
The sacrament of Reconciliation is being offered every Saturday from 3:45-4:45pm in the RCIA room off the church courtyard.



Dedication of a Church

What does it mean to “dedicate” a Church?

Previously referred to as the consecration of a Church, dedication is a rite in the Catholic Church by which a building is commissioned to serve permanently as a house of worship. Like kingship in the Old Testament, the building itself is anointed with sacred oil.

Is the dedication of a Church different than a blessing?

Any sacred worship spaces that are to be used are to be blessed before use. This includes buildings that are temporarily set aside for sacred worship. The dedication rite is reserved for those buildings that will be permanently used for worship. This Church, which was built expressly for worship and will be used expressly for this purpose has been dedicated.



What are the dedication candles and what is their purpose?

Six candles hang on the walls of the Church. These candles mark the spots where the walls of the Church have been anointed during the dedication rite. These candles were lit at the Dedication Mass and are lit on the anniversary of the dedication as a remembrance.

Who can perform the rite of dedication of a Church?

The rite of dedication can be carried out by the diocesan bishop or a priest specifically delegated by him. St. Gabriel Catholic Church was dedicated in 2011 by Bishop Robert Brom.
