FROM THE PASTOR



“Peace be with you: as my Father sent me, so I send you...Receive the Holy Spirit...Whose sins you forgive are forgiven...”

This morning I heard Frank Sinatra on the radio singing, “You aint nobody till somebody loves you.” I took it as a sign of the Holy Spirit’s presence on this beautiful feast day, the solemnity of Pentecost. I never imagined that God would be speaking to me through his words! There is only one valid reason to enter into any relationship: to love and be loved. This is why the human heart seeks the Lord; this is why we were made for one another. Regardless of what some disgruntled people say, we were made for love. This is the real thing. This is the greatest thing that could ever happen to us. When we give our love and joy to others, we also give the best reason to believe in God. You cannot argue with a happy Saint! The next greatest joy comes from loving, even without being loved back. Even this second-best joy of loving without being loved back is greater and deeper than the third joy, the joy of being loved without loving. This is why Jesus Christ is the real thing. There is no one greater for his love is the greatest. It is totally unconditional, totally authentic, and totally reliable.

Why were the doors locked? We are told for “fear of the Jews.” But I personally think that that might be a very diplomatic way of saying that they were afraid of one particular Jew, Jesus. After all, wouldn’t Christ remind them of what they had done? Peter, you denied me not once, not twice, but three times! Thomas, you wouldn’t believe me unless you saw me! Mark, you fled from me, naked! Until recently, the Apostles had given up a lot to follow the Lord. Now, they were willing to give up everything just to get away from him!

All their fears were for nothing! They were still thinking like common men rather than like Apostles. They were not thinking like God thinks. The Lord said, “Peace be with you.” I have forgiven you. Do not let your hearts be troubled. I have conquered the world! Christ forgives because He is victorious. The Cross is not the end of the story. The Cross is the veil of eternal life. They can only understand this because of the Holy Spirit. The Lord breathes on them and gives them a new life, a new heart, and a new mission: Go and forgive.

Why are we here? To forgive. Why does the Church exist? To forgive sins. This is the most important act of charity the Church can offer! Catholic charity is alive and well thanks to the thousands of priests who hear confessions daily. It is the reason why Christ had to die: to show the Father’s forgiveness even at our worst moment, when we committed the most hideous sin imaginable. The day the Church stops forgiving sins will be the day that Heaven and earth collide and there will no longer be a need for the Church. That day, we will see Jesus face to face!

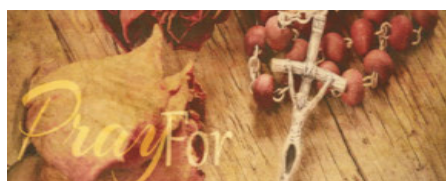
To forgive is the noblest duty of any Christian, for we too have been forgiven. Forgiveness is why we receive the Holy Spirit. It is also the reason why we are sent. There are many in this world that will drive you to the gates of Hell. Do not enter! Do not hate! Do not lose heart. Do not allow the toxin of resentment poison your soul. Our forgiveness is like a band-aid that covers a wound and allows the Lord to take his time to let the miracle to take place! Do not allow the wound to be re-opened by picking at it, going at it, or scratching and irritating it! Love is what heals all wounds - ALL WOUNDS, for it can bear all things and endure all things. Love never fails. The Lord valued his friendships, not for his sake, but for their sake. Receive the Holy Spirit. Receive the Lord’s Love, Joy, and Peace. Open the doors that have kept you in and get out of there today!

