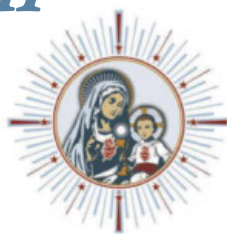

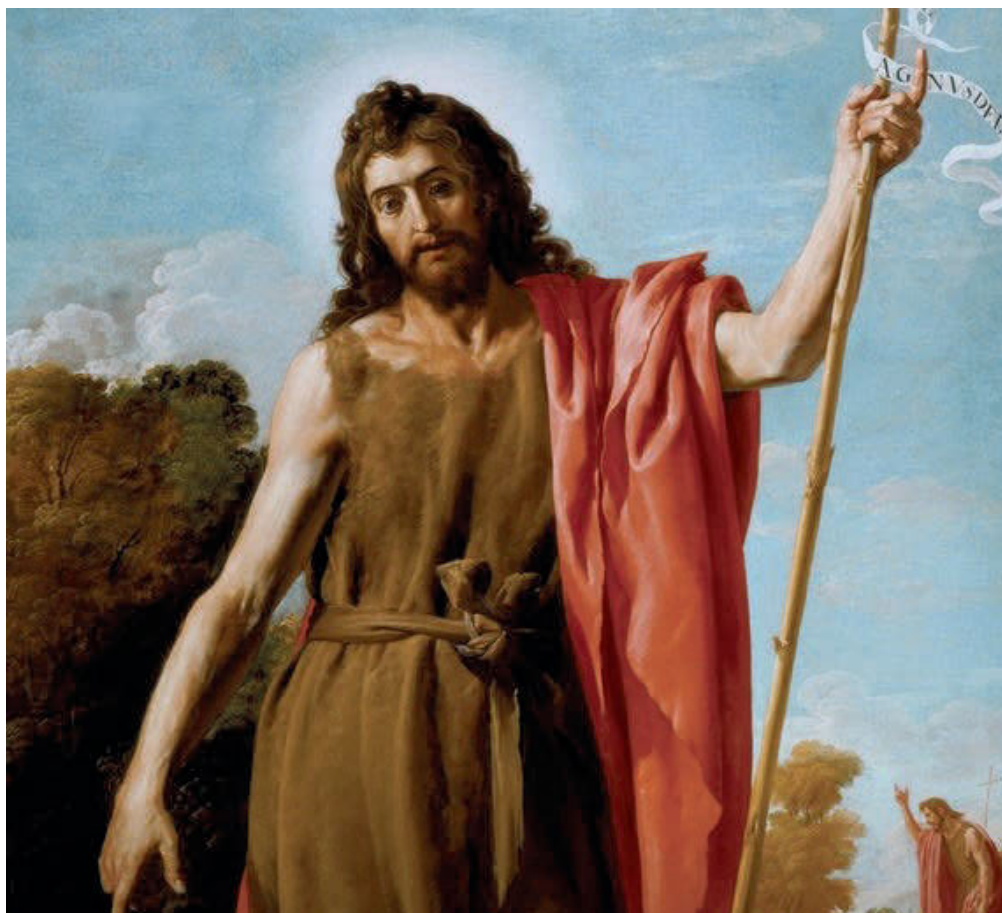

GOSPEL REFLECTION

We often want God to fix things or intervene and change nature's course. When He doesn't act as we desire, it shakes our faith. We do not always understand or appreciate why things happen as they do. There is much that is beyond our control. John the Baptist prepared the way for Jesus and Jesus is the way to God. There is something more going on in life than what we can see with human eyes. We are on a sacred path, and God is with us. God is with us in our confusion, suffering, doubts, and intense sadness. Jesus announced God's vision for humanity and taught people to see God and themselves for who they are. There is a way through and beyond all hardship and suffering. God does not abandon us.

REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

LITURGICAL FOCUS**The Immaculate Conception**

"Immaculate Mary, your praises we sing!" On Thursday, December 8th, we celebrate one of our Marian feast days. **The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a Holy Day of Obligation.** From the beginnings of the Church, spiritual writers and theologians have acknowledged the innocence and holiness of Mary. St. Irenaeus called her the "new Eve." Both Mary and Eve were given pure freedom to accept or reject God. Mary began the work of redemption with her yes to God! The Church began to celebrate the feast of Mary's conception in the early Middle Ages. In 1854, Pope Pius IX infallibly declared that Mary was free of original sin from the first moment of her conception. On this feast day, we celebrate the beauty and goodness of Our Lady!

**ENFOQUE LITÚRGICO****La Inmaculada Concepción**

"María Inmaculada, tus alabanzas cantamos!" El jueves 8 de diciembre celebramos una de nuestras fiestas marianas. **La Solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción de la Santísima Virgen María es un Día Santo de Obligation.** Desde los inicios de la Iglesia, escritores espirituales y teólogos han reconocido la inocencia y la santidad de María. San Ireneo la llamó la "nueva Eva." Tanto a María como a Eva se les dio libertad pura para aceptar o rechazar a Dios. María comenzó la obra de la redención con su sí a Dios. La Iglesia comenzó a celebrar la fiesta de la concepción de María a principios de la Edad Media. En 1854, el Papa Pío IX declaró infaliblemente que María estaba libre del pecado original desde el primer momento de su concepción. En este día de fiesta, celebramos la belleza y la bondad de Nuestra Señora.

On Sunday, November 27, we begin Advent, and it begins four Sundays before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. Advent means "coming," but who is coming?

Jesus, our savior, is coming. That is why Advent is equal to hope; it is a

time of waiting for the birth of God in the world, a time of change and prayer to commit ourselves to Christ and wait for him with joy. During this time, a crown of Advent is made; a crown of green foliage, which symbolizes eternity, hope, and life, and four candles (the four Sundays of Advent) are placed, symbolizing our walk toward the manger, the light, which is Christ.

SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On December 8, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin. (This feast is also a holy day of obligation for dioceses in the United States.) On this feast, we celebrate Mary's conception free from the stain of Original Sin, and we recognize that Mary's life began the moment she was conceived in the womb of St. Anne. So, too, does every human life begin at the moment of fertilization, when it is lovingly knit together by God the Father.
