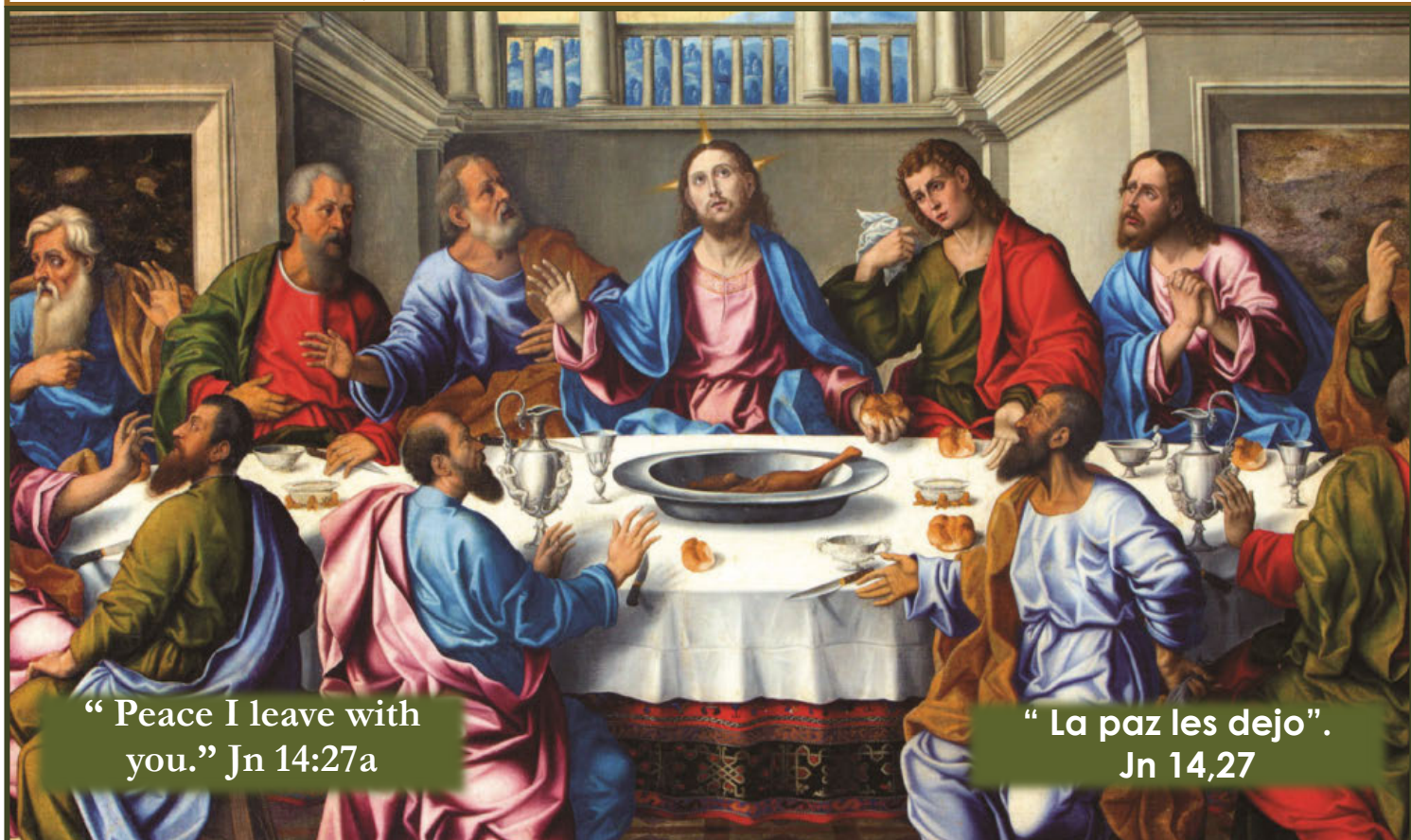

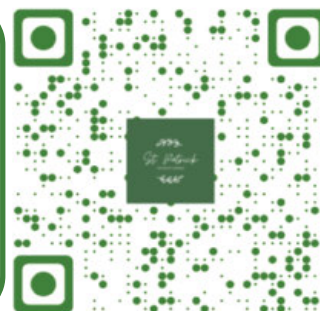

Does Disagreement Mean Hatred?



Our faith tells us clearly that we should not hate anybody. “If anyone says, ‘I love God,’ but hates his brother, he is a liar; for whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen. This is the commandment we have from Him: whoever loves God must also love his brother.”(1 John 4:20-21)

Jesus gave us the greatest example of loving all people. In His terrible and unjust suffering on the cross, He could have expressed very hateful words toward His persecutors, or He could have condemned them all to hell. Instead, He prayed for them, saying “Father, forgive them, they do not know what they are doing.” (Luke 23:34)

So it is wrong to hate anybody, whether because of their race, nationality, beliefs, or even because of the wrong that person has done. We are called by God to desire the good for all persons, without exception, especially the good of their eternal salvation.

But that does not mean that we must agree with everybody’s words or actions. Some people claim that anybody who disagrees with them must hate them! Maybe some people do wrongfully hate others because of strong disagreements, but that certainly does not mean that every disagreement indicates hatred. In fact the opposite can be true! Consider these examples:

1. A daughter begs her parents to let her go to a party that night. But her parents talk to some people about that party and find out it will be held in a house where there will be no adults present. They also find out that some of those planning to go to the party had gotten in trouble recently for using illegal drugs. So the parents tell their daughter that they cannot let her go to that party. She yells, “**You don’t trust me and you never let me have any fun! You must hate me!**” She runs to her room crying, slams the door and won’t come out for dinner. Her parents feel badly. But should they allow her to go to the party to show her that they do not hate her?

