PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Hello, I am Deacon Tristan Dillon. After eight full years of seminary formation, I can safely say that I'm still not good at talking about myself. I have been asked to give my vocation story numerous times and every time it feels a bit different. I'm asked to give a few points of my life that define me and my journey into the Seminary. Each time I give this story, it seems that there are different points that are more important than others. What I do know as important, is that I am a Roman Catholic thanks to the grace of God and my mother's conversion.



My mother was raised in the Church of Latter Day Saints, but in 1993, just a little over a year before I was born, she was baptized at the Cathedral of the Madeleine in Salt Lake City, Utah. I know that I would not be here without her heroic act to enter Christ's Church. She did this with no support from friends and disdain from her family. She then moved to Seattle, Washington with my father and sister. My mom missed the beauty of the liturgy at the Cathedral of the Madeleine, so my family would attend mass at St. James Cathedral every week. One of my earliest memories is listening to the beautiful choir and organ of the Cathedral, looking up at my mother, tugging on her sleeve and telling her, "Mom, I love our Church." My entire life I have been in complete love with the liturgy of the Mass.

When I was sixteen, my father got a job in St. George, Utah. We then packed up all our possessions and moved to Southern Utah. After arriving in Utah I began to volunteer at the local parish and spend time praying before the Lord in Adoration discerning why God had called me to Utah. It was here that I began to discern my vocation with a simple prayer asking God, "What am I supposed to do with my life?" After making this prayer through my sophomore and junior years of high school, I felt drawn to the priesthood. I realized that I wanted to give my life to Jesus Christ in a crazy and radical fashion, and I wanted to be able to serve the people of God. I began to meet with my local priest for spiritual direction. He then shipped me off to Salt Lake City to meet with the Vocations Office and the Bishop. I was accepted to the diocese and sent to Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon in the fall of 2013 to begin my Seminary journey. In 2017, I graduated from the college program with a degree in Philosophy and Literature. I have since continued there for my graduate studies in Theology.

A little about myself, I love hiking, especially in the red rocks of Utah. Zion National Park is one of the most beautiful places in the world, and I cannot spend enough time there. I also have a deep love of poetry and novels, especially the works of T.S. Eliot. I'm a huge movie buff. I would never call myself a true movie critic, but I do enjoy good movies. If you have any good recommendations, I'd love to hear them. As a child of the Pacific Northwest, I do also have a deep love for Punk and Grunge music. My mother is from the South, so I love eating and cooking good southern comfort food.

It's crazy to think that my seminary career started eight years ago and now I am a Transitional Deacon. This has been a beautiful journey and I have been blessed with so many wonderful priests and friends to help me with my discernment. At this point, I only have a year left until I am ordained a Priest of Jesus Christ. I am excited that I am now able to serve you all as a Deacon here at St. Pius X. I cannot wait to meet all of you and get to know you better! So far, you have all been so kind and wonderful. I feel truly blessed to be here at St. Pius X.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Hola, soy el diácono Tristan Dillon. Después de ocho años completos en el seminario, puedo decir con seguridad que todavía no soy bueno hablando de mí mismo. Me han pedido que cuente la historia de mi vocación en numerosas ocasiones y cada vez se siente un poco diferente. Se me pide que dé algunos puntos de mi vida que me definen a mí y a mi viaje al Seminario. Cada vez que cuento esta historia, parece que hay diferentes puntos que son más importantes que otros. Lo que sí sé que es importante es que soy Católico Romano gracias a la gracia de Dios y la conversión de mi madre.

Mi madre se crió en la Iglesia de los Santos de los Últimos Días, pero en 1993, poco más de un año antes de que yo naciera, se bautizó en la Catedral de la Madeleine en Salt Lake City, Utah. Sé que no estaría aquí sin su acto heroico de entrar en la Iglesia de Cristo. Lo hizo sin el apoyo de sus amigos con el desdén de su familia. Luego se mudó a Seattle, Washington con mi padre y mi hermana. Mi mamá extrañaba la belleza de la liturgia en la Catedral de la Madeleine, así que mi familia asistía a misa en la Catedral de St. James todas las semanas. Uno de mis primeros recuerdos es escuchar el hermoso coro y el órgano de la Catedral, mirar a mi madre, tirar de su manga y decirle: "Mamá, amo nuestra Iglesia". Toda mi vida he estado completamente enamorado de la liturgia de la Misa.

