

**From The Pastor's Desk**

**Jesus, the Bread of Life**

Scripture selections for the preceding week serve as forerunner for this week's gospel on the bread of life discourse. The readings from the Old and new Testaments prefigure the Eucharist. John the Evangelist dwelt extensively on the true meaning of this mystery in a profound way. The people were awestruck at the sign of feeding the crowd. But these *power filled acts* meant to lead people to faith, can be confusing. The crowd came looking for Christ for food, again. They wanted to make Jesus a king, for they found in him a prophet that would lead them to glory. As in the past, the Israelites were confused as to who gave them the Manna in the desert, the crowd was fixated on the bread that perishes. Jesus corrected their misguided conception and directed them to focus on the bread that endures: the Eucharist. The challenge in this story is to find the true meaning of feeding the multitude. Sometimes, this is the confusion we find ourselves in as followers of Christ. What do we believe about this powerful sign? The truth of this teaching is belief in the Real Presence, which is distinctly Catholic. The feeding is not just a miracle that changed loaves and fish, but men and women. It is an invitation to a personal encounter with the very life of God. The Saints from one generation to another have rendered testimonies of their encounters with Jesus in the Eucharist. To ponder and meditate on the mystery that the Eucharist is, please find some excerpts from the Saints:

*St. Jerome:* "If Christ did not want to dismiss the Jews without food in the desert for fear that they would collapse on the way, it was to teach us that it is dangerous to try to get to heaven without the Bread of Heaven."

*St. John Vianney (Cure d'Ars):* "All the good works in the world are not equal to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass because they are the works of men; but the Mass is the work of God. Martyrdom is nothing in comparison for it is but the sacrifice of man to God; but the Mass is the sacrifice of God for man."

*St. Maximilian Kolbe:* "If angels could be jealous of men, they would be so for one reason: Holy Communion. God dwells in our midst, in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar."

*St. Peter Chrysologus:* "He is The Bread sown in the virgin, leavened in the Flesh, molded in His Passion, baked in the furnace of the Sepulchre, placed in the Churches, and set upon the Altars, which daily supplies Heavenly Food to the faithful."

*St. Peter Julian Eymard:* "We have close to us as much as Joseph had at Nazareth; we have our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, but our poor eyes fail to see Him. Let us once become interior souls and we shall immediately see. In no better way can we enter into the Heart of our Lord than through Saint Joseph. Jesus and Mary are eager to pay the debts which they owe him for his devoted care of them, and their greatest pleasure is to fulfill his least desire. Let him, then, lead you by hand into the interior sanctuary of Jesus Eucharistic."

*St. Therese of Lisieux:* "Do you realize that Jesus is there in the tabernacle expressly for you - for you alone? He burns with the desire to come into your heart...don't listen to the demon, laugh at him, and go without fear to receive the Jesus of peace and love."

I was so taken aback, had to pick my jaw up off the floor because I don't typically hear this but I also wanted to burst into tears because it was such a beautiful reminder of why I come to work everyday. Jesus said we should have faith like a child... So, thank you, Sebastian, for filling my heart with such happiness. It has truly touched me. And this is why I do Children's Ministry....


### **General Faith Formation Registration FAQ's**

- ◆ **All families wishing to sign children up for Faith Formation must be registered members of Holy Spirit.** If you haven't already completed a Parish Census Form to be a part of our wonderful faith community, we ask that you do that **first before** picking up registration paperwork for Faith Formation. **You can do one on-line before you arrive!**
- ◆ **Children registering for sacramental preparation MUST HAVE completed the required one year of Faith Formation last year, whether it was at Holy Spirit or another parish, virtual or in-person.** *If it was at another parish, a Letter of Attendance Verification from that parish **MUST** be on file with our office prior to registering for sacramental preparation. We will also need a copy of the child's baptismal certificate before accepting sacramental preparation paperwork.*
- ◆ **The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in the 8th Grade or older and First Communion in the 2nd Grade or older.** Attendance for two consecutive years in Faith Formation/Youth Ministry remains a diocesan requirement for sacramental preparation. We verify attendance when you register for sacramental preparation to ensure children/youth meet the two-year requirement. *For Children's Faith Formation, this means they have completed all of the assigned CatholicBrain video lessons and for Youth Ministry, all of the assigned Google classroom lessons.*
- ◆ **For paperwork received on the 8th or 15th, all Faith Formation/sacrament activity fees must be paid in full by Monday, August 30 before your child will be placed on a class roster.** Current class fees are \$50.00 for one child; \$100.00 for two children; and \$115.00 for three or more children. **Sacrament activity fees (\$30.00/sacrament) are separate. Class fees will increase again as of Friday, September 10 so please register now!** **SPECIAL NOTE: We will not accept registrations after Monday, August 30 for SCHEDULE A or Tuesday, September 7 for SCHEDULE B in order to prepare for the first day of class.** You can still obtain paperwork Monday through Thursday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. **(NO FRIDAYS)**, but it will not be processed until after the first day of classes.
- ◆ **Because the first day of Faith Formation is always full of those unexpected snags plus we want to be able to devote our attention to the classes taking place, we will be unable to distribute or accept registration paperwork on Sunday, September 12 or Sunday, September 19.** But, don't forget! Registration forms are available on-line!
- ◆ Keep in mind that our class sizes this year have been reduced for safety purposes and your desired grade level and Schedule may fill up! Don't wait too long to register!
