***"You are my beloved; with you I am well pleased."***

This is what our heavenly Father spoke from heaven about Jesus on receiving John's baptism in the Jordan River. I believe this is what is spoken by our Father after every Baptism is complete. I really enjoyed the commentary on this Feast in the Magnificat:



*Why did Jesus, the all-holy Son of God, seek John's baptism of repentance? It was not to receive—for he is himself the source of all grace—but to give. "Christ is baptized, not to be made holy by the water, but to make the water holy, and by his cleansing to purify the waters which he touched" (St. Maximus of Turin). Christ's baptism reveals to us what our own baptism now accomplishes: the forgiveness of sin and a share in his divine sonship. The words heard from the heavens could be said about every person baptized since. "Baptism places upon our souls a mark that forever will identify it as one privileged of God" (Sr. Mary Jean Dorcy, OP). (Magnificat January 2022 pg.121-122)*

So if this is true, we should have a sense about us, that the prophet Isaiah is writing about the Messiah: (Is. 42:1-4, 6-7)

Thus says the LORD:

Here is my servant whom I uphold,  
 my chosen one with whom I am pleased,  
 upon whom I have put my spirit;  
 he shall bring forth justice to the nations,  
 not crying out, not shouting,  
 not making his voice heard in the street.  
 a bruised reed he shall not break,  
 and a smoldering wick he shall not quench,  
 until he establishes justice on the earth;  
 the coastlands will wait for his teaching.

I, the LORD, have called you for the victory of justice,  
 I have grasped you by the hand;  
 I formed you, and set you  
 as a covenant of the people,  
 a light for the nations,  
 to open the eyes of the blind,  
 to bring out prisoners from confinement,  
 and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness.

We have been chosen and are being sent to play our part in this mission. Although it will look different for each of us, we need to engage it. We were born for these times.

No era para recibir, porque él mismo es la fuente de toda gracia, sino para dar. “Cristo es bautizado, no para ser santificado por el agua, sino para santificar el agua, y por su limpieza para purificar las aguas que tocó” (San Máximo de Turín). El bautismo de Cristo nos revela lo que nuestro propio bautismo ahora logra: el perdón de los pecados y una participación en su filiación divina. Las palabras escuchadas desde los cielos podrían decirse acerca de cada persona bautizada desde entonces. “El bautismo coloca sobre nuestras almas una marca que siempre lo identificará como un privilegiado de Dios” (Sor Mary Jean Dorcy, OP). 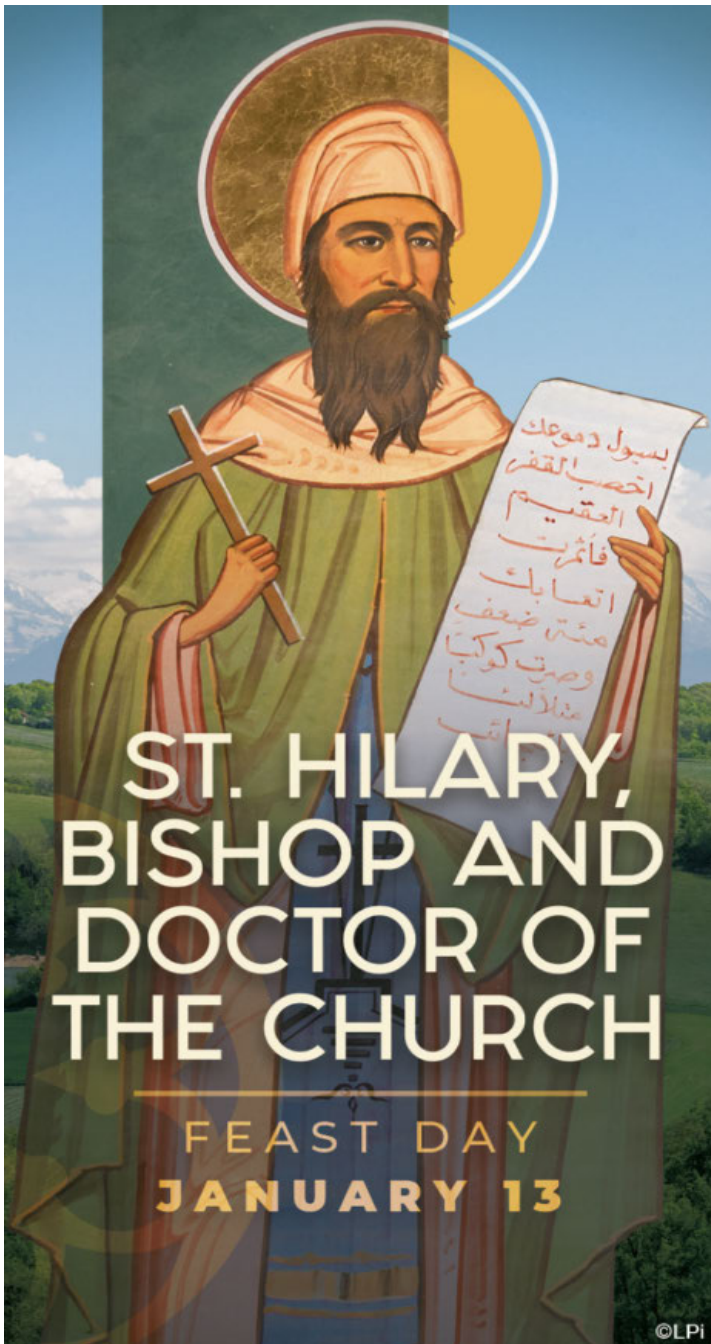