Cuando tenía 16 años, mi padre consiguió un trabajo en St. George, Utah. Luego empacamos todas nuestras posesiones y nos mudamos al sur de Utah. Después de llegar a Utah, comencé a trabajar como voluntario en la parroquia local y a pasar tiempo orando ante el Señor en Adoración para discernir por qué Dios me había llamado a Utah. Fue aquí donde comencé a discernir mi vocación con una simple oración preguntando a Dios: "¿Qué se supone que debo hacer con mi vida?" Después de hacer esta oración durante mi segundo y tercer año de la escuela secundaria, me sentí atraído por el sacerdocio. Me di cuenta de que quería entregarle mi vida a Jesucristo de una manera loca y radical y quería poder servir al pueblo de Dios. Comencé a reunirme con mi sacerdote local para recibir dirección espiritual. Luego me envió a Salt Lake City para reunirme con la Oficina de Vocaciones y el Obispo. Me aceptaron en la diócesis y me enviaron al Seminario Mount Angel en Oregon en el otoño de 2013 para comenzar mi viaje al Seminario. En 2017, me gradué del programa universitario con un título en Filosofía y Letras. Desde entonces he continuado allí para mis estudios de posgrado en Teología.

Un poco sobre mí, me encanta el senderismo, especialmente en las rocas rojas de Utah. El Parque Nacional Zion es uno de los lugares más bellos del mundo y no puedo pasar suficiente tiempo allí. También tengo un profundo amor por la poesía y las novelas, especialmente las obras de T.S. Eliot. Soy un gran cinéfilo. Nunca me llamaría un verdadero crítico de cine, pero disfruto de las buenas películas. Si tiene buenas recomendaciones, me encantaría escucharlas. Como hijo del noroeste del Pacífico, también tengo un profundo amor por la música punk y grunge. Mi madre es del sur, así que me encanta comer y cocinar buena comida casera sureña.

Es una locura pensar que mi carrera en el seminario comenzó hace ocho años y ahora soy un diácono de transición. Este ha sido un viaje hermoso y he sido bendecido con tantos sacerdotes y amigos maravillosos que me ayudaron con mi discernimiento. En este punto, solo me queda un año hasta que sea ordenado Sacerdote de Jesús Cristo. Estoy emocionado de poder servirles a todos como diácono aquí en Sand Pío X. ¡No puedo esperar para conocerlos a todos y conocerlos mejor! Hasta ahora, todos han sido tan amables y maravillosos, me siento realmente bendecido de estar aquí en San Pío X.



Do not wait until a priest retires or is transferred to celebrate their service. Like Father's Day, let Priesthood Sunday be the one day a year when we make it a point to make priests feel truly appreciated and special.

What is Priesthood Sunday? Priesthood Sunday is a special day set aside to honor priesthood in the United States. It is a day to reflect upon and affirm the role of the priesthood in the life of the Church as a central one. This nationwide event is coordinated and sponsored by the US Council of Serra International.

When is Priesthood Sunday celebrated? Priesthood Sunday is celebrated on the last Sunday of September. *Note:* Parishes may choose to celebrate Priesthood Sunday on another Sunday when it is convenient for them.

Why is Priesthood Sunday important? Catholics are invited to observe Vatican-backed worldwide events, namely, [World Day of Prayer for Vocations](#) and [World Day for Consecrated Life](#). In the United States, we also have [National Vocation Awareness Week](#) and [National Catholic Sisters Week](#). **Priesthood Sunday, however, specifically honors priests, without whom the Mass could not be offered and Sacraments could not be celebrated.**

More than the other events listed above, Priesthood Sunday is a more personal one for parishes and organizations with a chaplain. It is for those who cultivate close working relationships with their priests and therefore could benefit from a special day to express their gratitude. It's a chance to thank and honor priests in unique ways.

It is essential to note that **the number of priests and ordinations in the United States has steadily declined in the past 50 years.** Meanwhile, the number of parishes without a resident priest pastor has sharply increased in the same period of time. ([See the official statistics from the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate \(CARA\) here.](#)) **The men who answer the call to priesthood are special indeed, and they are working harder than ever before.**






