, it was God who took the decision to restore man to Himself. God did this through the Incarnation of His Son, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. This is the central message of today's readings.

In today's Gospel, we see the double story of God's compassionate love and mercy in the healing of the synagogue official's daughter and the woman with the issue of blood. Their stories were not pleasant at the beginning, but both ended in a change that left them completely transformed. Faith moves mountains!

The liturgy today invites us to turn our hearts and life situations to the Lord Jesus. He is our restoration with the Father. He touches us through the Sacraments, especially at every Eucharist, that we may be healed of our sins and spiritual diseases and made one with God. Therefore, let us not just bring the Lord our offertory, but also our challenges, brokenness, personal and collective challenges, etc. Though Jesus was stopped by the woman with the issue of blood, the daughter of the synagogue official was still raised to life. Delay is not denial. The crowd was there that day, but the woman was not perturbed by it. Her faith in Jesus changed her entire situation. Let us not allow shame and fear to prevent us from coming to Jesus. He is waiting.

## Touching the Cloak of Christ

Look to today's Gospel and you'll find one of the most arresting images in all of Scripture. Christ in a crowd, everyone clamoring for his attention, pressing against him. Several feet away, is a chronically ill woman, weak and desperate for help. She knows she doesn't have a chance of getting his attention. She has no connections. She has no strength. All she can do is lift up her hand.

So that's what she does. She reaches out.

There comes a time, or maybe several times, in each of our lives when we become this woman. We're tired and we're sick. Is it with sin? With fear? With anger? It doesn't matter. Whatever it is, it's made us weak, and we feel like we've run out of options. We've looked for help and come up empty. We've consulted friends and gotten nowhere. We're lost in the crowd of life, unable to stick our heads above the pressing throng to wave for help.

And there is Christ, always passing by us. The hem of his cloak is never far from our grasp. We have no hope of a big miracle like the synagogue leader. We don't even bother asking for that. But that cloak ... we can touch that cloak. That's something we can do.

Do we do it, though? Do we have the confidence of that sick, beaten-down woman who knew so totally that healing was there for the taking? Or do we retreat back into the crowd, stumbling back home with our pain and our sinfulness? Reach out, friends. However, whatever, whenever — reach out. Christ will not fail you.

## Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

### The Good News

Today's Gospel reading contains two stories that feature the healing ministry of Jesus. In the first story Jairus falls at Jesus' feet and begs Jesus to go and lay hands on his daughter, who is at the point of death. In the second story the woman who had been long afflicted with a hemorrhage touches Jesus' cloak, saying, "If I but touch his clothes, I shall be cured" (Mark 5:28).

To the woman Jesus says, "Daughter, your faith has saved you" (Mark 5:34). To Jairus Jesus says, "Do not be afraid; just have faith" (Mark 5:36).

### Reflect

Parents and caregivers can understand Jairus's desperation in seeking out Jesus. Who wouldn't try everything possible to save his or her child? Today's Gospel reminds us that we need God's help. We must stay strong in faith and continue to trust in God's plan for us and for our children.

### Share

As a family, make a list of those you know who are sick and in need of healing. Put the list on your family prayer table or post it on your refrigerator. Encourage all family members to pray for those on the list each and every day. As an alternative, bring the list to the dinner table each night and begin your meal by praying for those on the list. Also take time to create and send a Get Well card or note of encouragement to each person on the list.




