#### **Gospel Reflection**

SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY BENEDICT XVI

**ANGELUS** 

St Peter's Square, Saturday, 6 January 2007

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today's Solemnity of the Epiphany celebrates the manifestation of Christ to the Magi, an event that St Matthew emphasizes greatly (see Mt 2: I-I2). His Gospel narrates that some "Magi" - probably Persian religious leaders - reached Jerusalem guided by a "star", a luminous, heavenly phenomenon which they interpreted as a sign of the birth of a new king of the Jews.

No one in the city knew anything; rather, the king in charge, Herod, remained very disturbed by the news and conceived the tragic design of the "slaughter of the innocents" to eliminate the newborn rival.

The Magi, instead, placed their trust in the Sacred Scriptures, in particular in the prophecy of Micah, according to which the Messiah would be born at Bethlehem, the city of David, situated about 10 kilometers south of Jerusalem (see Mi 5: 1).

They departed in that direction and saw the star anew and, full of joy, followed it until it stopped over a poor dwelling. They entered and found the Baby with Mary; they prostrated before him and, in homage of his royal dignity, they offered him gold, frankincense and myrrh.

Why is this happening so important? Because in it the adhesion of the pagan people to faith in Christ has begun to be fulfilled according to the promise made by God to Abraham, about which the Book of Genesis refers: "By you all the families of the earth shall bless themselves" (Gn 12: 3).

If Mary, Joseph and the shepherds of Bethlehem therefore represent the people of Israel who have welcomed the Lord, the Magi instead are the first of the peoples, also called to be part of the Church, the new People of God established, no longer on ethnic, linguistic or cultural homogeneity, but uniquely on the common faith in Jesus, Son of God.

The Epiphany of Christ, therefore, is at the same time the epiphany of the Church, the manifestation of her universal vocation and mission. In this context I am happy to address my cordial greeting to the beloved brothers and sisters of the Eastern Churches who, following the Julian Calendar, will celebrate Holy Christmas tomorrow: with affection I wish them an abundance of peace and Christian prosperity.

I am happy to recall that on the occasion of the Epiphany, the World Day of the Missionary Childhood is celebrated. It is the feast on which Christian children live with joy the gift of faith and pray that the light of Jesus reaches all the children of the world.

I thank the children of the "Divine Infancy", present in 110 countries, because they are precious cooperators of the Gospel and apostles of Christian solidarity to those most in need. I encourage educators to cultivate in the little ones the missionary spirit, so that impassioned missionaries are born among them, witnesses of the tenderness of God and announcers of his love.

Now we invoke the Virgin Mary, Star of Evangelization: through her intercession may Christians in every part of the earth live as sons of the light and lead humanity to Christ, true light of the world.



Dear Brother Priests,

On May 19th of this year, I sent a letter to all priests in which I modified our pandemic protocols for liturgical celebrations. Those changes took effect on May 22nd, Pentecost Sunday.

Since the local pandemic situation has continued to improve, I announce the following liturgical directives which will take effect on Sunday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord:

#### General Dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day Mass Obligation

This dispensation is removed for all Catholics within the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. The faithful should fulfill their Sunday and Holy Day obligations joyfully and conscientiously.

At the same time, pastors should take care to remind the faithful that, from the law itself, the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday or a Day of Precept is not morally binding for those who find it impossible to attend Mass, e.g., due to illness, advanced age, caring for a sick person, or being at high-risk for contracting COVID-19 (cf. CIC, 1248). These persons should fulfill their obligations through some act of prayer or meditation upon the sacred scriptures for the Mass of the day.

#### Reception of the Precious Blood from a Common Chalice

For the time being, the suspension of receiving the Precious Blood from a common chalice remains in effect. However, those deacons vested and assisting the priest or bishop in the celebration of Mass are to receive (i.e., drink) the Precious Blood from secondary chalices.

#### Masking for Ordinary and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

Pastors have the discretion to determine whether clerics and lay ministers should wear masks when distributing Holy Communion. [The use of hand sanitizer before administering Holy Communion is recommended.]

#### Offertory Procession

Pastors are to resume the Offertory procession with the presentation of bread and wine.

#### Sign of Peace

The Sign of Peace is to be given at Holy Mass. Many of the faithful are now accustomed to making the Sign of Peace with a bow or some other gesture.

#### Altar Servers

Since there is no requirement for social distancing in our churches, the use of altar servers—boys and girls—is to be restored. Altar servers are always required at Masses celebrated by one of the local bishops, especially at Confirmation Masses.

#### Holy Water

Pastors are to resume the use of holy water in fonts and stoups. Holy water should be replenished frequently. In order to encourage safe and courteous use of holy water, an announcement may be given in these or similar words:

"Since the pandemic situation has improved in our area, Cardinal DiNardo has restored the use of holy water in our churches. As a courtesy to one another, all are encouraged to sanitize their hands before using the holy water font."

### Designated Doorways

There is no requirement to direct the liturgical assembly to enter or leave the church through designated doorways.

Finally, brothers, I wish to extend to you my deep gratitude for your priestly ministry and pastoral accompaniment of your parishioners throughout this year. With assurances of my prayers for you, I am
