FROM THE PASTOR

Jesus said to his disciples: "As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love." Remain in me. Regardless of what happens to you; regardless of what people do to you; regardless of who you are or what you have done, remain in my love. Before demanding from His followers that they keep His Father's commandments, the Lord commands His disciples to "remain in my love."

You don't have to be perfect; you don't have to be useful; you don't even have to be number one. All you need to do is remain in His love. When good times strike, consider it a blessing. When bad times strike, consider it an opportunity to show the world who you believe in. A friend of mine recently told me a story about his former boss and how downright unethical he was in his financial books and with his clients. Unfortunately for my friend, the good guys didn't win, and he was forced out. That was twenty years ago. Then suddenly, a few weeks ago, he received word that his former boss had been arrested on assault charges. Instead of gloating about it or sending him a quick little "what goes around comes around" email, my friend decided to write him an encouraging email and to pray for him. His former boss - former enemy - couldn't believe it. He thanked my friend and was extremely happy to hear from him.

There is such a thing as forgiveness! Remain in me, as I remain in you. As the Father loves me, so I also love you. We, as Christians, have been called to remain in Christ; in other words, to follow Him - in every word and deed - whether convenient or inconvenient. His words and actions inspire. But we have also been called to remain in each other; that is, with our Christian sisters and brothers - whether convenient or inconvenient. Through Him, with Him and in Him, we are all connected. Without ever realizing it, as my friend told me his story, he was inspiring me to imitate him, and in no less a manner as Christ's words inspires me to imitate Him. Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him and we will come to him.

As the Father loves me, so I love you. These words are just too profound to overlook them. As the Father loves me - imagine for a moment how the Father loves His Son. This is not some sentimental statement. This is deep and intense! And in just the same way...the Son loves me!

As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Wow! WOW!WOW! How can anyone read this...and just keep reading on??? At Mass I had to pause for a moment. Really! It was just too much to take in. These words are truly deep, yet reassuring; intense yet comforting. This is the reality of Christ and the mystery of faith.

Why does the Son love us so much? Is it because of what He can accomplish through us? No. Is it because He needs us? Not really. Then why? I believe it is because of who we are: His brothers and sisters. He loves us because we were created in the image and likeness of God.

And that's enough.



Mot de notre Aumônier

Bien aimés frères et sœurs, chers amis,

Les textes de ce dimanche semblent à première vue bien différents les uns des autres et sans lien entre eux : Dans la 1ère lecture, les Actes des Apôtres nous parlent du 1er concile de Jérusalem qui doit faire face au lien entre la Foi et la Loi, avec le problème d'intégrer la tradition de Moïse et l'ouverture aux païens dans une même foi. Ap 21, dans la 2ème lecture, nous propose la vision de la Jérusalem céleste, de l'avènement du Royaume ordonné autour de la figure de l'Agneau, le Christ. Enfin, dans l'Evangile, Jean nous parle du don de l'Esprit Saint source de joie et d'amour pour qui demeure en Christ. Essayons de lire ces trois textes à partir des trois axes ci-après : La Loi comme une carte qui balise le chemin de la foi : Jésus nous dit que la Loi de Moïse n'est pas abolie mais accomplie en lui. Il ne s'agit pas comme chrétien de rayer d'un coup de plume la Loi et les Prophètes, l'AT et les ¾ de la Parole de Dieu. La Loi et la tradition de l'Eglise sont nécessaires car elles nous donnent des repères et des indications utiles pour comprendre le monde et discerner le bien du mal, le juste et l'injuste, le péché et la grâce. La Loi, c'est un peu une carte routière qui indique le chemin au croyant. On a tous besoin de la Loi pour savoir où aller, savoir quel chemin emprunter, quel itinéraire choisir. Mais la Loi n'est pas le but du voyage, elle n'est pas une fin en soi. La Loi ne dit pas toujours quel chemin emprunter et comment se sortir d'une impasse. Il y a parfois plusieurs itinéraires possibles et plusieurs chemins en fonction d'où nous partons et où nous nous trouvons. Pour se diriger et pour que la carte soit utile, il faut une boussole pour trouver le bon chemin et parfois rectifier la route.


