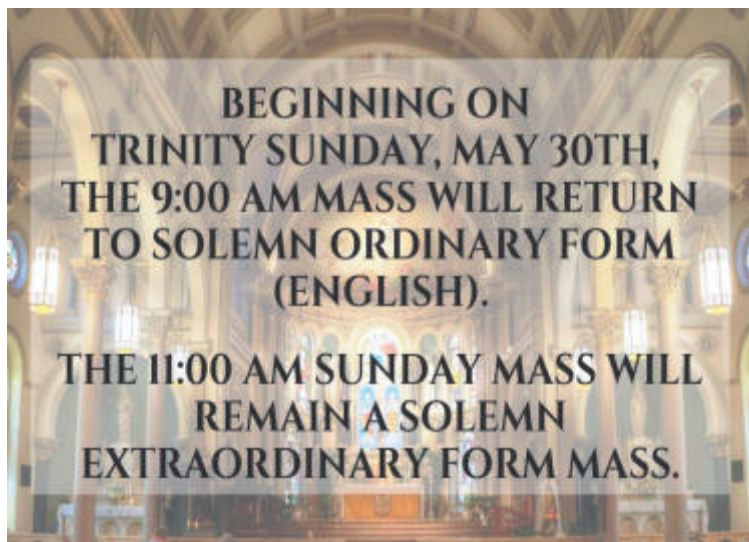

First Penance and Reconciliation and First Holy

Communion (FHC) – First Holy Communion Masses are scheduled for Corpus Christi (June 3 and 6, 2021). Parents, please continue to help your candidates be properly disposed for and attentive at Mass, how to use their missals, and learn the Mass responses. The Mass booklets given to the candidates earlier this year are helpful. Candidates should frequent the confessional after a thorough examination of conscience.

Confirmation 2021 – The class will meet Sunday, June 13, 2021 at 10:15am in the Foley House. Read Ch. 12 (Life in the Holy Spirit: Serving Others) and Epilogue (The Sacrament of Confirmation & Living the Christian Life). Ancillary work include memorizing the Church's doctrines concerning Holy Orders and Matrimony; Incarnation/Redemption (pp 7, 9-10, Preparation for Confirmation). All work is due.

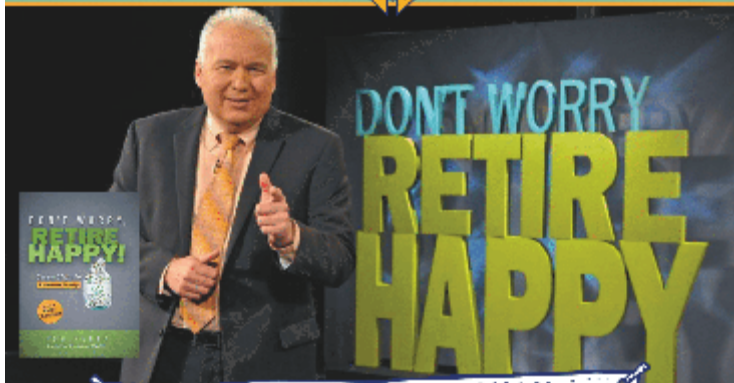

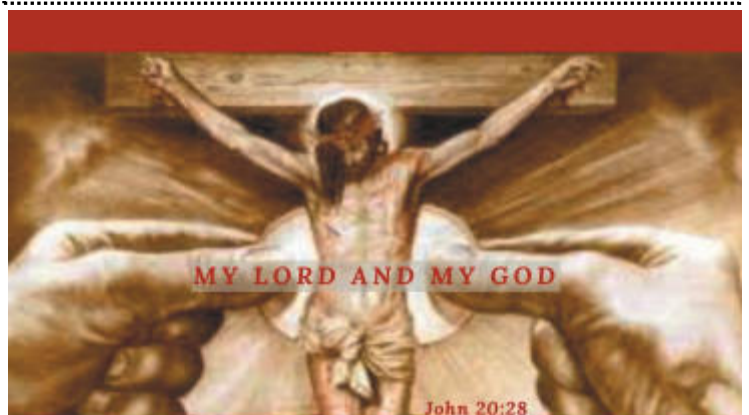

Video Message From Father Felix

Fr. Felix explains the modified pandemic restrictions and announces a change in Mass form in the video found at the following link:

Highlights include:

- I. Beginning with the 5:30 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, May 22, 2021, and thereafter:
 - a. Social distancing will no longer be required and we will be able to utilize 100 % of our seating capacity. Reservations (online or otherwise) will not be needed to attend Masses at Annunciation.
 - b. The wearing of face masks is encouraged but not required. Those who wish to wear a mask will be able to do so. Those who do not want to wear a mask will not be required to wear one.
 - c. Those who wish to receive Holy Communion on the tongue at Ordinary Form Masses (the Mass after Vatican II) will be allowed to do so. At Ordinary Form Masses, the communicant may receive Holy Communion on the tongue, or in the hand, at their discretion. We are all asked to exercise great care and reverence in the manner in which we present ourselves for Holy Communion so as to avoid all risk of profaning the most Holy Eucharist. The rubrics do not allow for Holy Communion to be received in the hand at Extraordinary Form Masses (the Mass before Vatican II).
 - d. The Precious Blood of Our Lord will not be offered to the faithful in a common chalice during the Rite of Communion throughout the Archdiocese until further notice.
 - e. Those at risk of suffering serious effects of the Coronavirus because of advanced age and/or other health complications may refrain from attending Mass without incurring serious sin. While it does not fulfill the obligation to attend Holy Mass in person, those who are at risk are strongly encouraged to view the Mass on video or via live-stream and unite themselves to the prayers of the Mass. Cardinal Dinardo's instruction regarding a general dispensation from the Sunday obligation remains in effect for all Catholics within the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston until further notice.
- II. Beginning on Trinity Sunday, May 30, 2021, and thereafter:
 - a. The Sunday Mass at 9 am will return to being celebrated as an Ordinary Form Solemn Mass, including the use of incense, chant, and more solemn ritual forms.
- III. Those who have been attending Sundays at 9am who have become attached to the Extraordinary Form of the Mass are encouraged to attend the 11am Solemn Extraordinary Form Mass.
- IV. Please continue to prayerfully remain spiritually close to those who have died, or who are sick, along with their families who are struggling amid suffering and loss. May we continue to take recourse to the Divine assistance the Lord offers to all who bear the Cross.

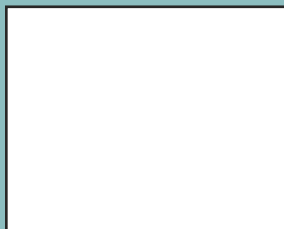
