



The Steward's Work Is Never Done

Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock! When you hear these strong words from the Old Testament, you're probably thinking, thank goodness I don't have any sheep — dodged that bullet. Nobody misled here! No flock scattered on my watch! However, we are all shepherds of a kind, called to tend our own sheep: our families, our parishes, our communities.

But it's exhausting. Don't we all sometimes just want to take a break from being a steward? The excuses are so familiar: we're tired, we've done enough, we've given all we can, what more does the parish (or my spouse, or my kids, or my boss, or my friends, or my community) want? We give ourselves permission to be selfish. So, what if the flock scatters just a little?

Jesus gets that. We can just imagine him weary with exhaustion, can't we? We see him on his boat, attempting to sneak away for a quick break — maybe just a chance to eat a bite of food in peace. He is God, but he was still human, after all. Even the most dedicated shepherds need to sleep. But people couldn't leave him alone. They were hungry for him. They needed what he could offer, and they needed it now.

As tough as it is, that's the example we are tasked with imitating. Everyday Stewardship demands accountability. It demands our showing up even when we are tired. It demands that we look at our lives, our time, our energies, our talents, our hearts, our bank accounts and think: where do I still have more to give?

Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

The Good News

Jesus and the Apostles tried to get away and take time to rest, but the crowds followed them. Jesus saw that the crowds were “like sheep without a shepherd” (Mark 6:34), and so he began to teach them.

Reflect

In many ways, our children are “like sheep without a shepherd” (Mark 6:34). They need strong shepherds to care for them, to guide them, to keep them from danger, to rescue them when they are lost, and to shepherd them in life and in faith. They look to you for such care and guidance. Take time to reflect on your role in your family as shepherd and guide. Think about the opportunities you have to shape your child's life by the words you say and by the example you give.

Share

In the spirit of today's Gospel, plan a day together and away from home, school, work, and daily responsibilities. Choose a destination—a trip to a park, a local museum, a movie, or lunch at a favorite restaurant. Begin your special day with a prayer for safe travels and a good family day. End your special day by talking about your favorite memories of the day.

We are excited to be open for Masses again at full capacity. Our Mass Schedule is: Monday-Friday (8:00 AM), Tuesday evening (6:00 PM), Saturday (8:00 AM, 4:30 PM), and Sunday (8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, 12:00 Noon, 2:00 PM). Reservations are not required. For those who have been vaccinated, masks are now optional on our property. Social distancing is encouraged to be 3 feet between households. 
If you are in a catholic, faith-filled, happy, devout, and devoted marriage and can give 10-12 hours of your time, once a year, then please consider joining this ministry. Not only is it gratifying knowing that you are helping to prepare a couple for sacramental marriage, but you will also reap the rewards of sharing the wisdom, knowledge, and experience gained from your own marriage with a couple who is just starting out.

We use the “For Better and Forever” program, along with its workbook, and meet 5-6 times in the sponsor couple's home for approximately 1 1/2-2 hours each session. Your couple comes to you to meet in the privacy of your home, with just the four of you present. “For Better and Forever” was begun in 1980 and is the most widely used marriage prep program in the U.S. and Canada. Our sponsor couples are trained by the parish coordinators, Debby and Dave Barton.




