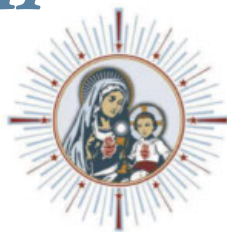

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Love, perhaps above any other experience, can cause us great hardship, pain, and suffering, especially when it's authentic and unconditional. While it can thrust us into an incredible experience of God and life on one hand, it can bruise and wound us deeply on the other because love makes us vulnerable. Mastering the art of love is the secret to living life well, walking in the presence of God and investing in the joy of the Gospel. Love and suffering walk hand in hand. Compromising one will compromise the other. Many really successful people and saints were brought to their station in life because they suffered. Suffering teaches us about what's important and propels us to search the depths of our souls for resources and strength we never would have known before. Maybe that's why Jesus spent so much time convincing us to accept both.

LITURGICAL FOCUS

Imitate the 10 Amazing Virtues of the Blessed Mother – Week 1

1. Profound Humility

Meaning: Profound – Penetrating or entering deeply into subjects of thought or knowledge.

Humility – Free from pride and arrogance; lowliness of mind.

How Mary demonstrated profound humility: Mary perfectly conformed herself to God’s Will. She saw herself as God saw her, nothing more and nothing less.

How we can live out this virtue: See yourself as God sees you! Pray the Litany of Humility, accept compliments gracefully and quietly, and don’t be embarrassed to make mistakes in front of others. Don’t be surprised to find faults and sins in your life—just turn to God and ask Him to help you with them. Say “yes” to God’s Will in your life.

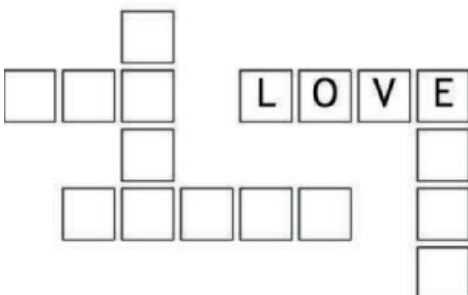

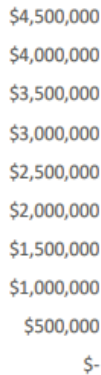


DEBT REDUCTION

The April monthly payment for the Parish Center building loan was \$10,587 -- \$2,917 applied to the principal balance and \$7,670 for interest expense. We thank those parishioners who are continuing their generous donations to cover the loan payments. The current principal balance of the loan is \$1,840,661. The Debt Reduction donations are deposited to a separate designated bank account. Donations in excess of the monthly payments are in reserve for future payment on the principal balance. We hope to refinance for more favorable terms when the current loan terms allow.
