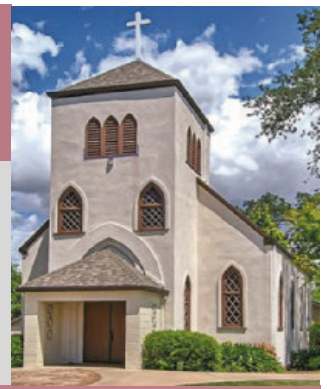

DEADLINE FOR FILING CLAIMS

The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento, Case No. 24-21326 U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of California Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024. On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO. If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese. Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024. 3 TIPS FOR CATHOLIC PARENTS

October, Halloween can be a challenging time for Catholic parents. As the days grow shorter and the nights creep in, neighborhoods often transform into spooky scenes—graveyards sprouting in front yards, ghosts peeking through windows, and decorations getting scarier each year. But as Catholic parents, we can approach Halloween differently by focusing on our faith, teaching our children about the angels and saints, and offering a new perspective on this season. The following tips can help us celebrate without glorifying the darker side of the holiday.

1. Focus on Angels and Saints Let's tell the rest of the spiritual story of goodness verse evil. Oftentimes as a culture the focus is only on the darkness- instead of seeing the glory of God in overcoming this darkness, as parents we can never allow this evil into our hearts, homes or the hearts of our children. All Saints Day is always on November 1 and is meant to remind us of the glory of God and how evils is always overcome!

2. Rethink Treats When you think of Halloween it is always connected with candy! However, it is so easy to go overboard and get carried away. Consider alternatives like pencils, stickers, or glow sticks. They're fun, affordable, and can make your house stand out as a place of light and joy. Even small gestures like these can transform Halloween into a more thoughtful and intentional celebration.

3. Decorate with Intention We all enjoy decorating for fall, but as Catholic families, it's worth asking: What message are we sending with our decorations? Avoid decorations that glorify fear or darkness. Instead, we keep things simple—pumpkins, lanterns, maybe a cheerful welcome mat.

3 CONSEJOS PARA LOS PADRES CATÓLICOS

Octubre, Halloween puede ser un momento difícil para los padres católicos. A medida que los días se acortan y las noches se acercan, los vecindarios se transforman en escenas espantosas: cementerios que brotan en los patios, fantasmas que se asoman a través de las ventanas y decoraciones que se vuelven más aterradoras cada año. Pero como padres católicos, podemos abordar Halloween de manera diferente si nos enfocamos en nuestra fe, enseñamos a nuestros hijos sobre los ángeles y los santos, y ofrecemos una nueva perspectiva sobre esta temporada. Los siguientes consejos pueden ayudarnos a celebrar sin glorificar el lado oscuro de este día festivo.

1. Enfócate en los ángeles y los santos

Vamos a contar el resto de la historia espiritual de la bondad contra la maldad. A menudo, como cultura, el enfoque está solo en la oscuridad, en lugar de ver la gloria de Dios al vencer esta oscuridad, como padres nunca podemos permitir que este mal entre en nuestros corazones, hogares o corazones de nuestros hijos. El Día de Todos los Santos es siempre el 1 de noviembre y está destinado a recordarnos la gloria de Dios y cómo el mal siempre es vencido.

2. Repensar las golosinas ¡Cuando piensas en Halloween, siempre está relacionado con los dulces! Sin embargo, es muy fácil pasarse de la raya y dejarse llevar. Considera alternativas como lápices, calcomanías o barras luminosas. Son divertidos, asequibles y pueden hacer que su casa se destaque como un lugar de luz y alegría. Incluso pequeños gestos como estos pueden transformar Halloween en una celebración más reflexiva e intencional.

3. Decora con intención A todos nos gusta decorar para el otoño, pero como familias católicas, vale la pena preguntarse: ¿Qué mensaje estamos enviando con nuestras decoraciones? Evite las decoraciones que glorifiquen el miedo o la oscuridad. En cambio, mantenemos las cosas simples: calabazas, linternas, tal vez un tapete de bienvenida.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

GOSPEL MEDITATION OCTOBER 6TH

As a young pastor years ago, I met with a middle-aged couple who had been divorced and civilly remarried. They were frustrated that an annulment had to precede a Church marriage. Sympathizing with their plight, I promised to walk with them along their journey. Once as we sat in my office, the man said to me, "Why is the Church so difficult on marriage?" I replied, "Actually, Jesus' teaching is what's difficult." He furrowed his brow and asked what I meant.

We opened the Bible and together read today's gospel passage from Mark 10:12 in which Jesus says, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another, commits adultery with her..." My two friends sat in silent astonishment. Surely Jesus understands the complexities of human life and sexual love. The words hung thick and heavy in the air. How could the merciful Lord be so seemingly unrealistic in his expectations, especially with so much divorce and remarriage in our world?

I didn't know what to say. So, we kept reading. Next, Jesus says, "Let the children come to me." The innocence of children allows them to receive and give love, to trust unconditionally, to believe in love that endures. Most children aren't yet jaded by statistics, broken hearts, or dysfunctional relationships. Children remind us of the world to come. The couple and I began to talk about child-like trust in Jesus and his teaching, and we continued to move forward. When it comes to the Church's demanding teaching on marriage, it's best to approach it as trusting children, whatever situations in which we find ourselves.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica en el numeral 1601 nos dice lo siguiente: "La alianza matrimonial, por la que el varón y la mujer constituyen entre sí un consorcio de toda la vida, ordenado por su misma índole natural al bien de los cónyuges y a la generación y educación de la prole, fue elevada por Cristo Nuestro Señor a la dignidad de sacramento entre los bautizados". Y continúa diciendo en el numeral 1662: "El matrimonio se funda en el consentimiento de los contrayentes, es decir, en la voluntad de darse mutua y definitivamente con el fin de vivir una alianza de amor fiel y fecundo. Pidamos siempre por los matrimonios porque es proyecto de Dios, que quiere que lo que él unió, no lo separemos. El Papa Francisco recomienda tres palabras a los matrimonios: "Por favor, gracias y perdón". ¿Qué opinas de esto? ¿Estás dispuesto(a) a luchar por tu matrimonio?"

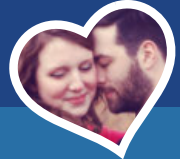
