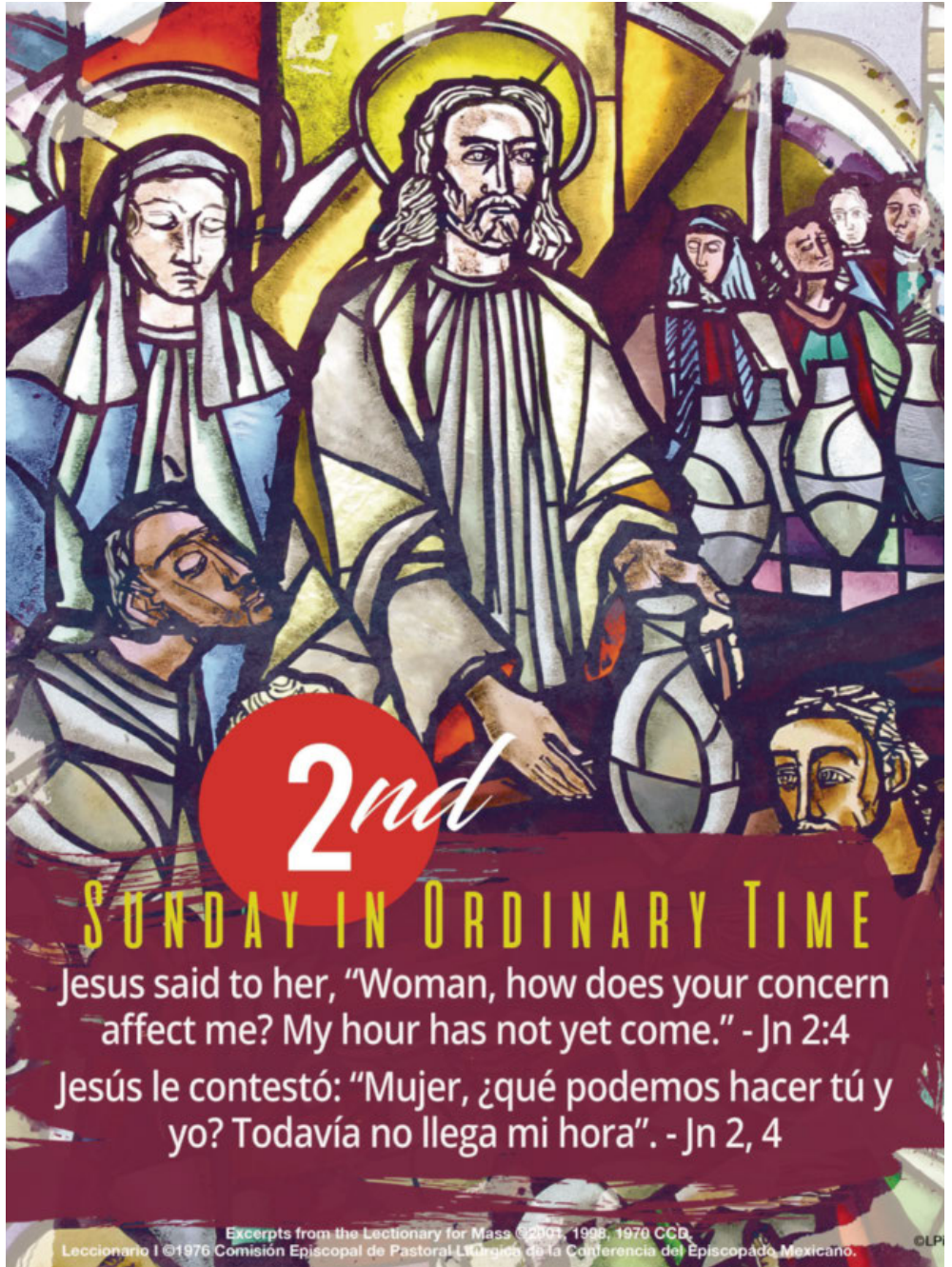

From the Pastor's desk – January 16, 2022.

