This is our festival, this is the feast we celebrate today, in which God comes to live with human beings, that we may journey toward God, or return—for to speak thus is more exact—that laying aside the old human being we may be clothed with the new...(St. Gregory Nazianzen)

I so love the Feast of the Epiphany. It has had a special place in my heart. It was on the Epiphany, when after trying many times to get off using tobacco, that the image of the Magi spoke to me while being the pastor in Ashland, to enter the new year by a different way. I meditated with the question, "How can we go back to our former ways after meeting the Christ Child?" I needed to change. So with the help of God, I was released from the addiction to tobacco. Ever since I try and look at the New Year as an opportunity to let God bring further healing.

Recalling my three talks of Advent, You Have Been Chosen and You are Being Sent, I want to reflect on this first reading from the prophet Isaiah:

Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you.

See, darkness covers the earth, and thick clouds cover the peoples; but upon you the LORD shines, and over you appears his glory.

I want to change out the place of Jerusalem, and put in St. Pius X. I really want us to have a sense that the Lord shines upon us and through us, people experiencing darkness can come to know God's glory.

Desde entonces, trato de ver el Año Nuevo como una oportunidad para dejar que Dios traiga más sanidad.

Recordando mis tres discursos de Adviento, Has sido elegido y estás siendo enviado, quiero reflexionar sobre esta primera lectura del profeta Isaías: ¡Levántate en esplendor, Jerusalén! Tu luz ha llegado, la gloria del Señor brilla sobre ti. Mira, las tinieblas cubren la tierra, y las nubes espesas cubren a los pueblos; pero sobre ti resplandece el Señor, y sobre ti aparece su gloria.

Quiero cambiar el lugar de Jerusalén y poner San Pío X. Realmente quiero que tengamos la sensación de que el Señor brilla sobre nosotros y, a través de nosotros, las personas que experimentan la oscuridad pueden llegar a conocer la gloria de Dios.





### Inspiration for the week

Human beings easily get bored. Life's routines can become so predictable that there is often little time for excitement or freshness. Today is all about the new and the wonderful. In celebrating the beauty and simplicity of the Epiphany, we see in tangible ways God's creative, redemptive, and restorative power. This refreshment and revitalization is offered not only to a select few but to everyone throughout the world. There is nothing routine or static about God. Surprises, wonders, miracles, opportunities, healings, and joy without measure are available to those who believe. There are never any endings, just beginnings. And, when darkness, boredom, and gloom seem to be the order of the day, a bright new light now shines pointing us to truth and reminding us that we are loved.



#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

The patron saint of Catholic schools, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (August 28, 1774 – January 4, 1821) was born in New York City to a prominent family of the Episcopal faith. When she turned 19, she married a wealthy businessman with whom she had five children. He later died of tuberculosis in 1803, leaving her a young widow. After discovering the Catholic faith in Italy, where her husband had died, she returned to New York and converted to Catholicism in 1805.

After several years struggling as a single mother, Elizabeth moved in 1809 to Emmitsburg, Maryland, where she founded the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph, the first community for religious women established in the United States. She also began St. Joseph's Academy and Free School, which started a chain reaction of Catholic-based education in the United States that continues today.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was canonized September 14, 1975 in St. Peter's Square by Pope Paul VI and was the first citizen born in the United States to be given the title of "saint."


