

Today we are invited to reflect on life and to hope in an imperishable existence. We rarely advert to life until it is threatened. Then it appears all the more precious to us for its very fragility.

The faith of Jairus, whose twelve-year -old daughter is at death's door, and the faith of that desperate woman whose life has been ebbing away with her blood for twelve years should be our faith. At the juncture of these two intertwining stories, there is in fact but one point of emphasis, Jesus does not disdain the naïve, almost superstitious faith of the woman with a hemorrhage who furtively touches him in the hope of being healed. Nor does he ignore the frantic faith of Jairus who has no other answer for the doubting crowd. To them, it is all too clear that no one can do anything against death. For Jesus, Death is but a sleep which awakens to a morning of resurrection.

Hope sleeps in each of us. We must regularly take its hand, awaken it, set it in motion. This marvel is possible only by faith in the One who can make our nights, however dark they may be, give way to an Easter morning. (St. Andrew's Missal p. 642)

La fe de Jairo, cuya hija de doce años está a las puertas de la muerte, y la fe de esa mujer desesperada cuya vida se ha ido desvaneciendo con su sangre durante doce años debería ser nuestra fe. En la coyuntura de estas dos historias entrelazadas, de hecho, solo hay un punto de énfasis, Jesús no desdeña la fe ingenua, casi supersticiosa de la mujer con una hemorragia que lo toca furtivamente con la esperanza de ser sanada. Tampoco ignora la fe frenética de Jairo, que no tiene otra respuesta para la multitud que duda. Para ellos, está muy claro que nadie puede hacer nada contra la muerte. Para Jesús, la muerte no es más que un sueño que despierta a una mañana de resurrección.

La esperanza duerme en cada uno de nosotros. Debemos tomar su mano con regularidad, despertarla, ponerla en movimiento. Esta maravilla sólo es posible por la fe en Aquel que puede hacer que nuestras noches, por oscuras que sean, den paso a una mañana de Pascua. (Misal de San Andrés pág. 642)




WHAT IS AN ORDINATION?

Ordination is the sacrament ceremony in which a man becomes a deacon, a priest, or a bishop and enabled to minister in Christ's name and that of the church. There are three ordinations in the Sacrament of Holy Orders: diaconate; priesthood; and episcopal. The ordination ceremony includes various rituals, rich in meaning and history, e.g., prostration, laying on of hands, anointing of hands, giving of the chalice and paten, sign of peace. HELP SPX SCHOOL RECEIVE MATCH DOLLARS

We are in the third quarter of the Endowment and Tuition Assistance (TA) program, fundraising for dollars to be matched by Joe Weston. The goal is to raise the maximum match-able dollars before September 15, 2021. You were so very generous the last two quarters. We thank God and pray He will bless you a hundredfold.

Weston ArchPdX Catholic Schools Endowment Match Program (\$45,000)

Currently, 34K has been raised and will be matched. *We have 11K left as potential matching funds* in this program. This program is open to all for participation, including current school families. Both the donations and matching funds will become part of the permanently restricted funds in the endowment, allowing for growth in earnings that are used to support student financial assistance.