Johnny Carson (who hosted the Tonight Show for 30 years), was interviewing an eight-year-old boy one night. The young man was asked to appear on the Late Show because he had rescued two friends from a coal mine outside his hometown in West Virginia. As Johnny questioned him, it became apparent that the boy was a Christian. Johnny asked him if he attended Sunday school. When the boy said he did, Johnny inquired, "What are you learning in Sunday school?" "Last week," the boy replied, "our lesson was about how Jesus went to a wedding and turned water into wine." The audience burst into laughter and applause. Keeping a straight face, Johnny asked, "And what did you learn from that story?" The boy squirmed in his chair. It was apparent he hadn't thought about this. But then he lifted up his face and said, "If you're going to have a wedding, make sure you invite Jesus and Mary!" And that is precisely the message of today's Gospel: make sure you invite Jesus and Mary wherever you live and wherever you go – they are the only ones you'll ever need. In other words, today's Gospel lesson is about the sufficiency of Christ in our lives and the power of his Mother's intercession.

Some time ago a woman wrote a fascinating article about redecorating her family home. Things went well until her husband overruled the interior decorator and hung a 16-by 20 inch picture of Jesus in the most prominent place in the house. She tried to get her husband to reconsider, but he absolutely refused. Then during a discussion with him, she recalled those words of Jesus: "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my Heavenly Father." That settled it. Her husband won. Now she says she is glad her husband won, because she thinks that picture of Jesus had a remarkable effect on her family and on visitors. The picture's most striking impact is on conversations, says the woman. It inevitably draws them to a higher level. The woman ends her article by saying she knows people will smile at her remarks and even ridicule them, but she doesn't care. "This much I know," she says. "When you invite Jesus into your home, you're never the same again." It is the message of the miracle of Cana. (Mark Link in Sunday Homilies).

Little Tommy was so impressed by his oldest sister's wedding that he announced. "I want to have a wedding just like Linda had." "That sounds great," said his father. "But whom will you marry?" Tommy announced: "I want to marry grandma because she loves me and I love her." "You can't marry grandma," his father said. "Why not?" Tommy protested. "Because she is my mother." "Well," reasoned Tommy. "Then why did you marry my mother?"

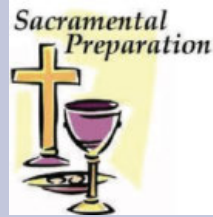

Now after all these years everything is changed. Now when I come home, my dog brings me my slippers and my wife barks at me." "I don't know what you are complaining about," said the counselor. "You are still getting the same service."

One woman asked the other, "You were always so organized in school, meticulously planning every detail. How did you plan your married life?" "Well," said her friend, "My first marriage was to a millionaire; my second marriage was to an actor; my third marriage was to a preacher; and now I'm married to an undertaker." Asked the friend, "What do those marriages have to do with a well-planned life?" "The first marriage was for the money, the second for the show, the third to get ready and the fourth to go!"

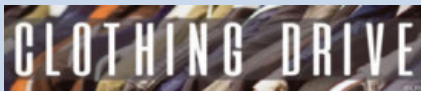

The Social Concerns Ministry

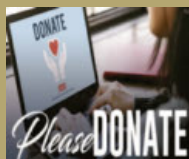

Helping Mothers Choose Life

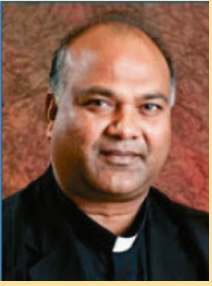

Johnny Carson (quien condujo el “Tonight Show” durante 30 años), estaba entrevistando a un niño de ocho años una noche. Se le pidió al joven que apareciera en el Late Show porque había rescatado a dos amigos de una mina de carbón en las afueras de su ciudad natal en Virginia Occidental. Cuando Johnny lo interrogó, se hizo evidente que el niño era cristiano. Johnny le preguntó si asistía a la escuela dominical. Cuando el niño dijo que sí, Johnny preguntó: “¿Qué estás aprendiendo en la escuela dominical?” “La semana pasada”, respondió el niño, “nuestra lección fue sobre cómo Jesús fue a una boda y convirtió el agua en vino”.

El público estalló en risas y aplausos. Con la cara seria, Johnny preguntó: “¿Y qué aprendiste de esa historia?” El niño se retorció en su silla. Era evidente que no había pensado en esto. Pero luego levantó el rostro y dijo: “¡Si vas a tener una boda, asegúrate de invitar a Jesús y María!” Y ese es precisamente el mensaje del Evangelio de hoy: asegúrese de invitar a Jesús y María donde quiera que vivas y a donde quiera que vayas; son los únicos que necesitará. En otras palabras, la lección del Evangelio de hoy trata sobre la suficiencia de Cristo en nuestras vidas y el poder de la intercesión de su Madre.

