From The Pastor's Desk

More on Floor Replacement Project

You may have noticed from my reports on the Sanctuary Floor Replacement project that there's been other makeovers within the sanctuary that have nothing to do with the floor. When we took on this task, a lot of things needed to be addressed that were not envisaged at the very beginning. The termite damage was noticed and addressed, asbestos contamination exterminated, and the two grey panels to the left of the crucifix were removed and the space reconstructed. They were all professionally handled in a way that exceeded our expectations.

Driving this project from the onset was sustainability and cost-effective business model. However, it is easy to notice that aesthetics was not thrown out of the window. With our new polished concrete floor, LVT in the classrooms, porcelain tile on the altar, and the carpet in the chapel and narthex in place, we have more health-friendly, cleaner, and easy to maintain facility. You may recall that we installed bipolar ionization system last year which makes our entire facility clean-air friendly. With all these in place now, a new set of contractors recommended portable equipment and accessories to maintain and keep the surfaces in their pristine conditions are needed.

In the past few weeks, individuals, families, and organizations have helped tremendously in offering their services to every aspect of need in this renovation process. Pews were moved and reassembled, doors taken down, stripped, refinished and reinstalled by the Knights in addition to so many sundry stuff. I cannot thank enough our young adults and their families for their assistance in pew staining, and general cleaning. May I say this again that without your support, prayers, encouragement, and commitment, we couldn't have come this far. Whatever your means can allow you to help us with to provide the required services and tools, will be greatly appreciated.

Please find on page 6, a list of various needs and services yet to be met as compiled by the Committee overseeing this project on our behalf.

General Faith Formation Registration



- ◆ All families wishing to sign children up for Faith Formation must be registered members of Holy Spirit. If you haven't already completed a Parish Census Form to be a part of our wonderful faith community, we ask that you do that **first before** picking up registration paperwork for Faith Formation. **You can do one on-line before you arrive!**
- ◆ Children registering for sacramental preparation **MUST HAVE** completed the required one year of Faith Formation **last year**, whether it was at Holy Spirit or another parish, virtual or in-person. *If it was at another parish, a Letter of Attendance Verification from that parish **MUST** be on file with our office prior to registering for sacramental preparation. **We will also need a copy of the child's baptismal certificate before accepting sacramental preparation paperwork.***
- ◆ The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in the 8th Grade or older and First Communion in the 2nd Grade or older. Attendance for two consecutive years in Faith Formation/Youth Ministry remains a diocesan requirement for sacramental preparation. We verify attendance when you register for sacramental preparation to ensure children/youth meet the two-year requirement. *For Children's Faith Formation, this means they have completed all of the assigned CatholicBrain video lessons and for Youth Ministry, all of the assigned Google classroom lessons.*
- ◆ For paperwork received on the 8th or 15th, all Faith Formation/sacrament activity fees **must be paid in full by Monday, August 30 before your child will be placed on a class roster.** Current class fees are \$50.00 for one child; \$100.00 for two children; and \$115.00 for three or more children. **Sacrament activity fees (\$30.00/sacrament) are separate. Class fees will increase again as of Friday, September 10 so please register now!** **SPECIAL NOTE:** We will not accept registrations after Monday, August 30 for SCHEDULE A or Tuesday, September 7 for SCHEDULE B in order to prepare for the first day of class. You can still obtain paperwork Monday through Thursday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. **(NO FRIDAYS)**, but it will not be processed until after the first day of classes.
- ◆ **Because the first day of Faith Formation is always full of those unexpected snags plus we want to be able to devote our attention to the classes taking place, we will be unable to distribute or accept registration paperwork on Sunday, September 12 or Sunday, September 19.** But, don't forget! Registration forms are available on-line!
- ◆ Keep in mind that our class sizes this year have been reduced for safety purposes and your desired grade level and Schedule may fill up! Don't wait too long to register!

Equipment Needs for New Flooring:

Concrete Scrubber -The vendor recommends Minute Man brand or equal and the use of red disks for the polished concrete floors. *The concrete floor scrubber should be used on a regular schedule to keep the concrete clean and prevent the guard from wearing away prematurely and the floor losing its shine. It is suggested that be done to aisles/walkways in the sanctuary and arcade/hallways every Friday after the morning Mass.

Microfiber system for wet mopping - this is similar to a Swifter, but has a mop bucket that is put in solution used to wet the microfiber mop. The microfiber is used until soiled from mopping and then changed. Only clean mops are dipped into the bucket. Soiled microfibers are washed in a washer for reuse.

Vacuum Cleaner - Existing vacuum cleaner is old, inefficient and worn out. See Bentley Carpet literature for vacuum recommendations.

Other areas of polished or sealed concrete should also be cleaned by the scrubber and microfiber system on a less frequent basis depending on the need. The microfiber mopping should be done in the areas between the pews. Additionally, the scrubber can be used as well as the microfiber mopping on the LVT. The microfiber system should be available at any janitorial service.

Additional Items or things that need to be addressed in the Church:

- Church and Rectory windows be washed (scheduling in progress)
- Chapel and classroom drapes cleaned and rehung/Blinds washed and rehung
- Needlepoint Tapestry and pew upholstery professionally cleaned (scheduled)
- All church materials be moved back from places of storage into the Church, including classrooms, Chapel, Sacristies, ushers' closet etc. (the Knights could be contacted about helping with this)
- HVAC registers and intake grates be cleaned
- Additional or replacement cleaning tools and supplies should be provided as indicated
- Doors entering sanctuary from Narthex be refinished and doors from sacristies be repainted (just the inside door of the priests' sacristy needs repainting)
- Doors entering Narthex from the outside be refinished
- The closet used for storing banners and the kitchen could be painted with leftover paint from the altar and chapel
- Door from arcade to Chapel be refinished
- Professional window service caulk the windows along the arcade to prevent water seeping in and pooling on arcade floor. Sprinkler head by the statue of the Blessed Virgin be redirected so it is not aimed at the window. It causes water to pool inside the church on arcade floor.
