### FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

From the Old Testament prophet Ezekiel we hear powerful words; “As the Lord spoke to me, the spirit entered into me and set me on my feet, and I heard the one who was speaking say to me: Son of man, I am sending you to the Israelites...” We must ask what it means to be “set on our feet?” This is an unusual turn of phrase.

The prophet is speaking about God intervening in his life and giving him new direction. By setting him on his feet God is directing him to do something special. God’s people Israel had turned away and forgotten the special relationship God continually offers. Ezequiel is being sent to do something that seems impossible—to call God’s people to faithfulness. The image is powerful: God physically takes Ezequiel and puts him on the path of doing something that seems impossible. But we must remember that with God all things are possible.

Sometimes it appears that our society has “lost its way.” People have turned from traditional values and traditional morality and seem to be selfishly living for themselves. (This criticism could probably be made of all societies throughout history—human nature is the same.) Still as followers of Christ we are sent forth to proclaim a different truth, a different vision. Like the prophet, we are called to proclaim a difficult message—a message that is countercultural.

Unlike the prophet, we are sent by the Christ we know and we have experienced. We are not talking about something or someone we have simply heard about, but we are proclaiming the living God who has entered our human experience. We proclaim Christ through whom we have the promise of eternal life because we are truly the adopted sons and daughters of God, true sisters and brothers of the Lord Jesus.

### DECIMO CUARTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Del profeta Ezequiel del Antiguo Testamento escuchamos palabras poderosas; “En aquellos días, el espíritu entró en mí, hizo que me pusiera en pie y oí una voz que me decía: “Hijo de hombre, yo te envío a los israelitas...” Debemos preguntarnos, ¿qué significa "ponerse de pie"? Este es un giro inusual de la frase.

El profeta está hablando de que Dios interviene en su vida y le da una nueva dirección. Al ponerlo de pie, Dios lo dirige a hacer algo especial. El pueblo de Dios, Israel, se había alejado y olvidado la relación especial que Dios ofrece continuamente. Ezequiel está siendo enviado a hacer algo que parece imposible: llamar al pueblo de Dios a la fidelidad. La imagen es poderosa: Dios toma físicamente a Ezequiel y lo pone en el camino de hacer algo que parece imposible. Pero debemos recordar que con Dios todo es posible.

A veces parece que nuestra sociedad ha "perdido el rumbo". La gente se ha apartado de los valores tradicionales y la moralidad tradicional y parece vivir egoístamente para sí misma. (Esta crítica probablemente podría hacerse a todas las sociedades a lo largo de la historia; la naturaleza humana es la misma). Aun así, como seguidores de Cristo, somos enviados a proclamar una verdad diferente, una visión diferente. Como el profeta, estamos llamados a proclamar un mensaje difícil, un mensaje contracultural.

A diferencia del profeta, somos enviados por el Cristo que conocemos y hemos experimentado. No estamos hablando de algo o alguien de quien simplemente hemos escuchado, sino que estamos proclamando al Dios vivo que ha entrado en nuestra experiencia humana. Proclamamos a Cristo a través de quien tenemos la promesa de la vida eterna porque somos verdaderamente hijos e hijas adoptivos de Dios, verdaderas hermanas y hermanos del Señor Jesús.

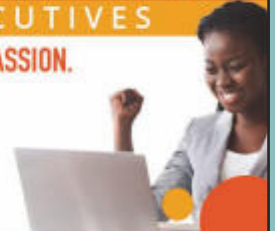
