TAKE COURAGE, THE LORD IS IN OUR MIDST

Jesus' changing of water into wine at the wedding feast at Cana reveals the beauty of God's greatness and His loving desire to reveal Himself to us. The shortness of the wine is the symbol of our human inadequacies. This describes the situation of the Jewish people after the Babylonian exile which is presented in the First Reading of today. Though the period of captivity was over, Israel was without focus or direction. She never realized the presence of God in her midst. The Prophet Isaiah encouraged the Israelites to stay positive for the Lord will make them His "delight".

As we begin a new year, some of us may still be looking back at the losses and negative experiences of 2021. Like the Israelites, some of us may be struggling to find some motivation, and a sense of direction. Take courage, God is in our midst. He is our greatest lover and will do everything to restore our hopes and joys. May He change our "waters" of doubt to faith, and our "lukewarm waters" into sweet "wines of joy." Let us find hope in the mystery of Christmas which we just celebrated for, "Our God is with us" Emmanuel!

In the Second Reading of today, St Paul Challenged the Church in Corinth to use the gifts God gave them to build the community. Another way God reveals Himself is through our different gifts. Therefore, like Jesus in the Gospel of today, let us use our talents for the benefit of our brothers and sisters and not for personal aggrandizement.

It Takes All Kinds

"If every flower wanted to be a rose," wrote St. Therese of Lisieux, "spring would lose its loveliness."

Who is God asking you to be today? There is an obvious answer that springs to mind right out of the gate. God wants me to be a good person (a good father, a good husband) today; today, God wants me to be a saint.

But this answer fails to get to the heart of the question. We are all striving today to serve the same Spirit, but we are given different gifts to do so. The one who has the gift of knowledge may fail if today he decides he wants to be a healer. The one who has the gift of "varieties of tongues" might falter in the expression of wisdom.

Think about the wedding at Cana and the players in the scene: the servers, the guests, the bride and groom. They all have a unique role to play, and though it is to the servers that Mary gives the instruction, "Do whatever he tells you," her words apply to all.

Today, are we called to be the servers — do we wait on God's instruction and carry it out, no matter how foolish or impossible it may seem to our human ears? Are we asked to be the disciples, to bear witness to a miracle and to give our testimony? Are we called to imitate the Blessed Mother herself and give encouragement to follow God's word?

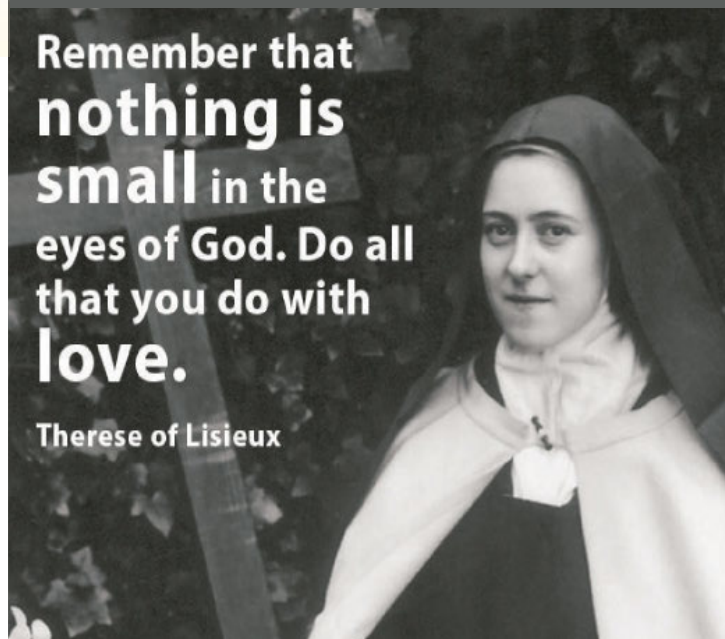
Let us examine our gifts and listen in the silence of our hearts to the direction of the Spirit. Then and only then, let us do whatever He tells us.

Gospel Reflection for Families

The Good News

While the Wedding in Cana is a familiar story, it only appears in John's Gospel. Scholars call it the first of Jesus' signs. Mary, Jesus' mother, observed that the wine was running low at a wedding feast she and Jesus were attending. She didn't specifically ask Jesus to do something about the situation, but he understood the implication. He instructed the servants to fill six stone jars with water and then take some to the waiter in charge. The waiter was surprised that the bridegroom had saved the best wine for last. The servants were surprised because they knew the jars were filled with water and they had witnessed something remarkable.

Reflect

The point Jesus wanted to illustrate by performing this sign was to introduce a change. Many scholars interpret the wedding as the new age and the huge stone jars represent the magnitude of the wonder. There is great abundance in the story and that is the message of the new order Jesus promises - God lavishes us with his abundant love and we come to know that love through Jesus.

Share

Change is often good for us. Jesus brought about a good change in the world. Think about some changes your family can make (or has already made) like rearranging furniture, breaking a routine, or going on vacation. Talk together about how these changes excite you, cause you to grow, or give you a different view of things.
