

OH, MY HOLY FAMILY

This year's celebration of Holy Family has special significance for me. In October, I had the awesome opportunity to visit the minor basilica, La Sagrada Familia, in Barcelona, Spain. Construction of this basilica started in 1882 and is still being worked on today. They estimate completion of this great work in 2030.

If you haven't seen it, look it up and check out the pictures of it. It really is quite amazing. However, I think it's over the top for many reasons. One thing I can share with you is that I was scheduled to celebrate Mass in the crypt of the church that day. So as I moved through the basilica with a guide, I found myself growing in an understanding of what the Holy Family means to me. You see, for many years I struggled with my relating with the Holy Family, with Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. I always thought that my family had to -in some way- use them as our role model. There is truth to this, however, how can my family relate to such perfection?

As I continued to look up at all the details presented by one of its architects, Antoni Gaudí, the basilica became one large presentation of salvation history that finds the Holy Family at the core, moves to the Passion of Christ, and leads to the building up of the Church, from which my family has been built up.

So when it finally came time for Mass, I preached a homily that I wasn't expecting. I also preached this homily again for my family in Houston, Texas while I was home to celebrate Thanksgiving this year. I reflected on the difficulty of living up to the perfection of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. I spoke about how my dad has often reflected the love of our heavenly Father, but at times, he also came up short. What is beautiful is that his reflection of the love and his faith in our heavenly Father was enough to help me to have a faith in God the Father. As I visited my mom, who is continuing her decline with dementia, I shared that I have been driven to Mary our mother to guide me and console me. As I reflected on the craziness, loveliness, and messiness of my brother and sisters, I reflected on the Word made flesh, who calls us brothers, sisters, and friend. He came to give his life as a ransom for ours. He came to do this to grant us access to the sacraments, which makes us members -real members- of the Holy Family. Because of this connectedness, I can recognize the holy in my family. Merry Christmas to you all and your Holy Families.

OH, MI SAGRADA FAMILIA

La celebración de la Sagrada Familia de este año tiene un significado especial para mí. En octubre, tuve la increíble oportunidad de visitar la basílica menor, La Sagrada Familia, en Barcelona, España. La construcción de esta basílica se inició en 1882 y todavía se está trabajando en la actualidad. Estiman la finalización de este gran trabajo en 2030.

Si no la ha visto, búsquela y mire sus fotos. Realmente es bastante asombrosa. Sin embargo, creo que es exagerada por muchas razones. Una cosa que puedo compartir con ustedes es que estaba programado para celebrar misa en la cripta de la iglesia ese día. Así que mientras me movía por la basílica con un guía, me encontré creciendo en una comprensión de lo que la Sagrada Familia significa para mí. Verá, durante muchos años luché con mi relación con la Sagrada Familia, con Jesús, María y José. Siempre pensé que mi familia tenía que, de alguna manera, usarlos como nuestro modelo a seguir. Hay verdad en esto, sin embargo, ¿cómo puede mi familia relacionarse con tal perfección?

Mientras seguía mirando todos los detalles presentados por uno de sus arquitectos, Antoni Gaudí, la basílica se convirtió en una gran presentación de la historia de la salvación que encuentra a la Sagrada Familia en el centro, se traslada a la Pasión de Cristo y conduce a la edificación de la Iglesia, de la que se ha formado mi familia.

Entonces, cuando finalmente llegó la hora de la Misa, prediqué una homilía que no esperaba. También prediqué esta homilía nuevamente para mi familia en Houston, Texas, mientras estaba en casa para celebrar el Día de Acción de Gracias este año. Reflexioné sobre la dificultad de vivir a la perfección de Jesús, María y José. Hablé de cómo mi padre a menudo reflejaba el amor de nuestro Padre celestial, pero a veces, también se quedaba corto. Lo hermoso es que su reflejo del amor y su fe en nuestro Padre celestial fue suficiente para ayudarme a tener fe en Dios Padre. Mientras visitaba a mi madre, que continúa su declive con la demencia, le conté que me habían llevado a María, nuestra madre, para guiarme y consolarme. Al reflexionar sobre la locura, la belleza y el desorden de mis hermanos y hermanas, reflexioné sobre el Verbo hecho carne, que nos llama hermanos, hermanas y amigos. Vino a dar su vida en rescate por la nuestra. Vino a hacer esto para darnos acceso a los sacramentos, lo que nos convierte en miembros -miembros reales- de la Sagrada Familia. Debido a esta conexión, puedo reconocer a los santos en mi familia. Feliz Navidad a todos ustedes y a sus Santas Familias.




