ELEVENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Brothers and sisters: We are always courageous, although we know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord,... For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense, according to what he did in the body, whether good or evil.

The second reading today reminds us that there is much more to life than we sometimes imagine. Frequently we become preoccupied with the minor details of life—we spend time looking for the right shoes or clothes, we worry about what others think of us, we occupy ourselves with things that don't really matter that much. It is understandable, it is natural that we attend to these details—these things are important.

The challenge of this reading from 2 Corinthians is for us to keep our eyes fixed on the things that matter most. Our relationship with God is most important. We need to pray. We need to teach our children to love God and trust God. Married people need to pray together—what could be more important? If our lives are balanced—if we have cultivated a trusting relationship with the living God—the other parts of our lives will also be more balanced.

Our ultimate vocation, our ultimate goal is eternal life with God. Let us keep our hearts and minds focused on the greatest gift God offers.

DECIMO PRIMER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Hermanos: Siempre tenemos confianza, aunque sabemos que, mientras vivimos en el cuerpo, estamos desterrados, lejos del Señor.... Porque todos tendremos que comparecer ante el tribunal de Cristo, para recibir el premio o el castigo por lo que hayamos hecho en esta vida.

La segunda lectura de hoy nos recuerda que hay mucho más en la vida de lo que a veces imaginamos. Con frecuencia nos preocupamos por los pequeños detalles de la vida: pasamos tiempo buscando los zapatos o la ropa adecuados, nos preocupamos por lo que los demás piensan de nosotros, nos ocupamos de cosas que realmente no importan tanto. Es comprensible, es natural que prestemos atención a estos detalles, estas cosas son importantes.

El desafío de esta lectura de 2da de Corintios es que mantengamos nuestros ojos fijos en las cosas que más importan. Nuestra relación con Dios es lo más importante. Necesitamos rezar. Necesitamos enseñar a nuestros hijos a amar a Dios y a confiar en Dios. Las personas casadas necesitan orar juntas, ¿qué podría ser más importante? Si nuestras vidas están equilibradas, si hemos cultivado una relación de confianza con el Dios viviente, las otras partes de nuestras vidas también estarán más equilibradas.

Nuestra máxima vocación, nuestro objetivo final es la vida eterna con Dios. Mantengamos nuestro corazón y nuestra mente enfocados en el mayor regalo que Dios ofrece.

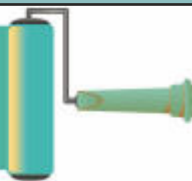
