THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

For Catholics, Christmas isn't just December 25. Rather, the Christmas season is 12 days long. The Feast of the Epiphany is the last day of the Christmas season in the Church. The Church celebrates the feast of the Epiphany this Sunday, but the typical day to celebrate the Epiphany is on January 6; 12 days after the Nativity of the Lord.

This feast day commemorates the visit of the Magi — the Three Kings — to Baby Jesus. The three kings are laden with gifts that are not merely precious and expensive. With their offerings, they are recognizing the dignity of the newborn Child:

He is King. He is God. He is Man.

To the king belongs gold, a symbol of wealth and splendor. Incense is a symbol of prayer used by priests to show Jesus' divine priesthood. Myrrh is both the fragrance of anointing and the announcement of the suffering of the Lord, true man among us.



St. Pius X and Corpus Christi are cosponsoring the Interfaith Homeless Shelter at Chula Vista Presbyterian Church, on the corner of Hilltop and L Street. This program is designed to help people get back on their feet by providing them with meals and shelter as they try to reestablish a residence.

Ways You Can Help:

Lunch Hosts will prepare bagged lunches.

DINNER HOSTS will prepare food for the 8-12 guests, deliver to CV Presbyterian by 5pm, and are welcomed to stay and visit with the guests each evening.

- 5pm 8pm: Evening Hosts
- 8pm 7am: Overnight Hosts stay at the shelter and attend to any emergencies that may arise, seeing our guests out by 7am each morning.

Our guests will be both male and female and are transitionally homeless. There is a common dining room, and separate sleeping areas for males and females. Showers and laundry facilities are also available on site.

Pre-established rules of conduct are well known to the guests and will be discussed with them on day one of our hosting.

All guests (max of 12) and hosts are required to be fully vaccinated. This will be verified by the InterFaith Shelter Network staff.
