## What Are Your True Treasures?

The liturgy this weekend invites us to reflect on the place of wealth in our lives as Christians. Even though to so many wealth refers to riches, property, and materials possessions, it is more than that. It concerns all we have received from God, both materially and spiritually. Our wealth refers to our time, treasure, and talent.

According to today's First Reading from the Book of Wisdom, the wise person will seek for wisdom above all other possessions. In the Gospel, Jesus does not condemn riches or rich people. His emphasis is the way people acquire wealth and how they use it. This could also be applied to the use of power. This should be used constructively and not in an abusive manner. Today's liturgy challenges us to be mindful of how we use the material and spiritual wealth we have received from God. This is a great challenge to our society today where people almost adore wealth, fame, power, and glamour. When we arrive at the pearly gates, God will not ask us how wealthy we were on earth. Rather, He will ask us what we have done with our time, treasure, and talent. According to St. Paul in his First Letter to Timothy: ***“As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share”*** (1 Timothy 6:17-18).

## If Heaven were like Harvard

There's no getting around it: life on earth can seem easier if you're rich. Most of the bodily and material needs a person could have are fulfilled if you've got a little bit of money behind you. So why doesn't this same theory apply to entering the kingdom of Heaven? Why isn't Heaven like an Ivy League school, where a connection and a hasty tuition check might open a lot of doors?

When you think about it, the virtues required to enter Heaven — things like charity and justice and courage — should be even closer within the grasp of those who never had to worry about where their food is coming from. In theory, your capacity for good works should only increase with the resources at your disposal.

The same is true for stewardship potential. Let's say I've got a lot of talent. Maybe I've got a lot of free time. On paper, it should be easier for me to give freely of these gifts, because I have the luxury that eluded the widow and her two coins: I can see my ample gift being put into action, when so many can only offer what they have and remind themselves that God sees it and appreciates it.

But here we get into the mess of humanity: if we have a lot of something, it means we have a lot of something we could use any way we want. And then we hear the whisper of the serpent: Think of what this (money, time, talent) could do for you.

May we pray for God to give us the heart of the widow, no matter our resources.

## Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

### The Good News

The man in today's Gospel lived a good life and observed God's laws. But he had yet to do the one thing Jesus would ask of him—to sell all he had and give to the poor. The man went away sad, for he had many possessions. Jesus emphasized to his disciples how hard it is for those with great wealth to enter God's kingdom.

### Reflect

Take time to make two lists today. On the first, list all the things that are important to you in the order of their importance. On the second, list what you really need in order to live. Compare the two lists. How are they alike? How are they different?

Review the first list. Is God first in your order of importance? If not, what can you do to make faith in him the most important priority in your life? Consider whether any other adjustments need to be made to your lists. Pray that the second list will help you be more aware of wants verses needs.

### Share

This week, invite the family to take part in an opportunity to give what you have to the poor. Set aside a day and a time to go through closets, cupboards, and drawers together. Gather any outgrown clothes or unused items that are clean and in good shape. Take them to a donation center such as Shade Tree, Las Vegas Rescue Mission, or Goodwill.




