RIGHT ON SCHEDULE!

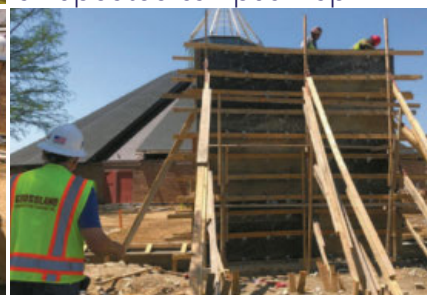


The month of May has been “foundational” with foundation being poured for the new chapel, the hallway surrounding the sanctuary, and our welcome center.