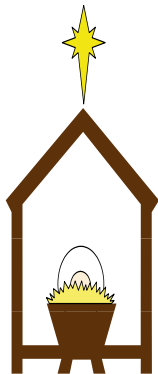

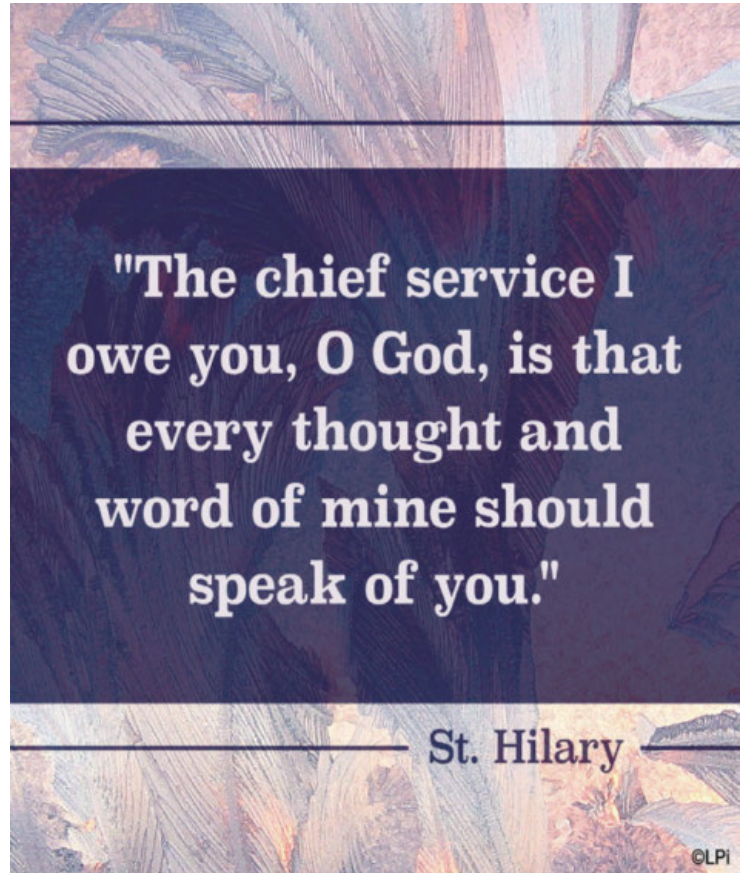