Hace algún tiempo, una mujer escribió un artículo fascinante sobre cómo redecorar la casa de su familia. Las cosas salieron bien hasta que su esposo decidió cambiar lo que el decorador de interiores había hecho y colgó una imagen de Jesús de 16 por 20 pulgadas en el lugar más prominente de la casa. Ella trató de hacer que su esposo reconsiderara, pero él se negó rotundamente. Luego, durante una conversación con él, recordó esas palabras de Jesús: “Todo el que me reconozca ante los demás, lo reconoceré ante mi Padre Celestial”. Eso resolvió el problema. Su marido ganó. Ahora dice que está contenta de que su esposo haya ganado, porque cree que la imagen de Jesús tuvo un efecto notable en su familia y en los visitantes. El impacto más sorprendente de la imagen está en las conversaciones, dice la mujer. Inevitablemente, los lleva a un nivel superior. La mujer termina su artículo diciendo que sabe que la gente sonreirá ante sus comentarios e incluso los ridiculizará, pero no le importa. “Esto es lo que sé”, dice. “Cuando invitas a Jesús a tu casa, nunca más eres el mismo”. Es el mensaje del milagro de Caná (Mark Link en las homilías dominicales)

El pequeño Tommy quedó tan impresionado por la boda de su hermana mayor que anunció. “Quiero tener una boda como la que tuvo Linda”. “Eso suena genial”, dijo su padre. “¿Pero con quién te casarás?” Tommy anunció: “Quiero casarme con la abuela porque ella me ama y yo la amo”. “No puedes casarte con la abuela”, dijo su padre. “¿Por qué no?” Tommy protestó. “Porque ella es mi madre”. “Bueno”, razonó Tommy. “Entonces, ¿por qué te casaste con mi madre?”

Un hombre que llevaba casado durante diez años estaba consultando a un consejero matrimonial. “Cuando me casé por primera vez, estaba muy feliz. Cuando volvía a casa después de un duro día en la tienda, mi perrito corría ladrando y mi esposa me traía mis pantuflas con una sonrisa reconfortante. Ahora, después de todos estos años, todo ha cambiado. Ahora cuando llego a casa, mi perro me trae mis pantuflas y mi esposa me ladra”. “No sé de qué se está quejando”, dijo el consejero. “Todavía está recibiendo el mismo servicio”.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Con la fiesta de la Epifanía y el Bautismo del Señor se cierra el Tiempo de Navidad, que siempre es precedido por el Adviento. Ahora, comenzamos el Tiempo Ordinario. Serán siete domingos de este corto periodo, que termina el día anterior al Miércoles de Ceniza. La segunda etapa de este Tiempo es más larga, da comienzo después del domingo de Pentecostés y termina hasta el sábado antes del primer domingo de Adviento. ¿Para qué sirve a los cristianos este Tiempo Ordinario? ¿Qué nos pide la Liturgia de este tiempo? Pues, es muy sencillo, nos pide meditar en el misterio de Cristo. En su invitación de participar en su Reino con alegría y compromiso verdadero. La Iglesia tiene diversidad de carismas, donde podemos entregarnos al servicio de los demás.

Por ejemplo, hoy el Evangelio nos invita a participar junto con María y Jesús en las bodas de Caná. Y es ahí en esa boda, donde Jesús hace su primer milagro a petición de su Madre María. El diálogo de ambos viene a ser a causa de la falta de vino. Por lo tanto, los novios estaban en apuros por esta razón. Este relato es muy profundo, el hecho de que Jesús participa en la boda, tiene como significado la boda de Dios con la humanidad, que más adelante será la Sangre de Jesús derramada para la salvación de la humanidad. “Alegrémonos, regocijémonos démosle honor y gloria, porque han llegado las bodas del Cordero” (Apocalipsis 19,7). También, el profeta en la primera lectura lo pone claro: “No te llamen más ‘Abandonada’, ni a tu tierra ‘Desolada’, sino que te llamen ‘Mi Preferida’ y a tu tierra ‘Desposada’. Porque Yavé se complacerá en ti y tu tierra tendrá un esposo” (Isaías 62,4).

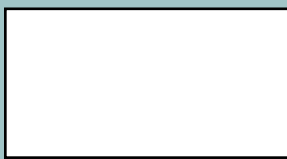
