THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

The mystery of Christ's baptism in the Jordan by St John, the Precursor, proposes the contemplation of an already adult Jesus. This mystery is infinitely linked to the Solemnities of the Lord's birth and the Epiphany that we have just celebrated, as in some ways it takes up and represents their significance to us.

At Christmas we have contemplated the human birth of the Word incarnate by the Virgin Mary. In the 4th century, the Fathers of the Church deepened the understanding of the faith with regard to the Christmas mystery in the light of Jesus' Humanity. They spoke of the Incarnation of the Word already working like the 'Christification' of that humanity that he had assumed from His mother. Or put in simpler terms: Jesus is the Christ from the first instant of conception in Mary's spotless womb because He Himself, with His Divine Power, consecrated, anointed and 'Christified' that human nature with which He became incarnate.

In the mystery of the Epiphany, we then meditated on Christ's manifestation to all nations that was represented by the Magi, the wise men from the East, who came to adore the Child.

Now, in the mystery of Christ's Baptism in the Jordan River, we again encounter and represent the truth of the Lord's incarnation and His manifestation as the Christ. Jesus' Baptism is in fact His definitive manifestation as the Messiah or Christ to Israel, and as the Son of the Father to the entire world. Here we find the dimension of the Epiphany which was His manifestation to all nations. The Father's voice from heaven shows that Jesus of Nazareth is the eternal Son and the descent of the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove shows the Trinitarian nature of the Christian God. The true and unique God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, shows Himself in Christ, through Him, with Him and in Him. (Joseph Ratzinger, *Jesus of Nazareth*, Bloomsbury 2007, p 18).

EL BAUTIZO DEL SEÑOR

El misterio del bautismo de Cristo en el Jordán por San Juan, el Precursor, propone la contemplación de un Jesús ya adulto. Este misterio está infinitamente ligado a las solemnidades del nacimiento del Señor y a la Epifanía que acabamos de celebrar, ya que de alguna manera retoma y representa su importancia para nosotros.

En Navidad hemos contemplado el nacimiento humano del Verbo encarnado por la Virgen María. En el siglo IV, los Padres de la Iglesia profundizaron en la comprensión de la fe en relación con el misterio navideño a la luz de la humanidad de Jesús. Hablaron de la Encarnación del Verbo actuando ya como la 'Cristificación' de esa humanidad que Él había asumido de su madre. O dicho en términos más simples: Jesús es el Cristo desde el primer instante de la concepción en el vientre inmaculado de María porque Él mismo, con Su Divino Poder, consagró, ungió y 'Cristificó' esa naturaleza humana con la que se encarnó.

En el misterio de la Epifanía, meditamos luego sobre la manifestación de Cristo a todas las naciones que fue representada por los Magos, los sabios de Oriente, que vinieron a adorar al Niño.

Ahora, en el misterio del bautismo de Cristo en el río Jordán, nuevamente encontramos y representamos la verdad de la encarnación del Señor y Su manifestación como Cristo. El bautismo de Jesús es de hecho su manifestación definitiva como Mesías o Cristo a Israel, y como Hijo del Padre al mundo entero. Aquí encontramos la dimensión de la Epifanía que fue Su manifestación a todas las naciones. La voz del Padre desde el cielo muestra que Jesús de Nazaret es el Hijo eterno y el descenso del Espíritu Santo en forma de Paloma muestra la naturaleza trinitaria del Dios cristiano. El verdadero y único Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, se muestra en Cristo, por Él, con Él y en Él. (Joseph Ratzinger, *Jesús de Nazaret*, Bloomsbury 2007, p 18).

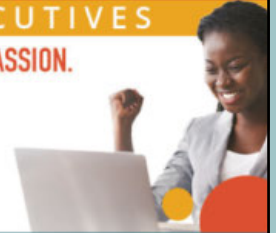
