# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

# Where There Is Charity And Love, There God Is Found

There were three quotes from the First Reading and Gospel this weekend that caught my attention:

"Would that all the people of the Lord were Prophets!"

"Would that the Lord might bestow His Spirit on them all!"

"Whoever is not against us, is for us!"

These words challenge us to root out the things that often divide us, and work toward peace and unity. In the words of a song: "Ubi caritas et amor, Deus ibi est," (Where there is charity and love, there God is found). The readings invite us to look at the greatness of God's generosity and respond likewise. We are called to embrace the values that promote the good of God's kingdom. God does not need our permission to use whomever He wants in order to achieve His divine purposes. Let us therefore strive to celebrate the success of others rather than ruin them. Celebrating them takes nothing away from us.

In the Gospel, among other themes, Jesus teaches his disciples and us about uprooting the things in our lives that lead us to sin. Unbridled ambition, domination, avarice, jealousy, arrogance, and the mistreatment of others are among these obstacles to our spiritual growth. Let us avoid whatever will hinder us from the kingdom of God.

"Lord our God, when our wealth increase beyond compare, and our banns are filled up with abundance of good things, help us not to become arrogant and use what You have given us to oppress the poor. Grant us generosity of spirit, and help us to remember Lord, that earthly wealth is passive, even diamonds do not last forever."

# **Breaking the Stewardship Mold**

Have you noticed how we always tend to pigeonhole one another - and ourselves? "I could never serve on the Parish Council. That's for Rick and Ellen and that whole group of people who have done it for years." "Greg takes care of faith formation in the parish - he always has. He doesn't need my help." "I can't afford to give the big bucks like those families who sit up front can. My offering wouldn't matter even if I did increase it."

Thinking like this is a good indication that we aren't in conversation with God about what His will is for our lives. If we have already decided what we are and are not meant to do, we aren't likely to pray over it, to discern it.

We have to be open to the spirit of the Lord wherever it leads us, regardless of what we or others have come to expect from us. We human beings come to believe that we are such good judges of what others can offer - or what we ourselves can offer. But God has plans for us to which we aren't privy. God calls everyone to serve Him in the way that pleases Him best, and only He can decide what that is. Everyday Stewardship demands a continual accounting of who we can be, what we can offer - even if it's outside our comfort zone, even if it's something that never occurred to us before.

There's only one Person who can tell us what God wants from us. Do we even think to ask Him?

# **Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families**

#### The Good News

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells John that those who are not against us are for us. Jesus also speaks of removing those parts of our bodies that cause us to sin, for they are hindrances to entering the Kingdom of God.

#### Reflect

The second teaching in today's Gospel invites us to reflect on the temptations and sources of sin in our lives. Spend time in honest conversation with God and pray for forgiveness and the strength to overcome temptations. Make time to experience God's healing love and grace in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.

#### Share

Lead a family discussion of familiar sins such as telling a lie, cheating on a test, being jealous of what someone else has, being selfish, or not keeping a promise. Make a list of the family's responses. Remind family members that in today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that we need to remove whatever causes us to sin from our lives so that we can one day enjoy everlasting life in the Kingdom of Heaven.

Brainstorm ways to work at removing some causes of sins from your lives. For example, you can remove the sin of lying by working at removing the cause for fear of telling the truth. Conclude the discussion by praying for God's strength and help in avoiding sin and in doing good. Make a plan to go as a family to receive the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.


