Protocol for Parishes: Ebbing Pandemic

Bishop Peter Christensen announced the following protocols now in effect for all parishes:

- + Size limits for Mass and other gatherings no longer in effect.
- + Masks may be worn, but not required.
- + Distancing during Mass and other gatherings no longer in effect.
- + Parishes resume worship aids, e.g. hymnals, baskets...
- + Holy water fonts filled.
- + Ministries resume, e.g. lectors, servers, extraordinary ministers...
- + Sign of Peace returns to pre-Covid form.
- + Communion distributed in pre-Covid manner.
- + Communion from the chalice resumes June 5/6.
- + Dispensation from Sunday Mass obligation concludes June 5/6.
- + If these protocols raise health concerns, always use personal judgement about Mass attendance.

As Christians, we have been given the gift of new life through Jesus' Resurrection.
