PARISH FIRE SAFETY IS THE 2018 NEED AT RISEN CHRIST
COST: \$9,000

Due in 2018:

- Annual inspection of fire sprinklers/extinguishers. Also, this year, and every 5 years, the 150 gallons of fire suppressant fluid must be drained and refilled. Inspection of every sprinkler head is performed.
- Semi-annual kitchen suppression inspection. Also, this year, and every 12 years, the kitchen hydrostatic tank must be sent for required testing.

JESUS' PARABLES IN THE SYNOPTIC GOSPELS

This adult education course will be Thursdays, 7:00–9:00PM, November 1st to December 6th, excluding Thanksgiving.

Jack McMahan leads each session.

Your bible will be needed, any translation.

- We'll start with basics: What is a parable? How does it differ from other literary devices that have elements in common, e.g., metaphors, similes, fables, legends?
- What is unique about the typical parable of Jesus?
- What pivotal role do the parables play within the structure of each of the synoptic gospels?
- What would a first century Jewish listener have understood when hearing the parables as first spoken by this first century Jewish preacher?
- Hint: It's likely to be different from what 3rd and 4th century Fathers of the Church understood the parables to mean — and we likely inherited.
- What is Jesus trying to tell me in my prayer life as I listen to the parables?

The Synoptic Gospels are Mark, Matthew and Luke. The Gospel of John does not use parables in narrating the life of Jesus.

Mark came first chronologically. Matthew and Luke borrow from Mark, sometimes changing/adding to the Parables of Mark. Mark wrote his parables to address different congregations from different countries/communities in the early years of the Church.
