

Jesus said to the crowds:

“This is how it is with the kingdom of God;

and through it all the seed would sprout and
grow,
he knows not how.

Of its own accord the land yields fruit,
first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in
the ear.

And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle
at once,
for the harvest has come.”

He said,

“To what shall we compare the kingdom of God,
or what parable can we use for it?

It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in
the ground,

is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth.

But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes
the largest of plants

and puts forth large branches,

so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its
shade.”

With many such parables

he spoke the word to them as they were able to
understand it.

Without parables he did not speak to them,
but to his own disciples he explained everything
in private.





In today's Gospel, Jesus compares the beginning of God's kingdom to a mustard seed. This tiny seed, which fits in the palm of a hand, can grow to fifteen feet with sprawling branches. Like the mustard seed, the Christian community had a tiny, seemingly insignificant beginning. The church, which began with about 120 followers, added three thousand people on Pentecost Day following the descent of the Holy Spirit. Since then, the number of Christ's disciples has grown incalculably and continues to grow throughout the world. Good stewards go about God's business of "planting seeds" among all those they encounter. What will we do this week to "plant seeds" and add to God's kingdom?

Building Fund Debt

Debt with National Knights Organization Loan Balance: \$2,567,600.82

We have completed a loan modification with the Knights of Columbus national organization in New Haven, CT. The new interest rate is 4%, down from 4.9%, and the new monthly payment is \$20,560.47, compared to \$23,559.99 on the previous loan. We have only modified the interest rate. The maturity date remains the same at 3/1/2035.