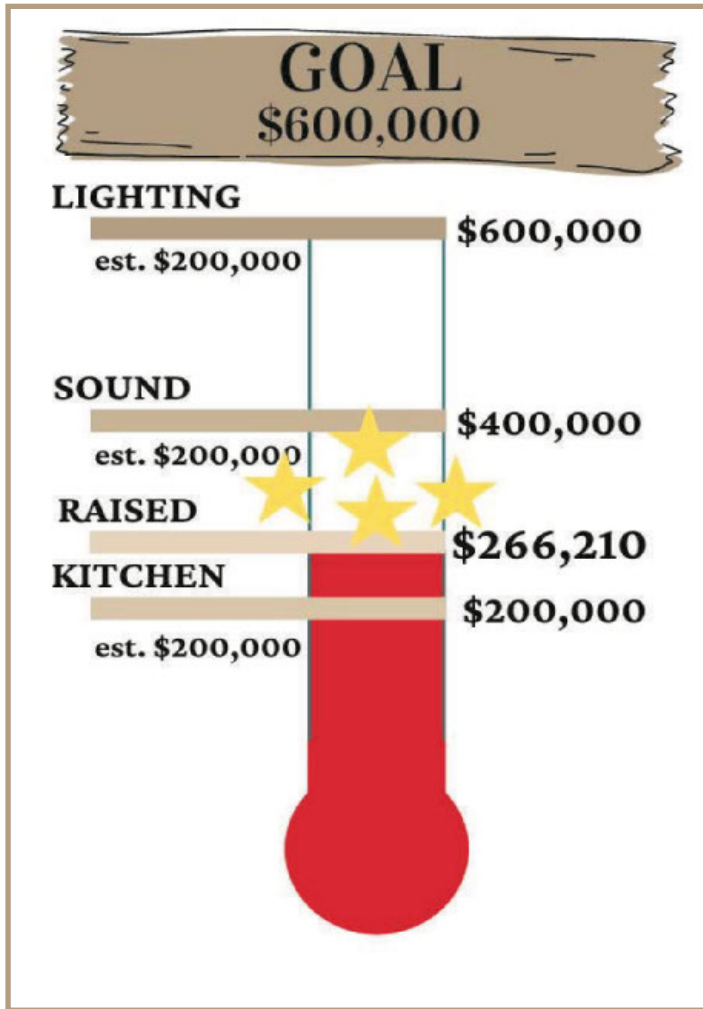

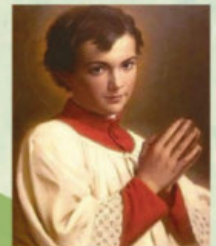

Mot de notre Aumônier

Bien aimés frères et sœurs, chers amis,

Cinquante jours après Pâques, nous voici parvenus à la fête de la Pentecôte. En ce dimanche, nous arrivons à la fin du temps pascal. Tout au long de cette période, nous avons fêté le Christ ressuscité, vainqueur de la mort et du péché. Le dimanche dernier, le jour de l'Ascension, il s'est manifesté une dernière fois aux onze disciples. Le livre des Actes des apôtres (1ère lecture) nous dit qu'il "s'éleva et une nuée vint le soustraire à leurs yeux". Tous ces gens n'avaient certainement jamais entendu parler de Jésus de Nazareth. Ils étaient là pour renouveler l'alliance avec Dieu. Mais rien ne se passe comme prévu. Il y eut simplement un bruit pareil à celui d'un violent coup de vent et aussi d'un feu qui se partageait en langues. C'est cela le don de l'Esprit Saint. À ce moment-là, tout est changé dans le cœur des apôtres. Alors qu'ils étaient "confinés" dans la salle commune, ils se mettent à sortir. La peur qui les paralysait est emportée. Ils se mettent à proclamer les merveilles de Dieu devant ceux-là mêmes qui ont fait mourir le Christ sur la croix. La première de ces merveilles c'est l'annonce de Jésus mort et ressuscité. Et ce qui est extraordinaire, c'est que chacun les entend dans sa propre langue. C'est une manière de dire que l'Évangile est pour tous, quel que soit l'endroit où le pays d'où l'on est. Et cette bonne nouvelle doit être proclamée dans le monde entier. Dans sa lettre aux chrétiens de Corinthe (2ème lecture), Paul rappelle l'action de l'Esprit Saint à l'intérieur de la communauté. Le problème c'est qu'il y a des divisions entre chrétiens. C'est un contre-témoignage. L'apôtre intervient pour rappeler que toutes les considérations de hiérarchie ou de supériorité doivent être éradiquées ; le fait d'être juif ou païen, esclave ou homme libre, ça ne compte plus. Le racisme, l'exclusion, le cléricisme n'ont plus leur place chez les chrétiens. Dans l'Église de Jésus Christ, on n'apprend plus à penser en termes de supériorité, de hiérarchie, d'avancement ou d'honneur. Désormais, une seule chose compte : notre baptême dans l'unique Esprit. L'Église n'est plus une pyramide mais une foule serrée autour de Jésus Christ. Saint Paul nous la présente comme un corps. Le Christ en est la tête et nous sommes les membres. Chacun de nous est différent. Il faut voir l'Église comme une foule de toutes les couleurs. Les divers membres n'ont pas la même fonction. Chaque membre est très important aux yeux de Dieu. Nous sommes appelés à vivre l'unité dans la diversité. Ce pari nous ne pourrions le gagner que parce que l'Esprit saint nous est donné. L'Évangile nous présente l'envoi des disciples en mission au soir de Pâques : "Comme le Père m'a envoyé, moi aussi je vous envoie". Puis il "souffle" sur eux. C'est ainsi qu'ils reçoivent le Saint Esprit en vue de la mission qui leur est confiée. Désormais, ils devront partir pour annoncer à tous l'Évangile du Salut en Jésus Christ. Pour cette grande mission, ils ne sont pas seuls. L'Esprit Saint, le souffle de Dieu, les accompagnera et les précèdera. Il sera agissant dans le cœur de ceux qu'il mettra sur leur route. Cette fête de la Pentecôte, c'est celle de l'Esprit Saint qui ne cesse de renouveler l'Église depuis plus de vingt siècles. C'est ce même Esprit que nous sommes invités à accueillir dans notre vie. Pour cela, il nous faut nous ouvrir à ce don de Dieu. Nous savons bien que cela n'est pas facile. Il y a en nous des résistances qui cherchent à nous détourner de lui. Être sous l'emprise de l'Esprit c'est sentir en nous la présence de Dieu qui est source de paix et de joie intérieure. Le Christ nous libère en nous orientant vers Dieu. Avec lui, nous pourrions nous imprégner de l'amour qui est en Dieu pour le communiquer à tous ceux qui nous entourent. Nous sommes envoyés dans le monde pour témoigner de l'espérance qui nous anime. Le Pape François nous dit que cette espérance doit être combative. La vie chrétienne est un combat contre nous-mêmes et bien souvent contre les idées à la mode. Comme un feu puissant, il chasse leurs ténèbres ; il illumine notre nuit. À la suite des apôtres, l'Église est appelée à communiquer la paix et à manifester le pardon. Cette paix, ce n'est pas l'absence de conflit ; c'est d'abord la paix intérieure (l'apaisement), c'est la miséricorde, c'est Dieu lui-même. La Pentecôte, c'est l'Esprit Saint qui vient illuminer notre nuit. Prions-le pour qu'il soit toujours avec nous ; qu'il nous donne d'annoncer la bonne nouvelle avec un zèle que rien ne saurait intimider. Bonne fête à tous et sanctifiant dimanche à chacun !

5 de junio de 2022 / Domingo de Pentecostés

Primera Lectura:

Hechos 2:1-11

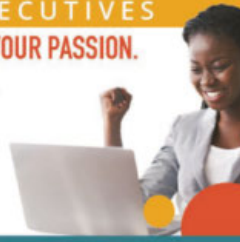

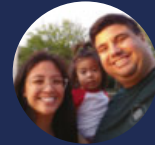
