From The Pastor's Desk

Sanctuary Floor Replacement Plan

As you well know, we are in the final stages of awarding a Contract for our sanctuary floor replacement project. The current carpet and floors were put in place over twenty-something years ago, and they have served their purpose well, and beyond.

A committee of six parishioners were tapped to assist us with this project. This committee diligently invested their time, resources, and explored a variety of options, consulted for quality, sustainable, cost-effective, aesthetic materials and labor, and other value-added benefits given the prevailing market forces while staying within our budget limitations. They visited some area churches and were given tours of the sanctuaries from which they gained experiences that were fruitful in their research. I am deeply grateful to the members of this committee for their dedicated service to this project and our church family. Your input is invaluable!!!

Part of the process was to submit our proposal to the Diocesan Sacred Place Commission, followed by a virtual meeting. This Commission reports directly to the diocesan bishop on church building projects, constructions, and renovations throughout the diocese of Dallas. We have received their recommendations and approval from Bishop Edward Burns. A member of the Sacred Place Commission, a professional artist, visited our Sanctuary space to see things firsthand. This on-site visit further enabled her to advise us on pattern, color, design considerations and selections with respect to existing structural apertures.

An Acoustic Evaluation was done and the recommendations were helpful in the selection of the materials for possible sound and audio effects. There's both good and bad news from the acoustic evaluation: the good news is that our proposed selections would not pose a post-renovation problem to the sound system; the bad news is that our sound system [equipment] is nearing its life span, which is another project down the road. Talk about getting old!!! The process has been a learning curve. In the process of evaluating our space, a small portion of asbestos was found in the kitchenette attached to the narthex-end of the sanctuary. Asbestos abatement will be done immediately which has depleted a fraction of the budget. For health reasons, I believe it is necessary to address this immediately. Hopefully, our new set of floors will complement and transform our Sanctuary into a more inviting and peaceful place for prayer and worship.

As I thank you for your contributions and support, I crave your indulgences and patience. Looking at the tentative replacement schedule, our last liturgical celebrations and activities in the church will be May 30th, 2021. The entire space will be evacuated to make room for the contractors to commence work on the first day of June. Our daily Mass on Monday May 31st will be from the gym or dining room in the community center. Weekend Masses and confessions will all take place in the community center until around mid-August, when hopefully we go back into a fresh, new look, worship space.

I ask for your prayers for a hitch free beginning and successful completion of this project. It is going to be quite an adjustment but we all can help in our little and big ways throughout this process.




Estate Planned Giving

Update on St. Joseph's Statue

We envisage a statue that would be same size and same stone as the blessed mother statue outside in the courtyard. It is a 5 foot statue made of Masha Marble compared to Carrara marble which is made to withstand the weather and outdoor elements. Our best estimate to date is \$15,000 including freight cost. For installation, the company uses an individual to do the installation (cost to be determined) or we can hire anyone of our choosing. We have so far received the generous contribution of \$5,032.83 so far in donations towards the purchase of the statue.

As we pray for the success of this project and the spiritual benefits, we join the Holy Father, Pope Francis in this prayer asking St. Joseph to intercede for us.
