

MESSAGE FROM FR. DAN



3RD SUNDAY OF EASTER

I am continuing my series of letters (after a break for Easter) for the future of our community. Easter tells me so much about the health and growth of our families. We had 24 masses and services for the Triduum. Only about 11,000 people went through our doors. For our health and for the people of Chandler that is a grace and a blessing. Some of our facilities at St. Mary's are aging and though our building at St Juan Diego is new, it is incomplete. For Easter Sunday we had about 2000 people at our 9:45 am mass. With a parish hall we could have the events and activities that helps our growing family to keep thriving. Now with prices going up seemingly every day due to inflation, saving our money and watching carefully for the right time to build will be both an act of prayer and stewardship. I pray often for wisdom in this area and perhaps you can do so as well. Pentecost is just around the corner, maybe an extra Veni Sancte Spiritu (Come Holy Spirit prayer) will help our efforts to plan, save and find the right time to build.



Please keep in prayer the children who are being Confirmed and celebrating their First Eucharist starting this week. We have over 130 students who will be completing their Sacraments of Initiation into the Catholic faith.






MENSAJE DE PADRE DAN



3º DOMINGO DE PASCUA

Continúo con mi serie de cartas (después de un receso por la temporada de Pascua) para el futuro de nuestra comunidad. La Pascua me dice mucho sobre la salud y el crecimiento de nuestras familias. Tuvimos 24 misas y servicios para el Triduo. Solo unas 11,000 personas cruzaron nuestras puertas. Para nuestra salud y para la gente de Chandler eso es una gracia y una bendición. Algunas de nuestras instalaciones en St. María están envejeciendo y, aunque nuestro edificio en San Juan Diego es nuevo, está incompleto. Para el Domingo de Pascua tuvimos alrededor de 2,000 personas en nuestra misa de 9:45 am. Con un salón parroquial podríamos tener eventos y actividades que ayuden a nuestra creciente familia a seguir prosperando. Ahora que los precios suben aparentemente todos los días debido a la inflación, ahorrar nuestro dinero y observar cuidadosamente el momento adecuado para construir será tanto un acto de oración como de administración. 