L'Esprit Saint comme boussole du croyant : « L'Esprit Saint que le Père enverra en mon nom, lui vous enseignera tout, et il vous fera vous souvenir de ce que j'ai dit. » La carte ne suffit pas, il faut la boussole du Saint Esprit pour nous guider sur le chemin et choisir le bon. L'Esprit Saint nous dit Jésus nous ne pouvons le recevoir et l'utiliser comme boussole que si nous sommes aimantés par l'amour de Jésus, la paix du cœur et la joie de la Foi. L'Esprit guide et aide à prendre le bon itinéraire. Cela veut dire aussi qu'il faut savoir discerner et réfléchir dans une vie de croyant. On ne peut pas se contenter de la carte car parfois on est perdu et on ne sait plus où on est. L'Esprit est là alors pour aider à changer de cap et retrouver le chemin. Le but du voyage, c'est le Royaume de l'Agneau : La carte et la boussole ne servent à rien si on ne sait pas où l'on va et quel est le but du voyage. L'Apocalypse nous révèle quel est ce but et vers quoi nous devons tendre. Nous devons tendre vers le Royaume de l'Agneau immolé, le Royaume de justice et de paix, le royaume où il n'y a plus de pleurs, de larmes, de mort, de péché. C'est la Jérusalem céleste, annoncée par les prophètes, réalisée en Christ, agneau immolé et ressuscité. Cette cité accueille le monde entier par les 4 points cardinaux. Elle est fondée sur l'Ecriture, l'AT avec la mention des 12 tribus de l'AT et le NT, avec la mention des 12 apôtres. Elle est le royaume de Dieu illuminé par la lumière de l'Agneau. Les trois textes de ce jour nous sont utiles pour vivre de la foi pascale, ils nous donnent une carte, une boussole et un but pour notre vie de foi, pour vivre de la vie éternelle. Chacun d'entre eux est utile car nous avons besoin des trois pour avancer dans la lumière de Pâques. Puisse l'Eucharistie de ce jour nous ouvrir à cette lumière. Bon dimanche, bonne et sanctifiante célébration à toutes et à tous.



“Jesús promete a los Apóstoles el don del Espíritu Santo, cuya tarea será enseñar y recordar sus palabras a la comunidad de discípulos. Enseñar y recordar: esto es lo que hace el Espíritu Santo en nuestros corazones” (Papa Francisco). Es muy cierto y se tiene la experiencia, de que, la persona que se abandona al Espíritu Santo, da muchos frutos de continua enseñanza y de obras buenas que el Espíritu de Dios hace en ella. Los santos y santas lo han experimentado en sus vidas, mostrando su fe con hechos. El amor de Dios nunca se cansa, si está presente, suceden cosas maravillosas.

“El que ama verdaderamente a Dios, observa sus mandamientos y Dios entra en su corazón y ahí permanece, porque el amor de Dios llena de tal manera su corazón, que al tiempo que le da tentación, no vuelve a su vida pasada” (San Gregorio Magno (540-640) Homilía 30). El reto, en este Sexto Domingo de Pascua, es que continuemos abriendo nuestro corazón y mente a la paz y al amor del Señor. Esa paz y su amor ayudarán a sanar las heridas sufridas por falta de amor, y quitará el miedo que se arraiga en la vida de la persona, a causa, muchas veces, de la falta de Dios en su vida. “Les dejo la paz, les doy mi paz, la paz que yo les doy no es como la que da el mundo. Que no haya en ustedes angustia ni miedo” (Juan 14:27). Oh, bien. “Si alguien me ama, guardará mis palabras” (Juan 14:23). Nuestra tarea: siempre tener la esperanza de enseñar y recordar todo lo que hemos recibido de Dios a los que nos rodean. ©LPi




