Saturday, January 22

The over 56 million abortions since the 1973 decisions of Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton reflect with heartbreaking magnitude what Pope Francis means by a "throwaway culture." However, we have great trust in God's providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord's help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

The Church designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children". This day is "observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion."

To prepare for this day, please join the Nine Days for Life Novena Wednesday, January 19 – Thursday, January 27, 2022. The novena and other resources can be found at www.9daysforlife.com. Please join us and others around the world in praying for an end to abortion.






- 5pm 8pm: Evening Hosts

All guests (max of 12) and hosts are required to be fully vaccinated. This will be verified by the InterFaith Shelter Network staff.
