From The Pastor's Desk

Happy Mother's Day!!!

Recently, two people were having a conversation while checking out in a grocery store. Although they had their masks on, they were loud enough that those standing more than ten feet away could understand them. They don't need a microphone even with their masks on. While I couldn't comprehend the gist of their conversation, the topic centered on Mother's Day. What I picked was a comment by one of them that every day should be a Mother's Day. That comment has stayed with me since then. While I understand that it might be too repetitive or boring or to celebrate it every day, there's a lot of sense behind the statement. While the one day in the year is a special day set aside to celebrate mothers, is it not worth appreciating mothers every day?

The vocation of motherhood is God-given and precious. Mothers occupy a special place in the life of the family, community, and our world. Their life-giving, self-giving love to the family is almost indispensable. With their spouses, mothers lay the enduring foundational and timeless values of faith, morals, and holistic formation as they nurture their loved ones. To live in appreciation is to live in gratitude. No price can be put on the debt that our human family owes to mothers. They cannot be over-appreciated.

The complex reality of a being a mother is unfathomable. They share their lives of selfless love in ways incomprehensible to many. The vocation of being a mother defies any job description; and no one template is common to the circumstances of all mothers. The burden of expectation placed on mothers is multifaceted that many thrust on themselves the pressure of being perfect mothers. Your perfection comes through the daily challenges and opportunities you face as you fulfil your vocation. The Blessed Mother comes to mind here. For the many troubles she had to endure, and the ones she did not know how to tackle, she took everything to heart in prayer. For the many prayers, thoughts, anxieties, fears, uncertainties that you keep, reflect on, and treasure in your hearts like the Blessed Virgin Mary, we pray that you would always feel the loving embrace of God. It takes a measure of maturity to appreciate the ramifications of being a mother.

Mother's Day is a day to salute our mothers, appreciate them and pray for them. As we appreciate the living, we also remember the deceased. Pope Francis likens the grandmas and grandpas to antiques of their families that must be treasured. They remain integral part of who we are as individuals and families.

On this day, we commit you to the maternal care of the Blessed Mother, asking her to intercede for you, and that you enjoy the little joys and moments that surround everyday living. For the unconditional love you offer to your family, be reminded that "To the world, you are a mother, to your family, you are the world" [Anonymous]. Every day, indeed, should be a Mother's Day. 

## Vatican News



**Pope Francis has called for a global prayer marathon for the entire month of May, praying for the end to the pandemic.**

“The initiative will involve in a special way all shrines in the world” in promoting the initiative so that individuals, families and communities all take part in reciting the rosary, “to pray for the end of the pandemic,” said the Pontifical Council for Promoting New Evangelization in a press release April 21.

“It is the heartfelt desire of the Holy Father that the month of May be dedicated to a prayer marathon dedicated to the theme, ‘from the entire church an unceasing prayer rises to God,’” it said.

The theme refers to the miraculous event recounted in the Acts of the Apostles (12:1-12) when all the church prayed for Peter, who was imprisoned until God sent an angel to free him, illustrating how the Christian community comes together to pray in the face of danger and how the Lord listens and performs an unexpected miracle.

**Each day in May, there will be a livestream from one of 30 chosen Marian shrines or sanctuaries to guide the prayer at 6 p.m. Rome time (noon EDT) on all Vatican media platforms.**

The pope will open the monthlong prayer **May 1 and conclude it May 31**, the council said.



### Update on St. Joseph's Statue



We envisage a statue that would be same size and same stone as the blessed mother statue outside in the courtyard. It is a 5 foot statue made of Masha Marble compared to Carrara marble which is made to withstand the weather and outdoor elements. Our best estimate to date is \$15,000 including freight cost. For installation, the company uses an individual to do the installation (cost to be determined) or we can hire anyone of our choosing. We have so far received the generous contribution of **\$4,792.83** so far in donations towards the purchase of the statue.

As we pray for the success of this project and the spiritual benefits, we join the Holy Father, Pope Francis in this prayer asking St. Joseph to intercede for us.
