#### Find happiness in God's Will

Word of Life for June 2021

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord', will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven." (Mt 7:21)

According to Matthew's Gospel, the Christian's law par excellence is mercy, which is the fulfilment of every act of worship and love for the Lord. While this Word of Life helps our relationship with God, which is certainly personal and intimate, it also opens us up to a fraternal dimension, as we take concrete actions. It urges us to "go out" of ourselves to bring reconciliation and hope to others.

A group of young people from Heidelberg, Germany gave this testimony: "How could we make our friends experience that the key to happiness lies in giving oneself to others? This is where we started to launch our new action, entitled 'One hour of happiness.' The idea is very simple: to make another person happy, at least for one hour a month.

"We started with the people who we felt most needed love, and wherever we offered our availability, doors were thrown wide open! And so, there we were: in a park, pushing some older people in wheelchairs; or in a hospital, playing with children; or doing sports with people with disabilities.

"They were overjoyed but, as the action promises, our joy was even greater! And our friends who were invited to participate? At first, they were intrigued, but now that they have tried to make other people happy, they agree with us: happiness can be given and the return can be felt."

### THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The readings today give us an opportunity to reflect on what God has planned for us. In the Book of Wisdom we hear, "God did not make death, nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living." The second reading from 2 Corinthians states, "For you know the gracious act of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, for your sake he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich." It seems that God wants us to prosper and live long healthy happy lives and to be rich. It sounds good, but is this really God's plan for us?

About 40 years ago a new Christian theology developed; "The Word of Faith." A more generic name for the same idea is simply the "Prosperity Gospel." The idea is that if we are faithful God will provide for all our needs. These people believe that Jesus doesn't want us to suffer or be poor or experience pain in our lives. They believe that if we trust enough in God our problems will vanish and we will always prosper and be happy. The true proponents of this doctrine reject that Jesus really suffered and died and that he only "spiritually" resurrected. They teach that if bad things happen to you it is because you have no faith. Sadly, this form of Christianity has become popular—television is filled with preachers promising a life without suffering, or challenge. Typically, they ask that their followers say a prayer and send them money and their lives will be perfect.

As Catholics we know better: we know that our spiritual journey is complex. To be a faithful follower of Jesus we need to embrace Him in all aspects of our lives. We believe that all our experiences in life have meaning. The joy and happiness we experience in life encourage us to believe in the goodness of God. The difficult times in life, physical sickness or the death of a loved one, teach us that God is present to us in all aspects of life. We might be wealthy young and good-looking, or we might be poor and old, it doesn't really matter. Christ is always close and all aspects of our lives are important.

### DECIMOTERCER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Las lecturas de hoy nos dan la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre lo que Dios ha planeado para nosotros. En el Libro de la Sabiduría oímos: "Dios no hizo la muerte, ni se regocija en la destrucción de los vivientes". La segunda lectura de 2 Corintios dice: "Bien saben lo generoso que ha sido nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que siendo rico, se hizo pobre por ustedes, para que ustedes se hicieran ricos con su pobreza." Parece que Dios quiere que prosperemos y vivamos vidas sanas y felices y seamos ricos. Suena bien, pero, ¿es este realmente el plan de Dios para nosotros?

Hace unos 40 años se desarrolló una nueva teología cristiana; "La Palabra de Fe". Un nombre más genérico para la misma idea es simplemente el "Evangelio de la prosperidad". La idea es que, si somos fieles, Dios se encargará de todas nuestras necesidades. Estas personas creen que Jesús no quiere que suframos, que seamos pobres o experimentemos dolor en nuestras vidas. Creen que, si confiamos lo suficiente en Dios, nuestros problemas desaparecerán y siempre vamos a prosperar y ser felices. Los verdaderos defensores de esta doctrina rechazan que Jesús realmente sufrió y murió y que él solo resucitó "espiritualmente". Enseñan que si te pasan cosas malas es porque no tienes fe. Tristemente, esta forma de cristianismo se ha vuelto popular: la televisión está llena de predicadores que prometen una vida sin sufrimiento ni desafío. Por lo general, piden que sus seguidores digan una oración y les envíen dinero, y sus vidas serán perfectas.

Como católicos, sabemos reconocer; sabemos que nuestro viaje espiritual es complejo. Para ser un fiel seguidor de Jesús, debemos aceptarlo con amor en todos los aspectos de nuestras vidas. Creemos que todas nuestras experiencias en la vida tienen un significado; la alegría y la felicidad que experimentamos en la vida nos alientan a creer en la bondad de Dios. Los tiempos difíciles en la vida, la enfermedad física o la muerte de un ser querido; nos enseñan que Dios está presente en todos los aspectos de la vida. Podríamos ser ricos, jóvenes y bien parecidos, o podríamos ser pobres y viejos, en realidad no importa. Cristo siempre está cerca y todos los aspectos de nuestras vidas son importantes.


