Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven. At the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken up into the glory of heaven. Jesus loved his mother so much that He did not allow her body to experience corruption. The Assumption was a belief in the early Church before it was officially declared a dogma by Venerable Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950. Reflecting on this great feast in the sixth century, St. John Damascene declared: “Your sacred and happy soul, as nature will have it, was separated in death from your most blessed and immaculate body, and although the body was duly interred, it did not remain in the state of death, neither was it dissolved by decay; your most pure and sinless body was not left on earth, but you were transferred to your heavenly throne.”

Mary, the Pure and Holy Virgin, always obeyed the command of the Lord. With perfect submission to the will of God the Father, she accepted the invitation to divine motherhood. At the end of her life, Jesus took His Blessed Mother to the eternal city of heaven, while millions of angels watched in celestial amazement.

This feast reminds us of the great participation of Mary in the work of salvation. Being “Full of grace,” her chaste body did not experience the decay of the grave. She was assumed into heaven with great splendor. Therefore, as children of Mary, we the members of the Church pray that we too may behold the joy of eternal life at the return of Christ. As Mary said to the servants at the wedding feast at Cana, “Do whatever he tells you” (John 2:5), she invites us to be obedient to the words of Jesus her son even as we wait in joyful hope for his second coming.

“Oh, mother most chaste, Blessed Virgin Mary, pray for us that we may behold the face of your most beloved child, Jesus Christ.”

WWJD bracelets were all the rage about 25 years ago in Christian circles. I've always wondered if a WWMD bracelet might not make just as much sense, and maybe more. What Would Mary Do?

I would argue that Mary was the most exemplary steward who ever lived. Her answer was always "Yes." Yes, Lord, I am Your handmaiden. Yes, I will visit Elizabeth, and help her in the last difficult months of pregnancy. Yes, I will bring my son up in the Mosaic law and present him at the Temple of Jerusalem. Yes, I will give him to the crowds and to public ministry. Yes, I will offer him on this Cross, if it is Your will.

Yes, yes, yes.

Well, I can't be like Mary, we think to ourselves. There's an intimidation factor with the Blessed Mother and Catholics sometimes — one that almost exceeds that of Christ. Perhaps it's because we are in awe of the fact that she was not divine in any way — she was a mere creation, like us — but somehow, she always had the courage to say yes. How could she do it, when we find it so hard?

Well, God certainly lavished on Mary extraordinary graces. Her lack of original sin liberated her to conform her will to God's.

But God is impatient to give us, too, all the graces we need to be a steward in the example of Mary. He's waiting for us simply to ask. Just as in Adam we died, so in Christ — through Mary — we live.

What can we say yes to today, in Mary's example?

Are You Committed To Strengthening Catholic Marriages?

Our parish pre-marriage preparation program is a ministry that not only prepares engaged couples for marriage but at the same time also strengthens the marriages of our sponsor couples – those who meet and work with the engaged couple. In this way, it's a double blessing for those involved!

If you are in a catholic, faith-filled, happy, devout, and devoted marriage and can give 10-12 hours of your time, once a year, then please consider joining this ministry. Not only is it gratifying knowing that you are helping to prepare a couple for sacramental marriage, but you will also reap the rewards of sharing the wisdom, knowledge, and experience gained from your own marriage with a couple who is just starting out.

We use the "For Better and Forever" program, along with its workbook, and meet 5-6 times in the sponsor couple's home for approximately 1 1/2-2 hours each session. "For Better and Forever" was begun in 1980 and is the most widely used marriage prep program in the U.S. and Canada. 