2. A friend gets drunk at a sporting event. You tell him that you should drive him home, since you haven’t been drinking. Your friend angrily says, “**I thought you were my friend, why are you treating me like I’m a little kid? Do you hate me?**” Should you agree it is okay for him to drive himself home, to prove that you don’t hate him?

3. A teenage friend of your son comes by to visit. You notice that the girl looks dangerously thin, and so you keep offering her food. The girl gets upset at you, saying, “**I am trying to lose weight because I am too fat. You are not being my ally by offering me all this food! Why do you want me to get fatter? Why do you hate me?**” Should you agree with her that she really is fat, to show that you are her ally and you don’t hate her?

In each of these situations, there was a disagreement, but it was based on true concern for others. The disagreements were NOT based on hatred. If we truly care about people, then sometimes we might need to disagree with them, for their own good and for the good of others.

In our times some people want to change the fundamental meaning of marriage, some people want to change what it means to be a woman or a man, some people want to deny legal protection to prenatal boys and girls, and some people want to restrict reasonable religious liberties. In charity and gentleness, we should speak up for what is right, for the good of all persons. **We should not be intimidated from doing this for fear of being falsely accused of hatred.** Jesus was a sign of contradiction (Luke 2:34). So we are called at times to testify in contradiction to prevailing ideas and actions. May God give us the wisdom and grace to do so!

¿Desacuerdo significa odio?



Nuestra fe nos dice claramente que no debemos odiar a nadie. "Si alguno dice: 'Amo a Dios', pero aborrece a su hermano, es mentiroso; porque quien no ama a un hermano a quien ha visto, no puede amar a Dios a quien no ha visto. Este es el mandamiento que tenemos de Él: el que ama a Dios, ame también a su hermano." (1 Juan 4:20-21)

Jesús nos dio el mayor ejemplo de amar a todas las personas. En Su terrible e injusto sufrimiento en la cruz, Él podría haber expresado palabras muy odiosas hacia Sus perseguidores, o podría haberlos condenado a todos al infierno. En cambio, oró por ellos, diciendo: "Padre, perdónalos, no saben lo que hacen". (Lucas 23:34)

Por lo tanto, está mal odiar a alguien, ya sea por su raza, nacionalidad, creencias o incluso por el mal que esa persona ha hecho. Estamos llamados por Dios a desear el bien de todas las personas, sin excepción, especialmente el bien de su salvación eterna.

Pero eso no significa que debemos estar de acuerdo con las palabras o acciones de todos. ¡Algunas personas afirman que cualquiera que no esté de acuerdo con ellos debe odiarlos! Tal vez algunas personas odien injustamente a otras debido a fuertes desacuerdos, pero eso ciertamente no significa que todos los desacuerdos indiquen odio. ¡De hecho, lo contrario puede ser cierto! Considere estos ejemplos:

1. Una hija ruega a sus padres que la dejen ir a una fiesta esa noche. Pero sus padres hablan con algunas personas sobre esa fiesta y descubren que se llevará a cabo en una casa donde no habrá adultos presentes. También descubren que algunos de los que planeaban ir a la fiesta se habían metido en problemas recientemente por usar drogas ilegales. Entonces los padres le dicen a su hija que no pueden dejarla ir a esa fiesta. Ella grita: "¡No confías en mí y nunca me dejas divertirme! ¡Debes odiarme!" Corre a su habitación llorando, da un portazo y no sale a cenar. Sus padres se sienten mal. Pero, ¿deberían permitirle ir a la fiesta para demostrarle que no la odian?

2. Un amigo se emborracha en un evento deportivo. Le dices que deberías llevarlo a casa, ya que no has estado bebiendo. Tu amigo dice enojado: "Pensé que eras mi amigo, ¿por qué me tratas como si fuera un niño pequeño? ¿Me odias?" ¿Deberías estar de acuerdo en que está bien que él conduzca hasta su casa para demostrar que no lo odias?

3. Un amigo adolescente de su hijo viene de visita. Notas que la chica se ve peligrosamente delgada, por lo que sigues ofreciéndole comida. La niña se molesta contigo y te dice: "Estoy tratando de perder peso porque estoy demasiado gorda. ¡No estás siendo mi aliado al ofrecerme toda esta comida! ¿Por qué quieres que engorde? ¿Por qué me odias?" ¿Deberías estar de acuerdo con ella en que realmente está gorda, para demostrar que eres su aliado y que no la odias?

En cada una de estas situaciones, hubo un desacuerdo, pero se basó en una verdadera preocupación por los demás. Los desacuerdos NO se basaron en el odio. Si realmente nos preocupamos por las personas, a veces es posible que tengamos que estar en desacuerdo con ellas, por su propio bien y por el bien de los demás.

En nuestros tiempos, algunas personas quieren cambiar el significado fundamental del matrimonio, algunas personas quieren cambiar lo que significa ser mujer u hombre, algunas personas quieren negar la protección legal a los niños y niñas prenatales, y algunas personas quieren restringir libertades religiosas razonables. Con caridad y mansedumbre, debemos hablar por lo que es correcto, por el bien de todas las personas. **No debemos sentirnos intimidados de hacer esto por temor a ser acusados falsamente de odio.** Jesús era un signo de contradicción (Lucas 2:34). Así que a veces somos llamados a testificar en contradicción con las ideas y acciones prevalecientes. ¡Que Dios nos dé la sabiduría y la gracia para hacerlo!
