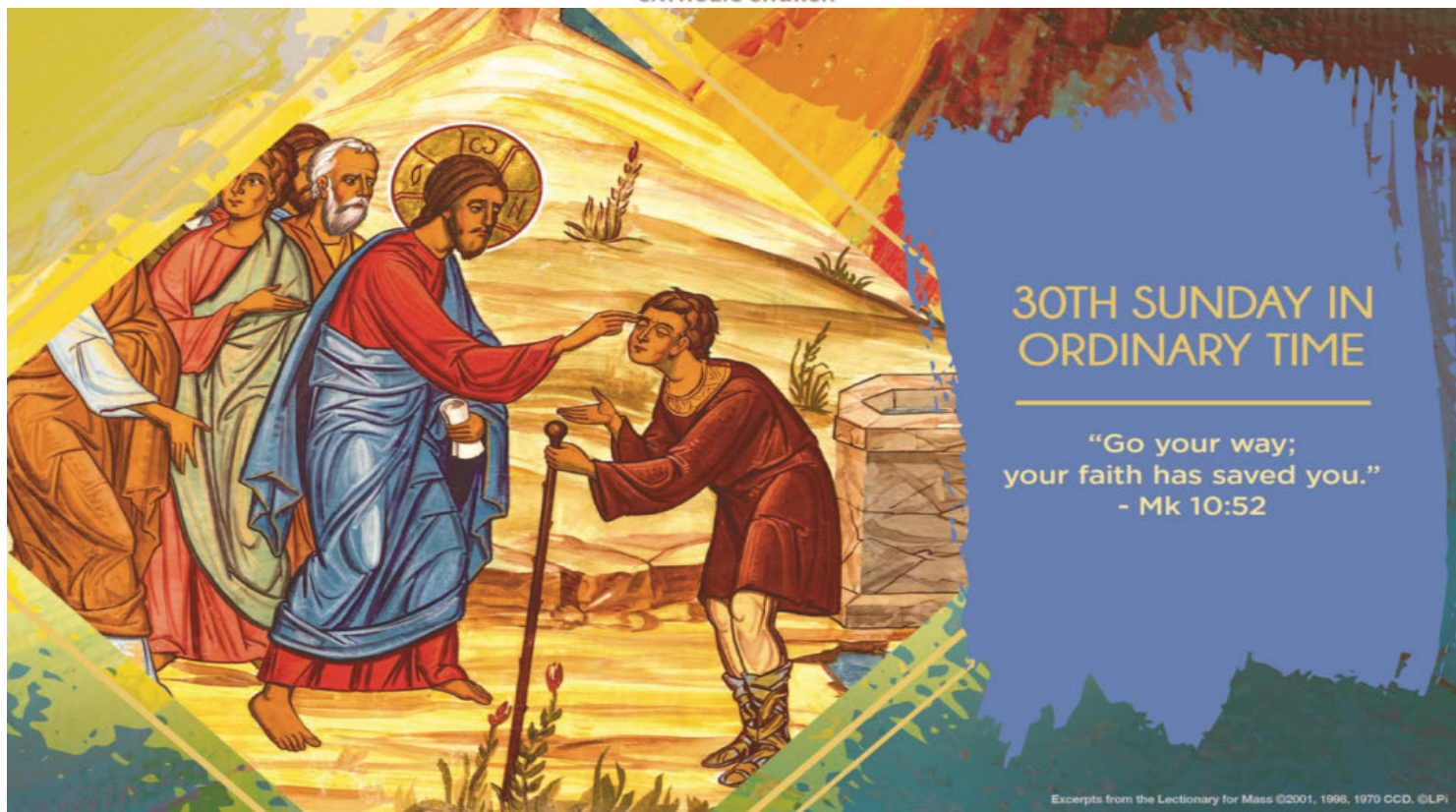

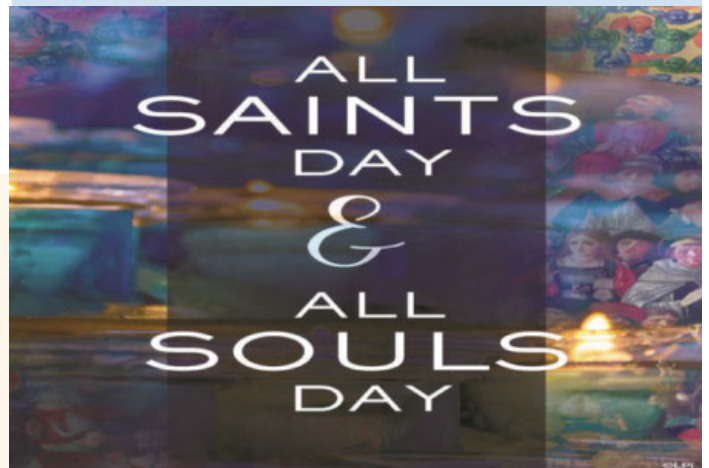

After his ordination at Our Lady of Good Shepherd Cathedral Rushoraza in 2013, he was assigned to the minor seminary as a teacher and formator at same time being one of the Vocation Directors. At age 33, he was chosen and sent for studies in Sacred Liturgy at St. Anselm Pontifical University in Rome where he did Masters and Doctorate Degrees in Sacred Liturgy until 2024.

He had a short visit and stay at Santiago de Compostela upon invitation of some parishioners he connected with while at St. Francis of Assisi in Gallup, New Mexico and the hospitality extended by Fr. Thomas Naval.
