**From The Pastor's Desk**

**Lent, a time to Rebuild**

A preview of Post-pandemic world would nevertheless be an interesting one. The pandemic has foisted a myriad of burdens and the effects will linger for a while. As the saying goes, life is a teacher, and so is COVID 19. Without doubt, the year 2020 taught us more than we could fathom. It is a year riddled with deaths, anxieties, despair, doubts, and nauseating political atmosphere. We witnessed a wave of popularization and legitimization of moral relativism, mutual mistrust, and utter disregard for common sense; exposing the illusions that we are secure and ready for whatever life might throw at us. The pandemic has unraveled our isolationism and fragility and shaken our civic and religious foundations. We saw a world drifting out of our controls and pivoting to virtual dependency. The storms of a couple weeks ago, further jolted those in Texas into survival mode. A lot to learn from 2020 and so much to unlearn. As our hearts and minds continue to filter the events of 2020, our world is hoping for a return to normalcy.

As every sector strives to grapple with economic and social restructuring, planning must incorporate new ways of thinking and doing things. Organizations and businesses have their sights now on life after the pandemic. A lot of rebuilding and healing need to happen for our collective coexistence. Bishop Burns seems to be on a similar radar. In his 2021 Lenten Pastoral: *The Journey Through Lent, Easter, Ascension, and Pentecost: A Post-Pandemic Plan for the Diocese of Dallas*, he indicates his interest and plan to convene a Synod for the diocese of Dallas. It will be an opportunity for stock taking and a review of the *state of the diocese*. He realizes that no one person has ownership of this vision and through this Synod offers an opportunity to the faithful and priests of the local church to have input, participate and discuss what pertains to them as Catholic Christians within the diocese. The last Synod was 87years ago. For sure, that is a long time. A human this old, and without periodic medical checkup, might have a lot of health issues. The synod will be a wonderful opportunity for brainstorming on new paradigms and new strategies of being a church in a post-pandemic society. I believe that the hard copies of the Pastoral Letter are coming our way to assist us in preparation through prayer and reflection for the Synod moment.

The diocese of Dallas has also created an Interracial Healing Task Force. The team provides reflection questions for the Sundays of Lent to *help each of us look inside ourselves to consider the often difficult topic of racism and even the more challenging struggle of how to achieve racial healing*. This is designed to help Catholics, parishes, families, and individuals to take a long, deep look of the imperceptible and overt bias and prejudices that we live with unconsciously without reflection.

These are brave and bold initiatives on the part of our bishop. They offer fresh prospects for the faithful of Dallas to do some inward introspection, work together with the clergy, and listen so as to discern new ways of being better disciples and missionaries to a world that needs a lot healing. As we long for a return to the pews, how we minister to those among us and beyond hurting from COVID 19 effects is key.

We all clamor and hope for a return to normalcy. Top on my list, is a return to being humans again.

## CHILDREN'S FAITH FORMATION

During the upcoming scheduled Spring Break—March 15-19 (there won't be any homework assignments!!), I will be doing another thorough review of all the children's CatholicBrain homework trackers, especially those that are Year 1 students (which includes 1st Grade) and those currently enrolled in sacramental preparation (First Communion). I will contact all families individually to let you know what video lessons your child(ren) is missing so that they are able to catch-up. As directed to us by Fr. Eugene, all children must be current and up-to-date on their assigned on-line video lessons. We will assist you as best we can to get your kiddos caught up!

And FYI—technically, there are no In-Person Faith Formation sessions scheduled for the Month of March. HOWEVER, if we do not have a large enough response to have our proposed TOB mini-series, we will use Sunday, March 21 as our make-up day for the cancelled GROUP A session and Sunday, March 28 for the cancelled GROUP B session. I will keep you all posted...

***Speaking of Baptism, welcome to the newest members of our parish community who celebrated the Sacrament of Baptism on Saturday, February 13: Erik Ruben Cazares; and on Sunday, February 14: Clara Isabella Langer!***

Parents, we are setting aside next week, March 5-11, for our diocesan mandated child safety training lesson. We are still being required to have a class this year. This safety class is typically referred to as VIRTUS for Grades K-3 and is conducted during the Theology of the Body (TOB) mini-series for Grades 4-6.

In order to make this lesson plan easier on you, the parent, we are opting for and have been granted approval from the diocese, to use the on-line safety program, **NETSMARTKIDS**. Some of the children who were in Grades 2 and 3 the past several years are already familiar with this program. Our Safety Officer, Sharon Bush, and I have reviewed the available **NETSMARTKIDS** videos and have selected ones which we believe are appropriate for your children since **NETSMARTKIDS** deals with on-line safety. And since all children have been doing some form of on-line schooling this past year, this seemed to be a good fit for families. We will be uploading "Router's Birthday Surprise" for Grades K-3 and "In the Cloud" for Grades 4-6. An on-line Google Acknowledgement Form has been developed for you—the parent—to complete since this information has to be documented and reported to the diocese for our annual audit. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact myself or Sharon Bush. As always, we greatly appreciate your assistance in completing this safety training!
